# **Meeting with Chief Secretary, Himachal Pradesh**

Sh. B.K. Agarwal, Chief Secretary, Government of Himachal Pradesh had a detailed meeting with Smt. Padmavathi Viswanathan on the role played by NIC Himachal Pradesh. He appreciated that NIC is doing most of the ICT activities in the State and are an integral part of the State Government.

- He desired that the User interface of some of the earlier developed applications need improvement. The State Coordinator informed him that now NIC has designated Quality officers to look into these aspects and the quality of software and user interface will improve.
- The State Coordinator explained the importance and need for data analysis and predictive analysis. The Chief Secretary desired to have a demo of these tools to further explore the possibilities.
- He desired to identify some NIC developed software which are high impact but low in implementation so that these can be taken up for full implementation.

• He was requested to consider State Government housing facilities at Tribal/ Remote Districts of Lahaul & Spiti, Chamba and Kinnaur, to which he agreed.

# **Meeting with Principal Secretary (IT, Transport, E&T)**

Sh. Jagdish Chander Sharma, Principal Secretary (Information Technology, Transport, Excise & Taxation) GoHP welcomed the NIC HP State Coordinator to Shimla.

#### **Visit to NIC CGO Complex Office, Shimla:**

- NIC Mini Data Centre is set up in CGO Complex. There are 3 NIC officials posted. The storage space is 60 GB but its full potential will be utilized once the recently approved Switches are supplied. The DR site is at Pune for data backup.
- NKN PoP is functional from CGO Complex, providing connectivity to Secretariat, CM Office, Governor Secretariat, HP Assembly, High Court, SDC, SWAN and 22 other NKN institutes. It has back up from 125 KVA Genset and 2 UPS besides the CPWD back-up.

 The Manav Sampada, Mid Day Meals Automated Reporting & Monitoring System software have been developed through outsourced manpower and they are stationed here due to availability of space. Suggestions for photo uploading facility, analytics for food quality were discussed provided Internet connectivity is available in all reporting schools, which is not the case presently.

- Currently, the Public Service Commission software is being developed and a
  demonstration of the under development modules of Software Admin, DPC, R &
  P Rules, Candidate registration, Departmental Requisition and Examination
  modules was done. Some suggestions for incorporating in the software were
  given:
  - Check box and colour coded application completion status, Auto Save
  - Document checklist with respect to candidate profile/ application
  - Water mark in Admit Card formats
  - Digi-locker based qualification/ other certificates
  - Employment Exchange registration number of candidate, if available
  - Load Testing
  - MS SQL 2017 having data analytics functionalities and Visual Studio procurement though NICSI to be followed up through State Coordinator

# **Visit to NIC District Centre, Solan:**

- The NIC Centre is newly set up in the year 2018 as the District Administration has provided about 1600 square feet of area in the newly constructed building and furnished it. The set up is very good.
- Sh. Sanjeev Kumar, DIO gave presentation on the activities currently ongoing in the District. All new hardware under District NIC Infrastructure Upgradation has been received.
