Meeting of the NIC HP State Coordinator with DIOs/ADIOs/ Group Heads Through VC on 23-December-2020 from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM

Smt. Padmavathi Viswanathan Iyer, DDG and NIC HP State Coordinator interacted with SIO, Group Heads at Shimla, NIC Centre In-charges, DIOs/ ADIOs through Video Conference on 23rd December, 2020 in the meeting held from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM. She appreciated the work done by NIC Himachal Pradesh and recognition being received at National level for the good work. She inquired about the well-being of all officials, their families and asked for any issues being faced by them at any level in performing their work. She informed about the medical facility order issued recently by Government of India whereby CGHS beneficiaries can avail cashless benefits in private hospitals on the recommendation of CGHS/Government Hospital specialist. She congratulated NIC HP team for the awards being received at the National level.



Sh. Ajay Singh Chahal, SIO explained the new activities being carried out in the State, new projects undertaken and other similar work. He informed that all officials have completed their mandatory Vidyakosh courses and are now planning their webinars in coming months. The Covid19 Sample Collection Management System, developed by NIC Himachal Pradesh, has helped ICMR and Health Officials at the National level in combating Covid19 Pandemic in an effective manner. This software has been developed and implemented by NIC Himachal Pradesh in 35 States/UTs and so far 7.5 Crores samples have been collected by over 1 lakh sample collectors all across India. This is a big achievement of State NIC.

The SIO updated all NIC HP officers in the current projects undertaken along with their importance and that the State Elections to Panchayati Raj Institutions and Urban Local Bodies have been announced. He informed that a new software has been developed along with appropriate mobile apps to ensure that the entire process is paperless and done through this software right from filing of papers by candidates (partial) to counting of votes and issuance of elected candidate certificate. He asked Sh. Sandeep Sood to hold a demo of software so that DIOs are aware of its various functionalities.

He informed about the following projects/apps being undertaken by NIC for State Departments,:

- 1. RERA-Real Estate Regulatory Authority workflow software
- 2. HP SDMA-SW and mobile app for Schools Disaster Plans
- 3. Covid19 Care for Patients, mobile app for Health officials
- 4. Revenue Relief for Pong Dam oustees
- 5. BPL upliftment for RDD
- 6. Subhash Palekar Natural Farming portal for farmers
- 7. Online employee bills
- 8. Mobile Apps for State Election Commission
- 9. Dashboards for Ease of Doing Business under various Projects

The State Coordinator highly appreciated the work activities being done by NIC HP at National, State and District level.



Thereafter, all DIOs/ADIOs and Group Heads at Shimla informed the work activities being done by them after the last meeting. These are listed below:

- 1. Sh. Neeraj Goel, STD informed that now the classroom based trainings have started in HIPA and he is coordinating/ arranging these.
- 2. Sh. Sanjeev Kumar, DIO Solan informed about the creation of additional Kasauli tehsil and shifting of eHimBhoomi data there. He will update on eKalayan mobile app too.

- 3. Sh. Bhupinder Pathak, DIO Kangra informed that they have completed the work related to Virtual Court in coordination of Sh. Ashwani Kumar, Scientist-D, Incharge NIC High Court and that Hon'ble Chief Justice of India may inaugurate it in future.
- 4. Sh. Akhilesh Bharti, DIO Mandi informed that the security audit of both Schemes MIS and Roznamcha software has been completed and these are hosted on State Data Centre, Shimla for easy access. The Roznamcha software is implemented in Mandi district with more that 32,000 entries and can be used by other Districts in future.
- 5. Sh. Pratul, DIO Lahual & Spiti will finalize software modalities through written communication with DC L&S along with business rules/ mode of operation.
- Sh. Sanjay Kumar, STD informed about the roll-out of PSC-Soft software in HP Public Service Commission, its changes and future replication in the States of Delhi, Haryana, Lakshadweep, Chhattisgarh, MP, Maharashtra etc. He informed the progress made in online employee bills submission software too besides adding lots of analytical reports in Covid19 SCMS software.
- 7. Sh. Shailender Kaushal, TD informed about Arogya Setu API and how it is being integrated for office employees. It has been done for 126 NIC HP employees/FMS/ Outsource employees. Sh. Pankaj Gupta, DIO Shimla informed that it has been done in DC Office Shimla also and other Districts may follow suit. VC boards have been prepared.
- 8. Sh. Sandeep Sood, STD informed about SEC software for elections and also the CPGRRAM integration with Smagr eSamadhan and will do a demo for these soon.



The **action taken on previous review meeting decisions** were discussed and current status was is as following:

- Weeding out of obsolete record, advice to be sought from Sh. P.K. Upadhyay, Sr. TD, on records pertaining to old DSCs available at NIC HP earlier than 7 years-Obsolete record and equipment processed and weeded out at Shimla. DSC files weeding out in progress by scanning the records before disposal. (Action: TD (S Kaushal))
- 2. Getting software quality audit done through SQG for important products like HP PSC SWwork is in progress (Action: STD (S Kumar))
- 3. Procurement of Oxymeter and Thermal Scanners for NIC officials in all offices-procured at Shimla. DIOs and other locations may procure as per procedure. (Action: DDO)
- 4. State Coordinator also assured to follow up the action being taken in the matter of procurement of physical security equipment and 20 KVA UPS at NIC Hqrs.-approvals received, purchase orders for UPS issued. (Action: TD (VKS))



Decisions taken in the meeting are:

- 1. Inform all officers about new Medical procedure in case of treatment through empanelled private hospitals (for CGHS beneficiaries) (Action: DDO)
- 2. Completion of new Vidyakosh courses and Webinars by eligible officers (Action: All officers)
- 3. eHimBhoomi and NGDRS implementation in State by removing any software related issues (Action: STD (LK), STD (S Sood))

- 4. Manav Sampada-Treasury FMS to be trained properly as State Government has given target of 28-Feb-2021 to complete eService book records in State and online submission of TA/Medical bills by 1-April-2021 (Action: STD (S Kumar))
- 5. State Election Commission software demo for all DIOs (Action: STD (S Sood))
- 6. IP Phones will be allotted to L&S, Kinnaur, Bilaspur and Shimla districts as per availability. (Action: TD (VKS)/TD(S Kaushal)
- 7. Sh. Subham and Sh. Swetansh, DIA Kinnaur and Solan will finalize Chatbot and eKalyaan Mobile apps (Action: DIA Kinnaur and DIA Solan).
- 8. DIO Kangra and Sh. Vijay Gupta, TD will complete eChallan payment gateway integration for traffic challans in coordination with the SBI vendor who supplied the POS machines.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to all officers present in the meeting with the hope that the State NIC will do equally good in the coming year 2021 and gives its best in providing innovative solutions for the improvement of various Government systems.
