

## Proceedings of the Visit of State Coordinator to Himachal Pradesh and DIOs Workshop at NIC HP State Centre, Shimla

Dates of Visit/Workshop/Meeting: **11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2024**

Venue: **NIC HP State, Centre, HP Secretariat, Shimla.**

Sh. IPS Sethi, DDG & State Coordinator, HP visited Shimla in December 2024. A 2-Days DIOs workshop was held at NIC HP State Centre Shimla on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2024 under the Chairmanship of Sh. I. P. S. Sethi, DDG-cum-State Coordinator NIC Himachal Pradesh. The idea of the workshop was to review the various ongoing projects and activities at NIC District Centres and all the NIC Offices in the State. Besides this, a technical session for the enhancement of the technical expertise and knowledge of NIC officers was also conducted by **ValueFirst (ValueFirst Digital Media Pvt. Ltd.)** through VC for integration of WhatsApp Messaging Services and Onboarding Procedures in the Government Websites.

Sh. Ajay Singh Chahal, DDG-cum-SIO NIC Himachal Pradesh welcomed Sh. I. P. S. Sethi, DDG and all the DIOs of Himachal Pradesh. The SIO, HP presented the State Profile of NIC HP and briefed about the various Products/Projects and Mobile Apps being developed and managed by the NIC Himachal Pradesh. He also outlined the upcoming activities and highlighted the various awards won by NIC Himachal Pradesh in the recent past.

The major awards & accolades won by NIC Himachal Pradesh during 2024 are:

- GEMS of Digital India Award 2024 for MEITY-GAC (Grievance Appellate Committee MIS)
- GEMS of Digital India Award 2024 for School Safety MIS/Mobile App for GoHP
- Appreciation Certificate by Hon'ble Governor of Himachal Pradesh for Exemplary Work Done for iRAD Implementation
- m-Governance Initiative of the Year Award 2024 (15<sup>th</sup> National Digital Transformation Awards 2024) for School Safety MIS/Mobile App for Government of Himachal Pradesh

Further, the issues of Manpower Shortage, Obsolete Hardware/Network Infra in NIC Himachal Pradesh were also discussed in detail and the State Coordinator has been requested to consider this on priority and ensure placement of manpower due to vacancies created on account of retirements, transfers etc.

Sh. IPS Sethi, DDG-cum-State Coordinator NIC HP, appreciated the work being done by NIC HP. He opined that sincere and excellent work done by NIC HP has been acknowledged at the National Level and many National Level Projects viz. RTPCR, OxyCare, PM POSHAN (MID DAY Meal), Manav Sampada/eHRMS, PSCSoFT, Riktiyan, Digital Government Platform, NaaS – Notification as a Service and GAC - Grievance Appellate Committee etc. have been successfully developed by NIC HP and implemented pan India. He assured that the issues like manpower shortage and replacement of old & obsolete HW/Infra shall be taken up at the NIC HQ.

## Common Issues

Following were the common issues raised by the DIOs:

- Issue of UPS replacement
- Requirement/replacement of Laptops
- Requirement of upgradation/replacement of existing HW supplied during 2017 to 2019.
- Replacement of old Network Infra specially Routers and Switches.

To bring in healthy competition and to improve the presentation skills, it was decided to rank the presentations. The ranking was done using NIC HP developed HindiBodh mobile app through participants feedback and the top three ranked presentations are:

## Interaction with Group Heads

Day two of the workshop was reserved for the presentations by the Group Heads and all the Group Members. Various items like Administration, Personnel, Stores and Miscellaneous Issues were also taken up after the presentations.

The Group Heads were asked to deliver 7 minutes presentation each covering the last 6 Months Achievements, Action Plan for next 6 Months, Trainings attended and their application, Applications Integration with other SWs, SW User Rights not transferred to User Departments, suggestions for improvements in existing applications, Webinars, Vidyakosh and Sandes usage status.

The Group Members were also asked to deliver 7 minutes presentation each covering the projects being managed (Security Audits, VA, SSL, Password Policy Implementation, Encryption of selected Data Fields, migration of Applications to NGC etc.), Webinars, Vidyakosh and Sandes usage, training(s) attended and their application in the projects.

All the Group Heads along with their team members gave brief presentations of the assigned activities and interacted with the DIOs. They also shared the details about the upcoming activities being carried out by their respective groups. In addition, the issues being faced, their remedial solutions and suggestions etc. were also discussed in detail in the workshop.

On basis of the quality, content, time-management and the presentation delivery, ranking of the presentations was done using NIC HP developed HindiBodh mobile app. The top three ranked positions are:

## Administration, Personnel, Stores and Miscellaneous Issues

Sh. Vimal Sharma (DDO), Sh. Rajesh Kumar Yadubhushanam (Section Officer) along with Admin Staff Members took up the Admin and Stores related issues.

## Decisions Taken

In the end, SIO HP wished Happy New Year to all the officers & officials and directed all the DIOs, Group Heads and Members to take care of the following key points:

- Compliance of DPDP Act 2023 (Digital Personal Data Protection Act), PII (Personally Identifiable Information), Aadhaar and Cyber Security guidelines.
- Data Privacy & Security must be accorded highest priority and any sensitive data must be encrypted while in transit as well as in rest.
- Cyber Security training programmes should be conducted on regular basis.
- All the user credentials and data backup must be handed over to the respective application owners.
- All the projects/applications must be reviewed regularly for their UI/UX, process re-engineering and tech stack being used so that same me be kept up-to-date and robust enough to deliver the services in a transparent, secure and user-friendly manner.
- Vulnerability Assessment and Security Audit of all the applications must be done mandatorily as per the schedules in coordination with the concerned User Departments as in absence of these, the application is required to be off-loaded immediately as per the MeitY, GoI Guidelines.
- Usage and promotion of Hindi Language in the day-to-day official working.
- In view of the on-going winter season, special precaution must be taken for any fire incidents.
- To work proactively and learn new technologies to keep themselves up-to-date and at par with the industry standards.
- Application specific capacity building user trainings should be conducted on regular basis.
- In-time submission of the Bills and verification of Service Books entries.
- In-time completion Vidyakosh courses and delivery of the Webinars.
- Cleanliness/Swachhta activities, Record Keeping and weeding out of the old records should be done on regular bases.

## Technical Session

During the workshop, a Technical Session on WhatsApp Services was held through **ValueFirst (ValueFirst Digital Media Pvt. Ltd.)** for the integration of WhatsApp Messaging Services in the Government Websites and its Onboarding procedures.
