Meeting of the NIC HP State Coordinator with DIOs/ADIOs/ Group Heads Through VC on 01-June-2020 at 2:30 PM

Smt. Padmavathi Viswanathan, DDG and NIC HP State Coordinator interacted with DIOs/ ADIOs, Centre In-charges and Group Heads through Video Conference 1st June, 2020 from 2;30 PM to 4:30 PM. She reviewed the work done during April and May 2020 and inquired the welfare of officials, including the difficulties faced, if any. The Group Heads/ NIC HP officers were at Shimla and remaining DIOs and ADIOs participated from their respective locations. The list of participating officers is given on Page-3.



Sh. Ajay Singh Chahal, SIO NIC HP, welcomed the NIC HP State Coordinator, Smt. Padmavathi Viswanathan and thanked her for taking time for interaction. The SIO thanked her for her support and guidance to NIC Himachal Pradesh. He added that it due to her guidance and support that NIC Himachal is considered among the best NIC States in India. The SIO updated that during the lock down period NIC Himachal was assigned the task of development of 2 national level mobile apps namely RATI (Rapid Antibody Test of India) and RT-PCR app and https://coivd19cc.nic.in portal for storing authorization details of sample collectors along with their collection centre and lots of MIS reports. NIC HP completed the task successfully in a very short time and now these mobile apps and portal are being used all over the country, reaching almost the figure of 1 lakh RT-PCR tests per day. NIC HP not only completed the task of development but was also instrumental in creation of Infrastructure on cloud. The SIO further informed that NIC HP officers worked as team and accomplished the task within short duration of time. The SIO also added that during the period all the DIOs of HP worked day and night with the district administration.

The State Coordinator appreciated the work done by NIC HP and also added that it is faith in the team of NIC HP due to which DG NIC assigned the task to NIC HP.

Thereafter, the State Coordinator interacted with all the Officers of NIC Himachal Pradesh, during the interaction she was courteous enough to enquire about status of health of each officer and his family members. She also pointed out that during these testing times all the officers should take care of their health and family by taking all necessary precautions. All officers present in the VC based meeting highlighted their work activities and how they managed to work despite difficult working conditions.

During the lock down period all NIC Officers worked almost round the clock on all days to provide support to State and District administration, specifically the following:

- 1. Video conferencing: was the main source of interaction among various authorities. VC was extensively used during the period. NIC HP ensured smooth conducting of VCs at different level.
- All the DIOs/ ADIOs worked closely with district administration. All the notifications/ circulars related to Covid19 were regularly updated on the websites and social media to make information readily available to the citizens. Support was provided for issuance of curfew passes, housekeeping related to Quarantined individuals and containment zones.

Mobile Apps/ Software Applications Developed during the period:

- 1. RATI Mobile App (Rapid Anti body Test of India) for capturing details related to Rapid Anti body tests for ICMR
- 2. RT-PCR Mobile App for capturing details related to Covid19 test being conducted throughout India for ICMR.
- 3. <u>https://covid19cc.nic.in</u> portal for details of collection centers, the information being collected is used by RATI and RT-PCR Mobile Apps
- 4. Curfew Pass Issuance System using ServicePlus Platform: DIO Kangra coordinated the development of curfew pass issuance system using ServicePlus Platform. The application is integrated with Arogya Setu App.
- 5. Arogya Setu App: Creation of Users at district level and providing trainings related to Arogya Setu app for usage and monitoring.
- 6. Application for Monitoring Health of Drivers: NIC Kullu developed application for tracking health of drivers of transport vehicles and now they are developing another web-app for disbursement of help to needy families for construction and repair of their houses in the District.



Other activities completed during the Period are:

- 1. Disbursement of Social Security Pension: ensured timely disbursement of Pensions
- 2. Closing of Financial Year of State
- 3. Regular updations of web sites. All the websites were regularly updated.

The State Coordinator appreciated the work done by NIC Himachal Pradesh at District and State level. She specifically highlighted the Covid19 related Mobile Apps developed by NIC HP for National level in a very short time. She wished all the best to all officers and inquired about their families, issues faced during the lock-down period and how these have been tackled. She advised officials to use face masks, face shields and protect themselves properly.
