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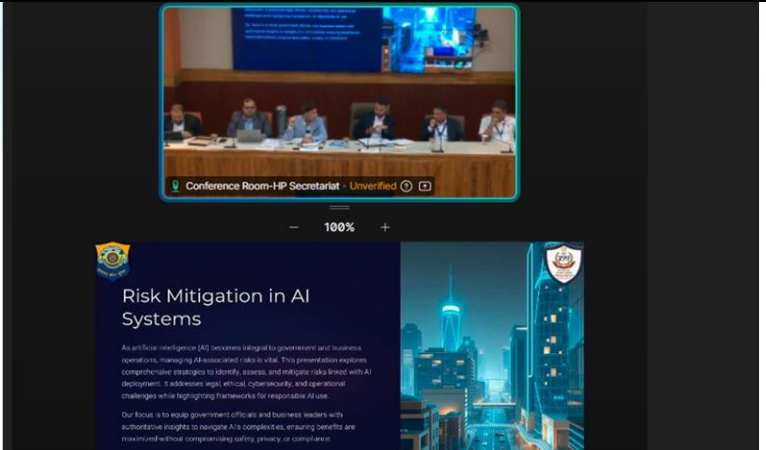

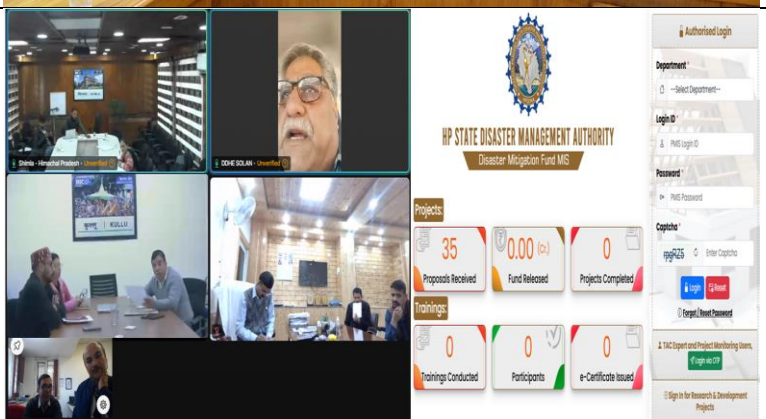

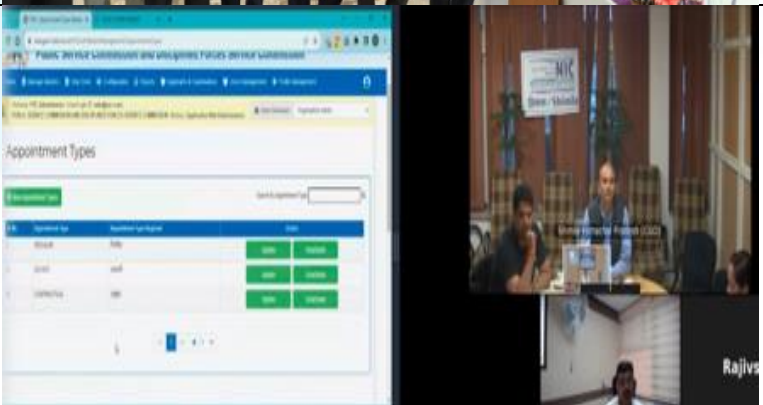

2.0 NICNET Services at NIC Himachal Pradesh

(NKN, Video Conference, Email, Internet Nodes, Connectivity, VSATs)

Network at a glance

- Mini Cloud has been operational in Himachal Pradesh.
- Core connectivity of 3* 10GB provided by BSNL, PGCIL and RAILTEL.
- High Speed connectivity of 1000/100/34 Mbps to Institutes and NIC Districts.
- LAN of approximately 1500 nodes in HP Secretariat.
- NIC HP has developed many mobile apps, Wi-Fi network has been setup in HP Secretariat to promote the mobile apps to users. At present more than 1900 Wi-Fi accounts are created.
- More than 9000 e-mail accounts provided to Government Officials in the State.
- VSAT based connectivity in Remote Districts (Kinnaur and Lahaul & Spiti) of NIC and 4 Tribal Sub Divisions of Himachal Pradesh.

NICNET has been extended to Central government offices and NKN is providing connectivity to major institutes in Himachal Pradesh. National Knowledge Network is a high bandwidth, low latency network. The aim of the project is to connect educational, medical, research institutes and also the Government Networks. NIC has provided network connectivity to 24 institutes in the Himachal Pradesh through NKN project. All the important Educational, Medical and Research Institutes are connected to the NKN. All the State Government Offices are also connected to NKN through HIMSWAN. NIC has also provided VSATs connectivity to 4 Tribal Sub Divisions of HP and as a backup link for remote districts of Himachal Pradesh.

Video Conferencing



Video Conferencing services are available in CM Office, Raj Bhawan, Vidhan Sabha, NIC HP State Center, CGO Complex and all NIC Districts Centres. NIC has also provided VC facility in 4 Tribal Sub Divisions of Pooh, Bharmaur, Kaaza and Pangi. Video Conferencing facility is integrated with other Video Conferencing projects implemented by the state Government.

All projects have been integrated and VC upto block level is possible from any NIC based Video Conferencing system. All NIC studios support Full High Definition VC facility.

VC Sessions conducted

- 18,089 VC Sessions have been conducted between January 2018 to 30 September, 2025.

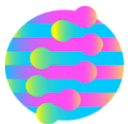

100% coverage, Web enabled Sarathi 4.0 has been Implemented in all the RLAs/RTOs of the State.

6. Vahan - Registration of Vehicles Information System

The vehicle registration SW is a standard S/W developed by NIC for the country wide implementation to enable the tracking of vehicles across the country by porting data to a central national register which will be a deterrent for vehicle thieves and help in faster detection of owner/ vehicle details in case of need.

100% coverage Web based Vahan4.0 has been implemented in all the RLAs/RTOs of the State.

7. Transport Barrier Information System

The software has been developed to collect the tax from the vehicle owners as per norms and also to generate various statutory & query reports as well as to help them in changing the fee collection structure within no time at the Transport barriers. Implemented at 10 Interstate transport barriers.

8. PUC 2.0 (Pollution Under Control)

To tackle air pollution by ensuring that vehicles are physically inspected and their emissions are checked, a PUCC (Pollution Under Control Certificate) is issued. The PUC 2.0 project, mandates physical presence of the vehicle at Automated Emission Testing Centers (AETCs) and includes live video recording and geo-location of the mobile device for issuing PUCC.



The PUC2.0 has been implemented in Himachal Pradesh with its integration with HimKosh.

9. eDetection

The eDetection Application is reshaping road safety by automatically identifying vehicles which are either blacklisted or operating without valid Motor Vehicle (MV) documents such as Tax, Fitness, Insurance, Pollution Under Control Certificates (PUCC) and Permits. This system leverages vehicle data from Toll Plazas to issue eChallan seamlessly for the defaulter



Initially implemented on pilot basis on three NHAI Toll Plazas in HP, the Himachal Entry Tax violations have

vehicles detected by the application. Additionally, it helps in identifying counterfeit vehicles with falsified Number Plates by cross-referencing with the Vahan database. also been integrated through eCheckpost application in the eDetection system.

10. Citizen Service Centres (Sugam, LokMitra, Pehal, eVikas)

The **Sugam Centre**, one of its kind, provides centralized integrated services to citizens for different departments under one roof. The services cover online transactions like registration of deeds/ vehicles, issuance of licenses/ certificates, payments etc. It is set up in all DC office of the districts and offers more than 50+ services under single roof.



LokMitra: It provide the rural masses with the benefits of Information Technology at their doorstep, the State Government named all MeitY sponsored Citizen Service Centres (CSCs at 3243 Panchayats and Urban Areas) as LokMitra Kendras based on the pilot project implemented by NIC HP in Hamirpur district earlier. The objective is the saving in time and money of the people, which is spent in physically visiting various Govt offices.

Pehal-Citizen Service Centers: It introduce the transparency in the government functioning and to provide better, friendlier, speedier, efficient services to the citizen on a single window. These Service Centers have been set up to offer Driving License and Registration of Vehicle services at all District HQs/Sub-Divisions (RLAs)/RTOs and STA.

11. Budget Processing MIS

Budget Processing and monitoring system developed for the State Finance Department covering real time generation of Supplementary and regular Budget, Re-appropriation, Budget documents. Improvements have been carried out to link it with the Planning department and other State departments to prepare scheme wise online Plan budget proposal & final estimates for the coming financial year. System also generates the scheme wise budget estimates for the next 3 years.

The SW has been implemented for the last many years.

Budget Suggestions portal has been integrated with it.

12. OLTIS - Integrated Online Treasury Information System

i-OLTIS is an online centralized application for conducting all the treasury operations. It facilitates processing of bills created online by DDO to creating payment scrolls for banks which banks download from the portal itself thus speeding up the process of payments to beneficiaries. It also simplifies other treasury operations like stamps distribution, DDO management, creating and rendering account to AG office. Real time expenditure reports help the HOD/DDO to utilize the allocated budget in efficient ways. Web services were developed to integrate departmental application for sending online bills.

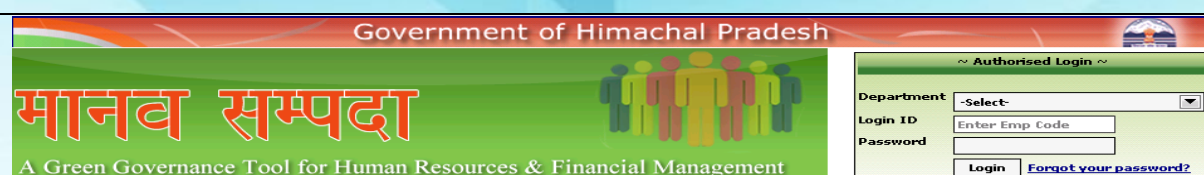

The software is for generation of Electoral Rolls from the existing ECI rolls for the Panchayati Raj Institutions and Urban Local Bodies Elections, minimizing the data entry work. The S/W has been expanded to cover the PRI Representatives including capacity building through continuous training at various Training Institutes in the State. The Electoral Rolls are being generated using this application since 2010 and all annual revisions are carried out by ERMS. The revision of electoral rolls for 2015 general elections has also been carried out successfully in the elections held recently. Till now 2 general elections have been conducted using Electoral Rolls generated using ERMS. Software interface being developed for the Election process now. Now EVM management and poll day processes have also been automated and elections held through SW since 2022-23.



41. Energy - Power Projects Monitoring System

Various power projects sanctioned by the State Government for development and generation of electricity through independent power producers (IPP) need close monitoring as majority of the producers have not developed these projects, which affects State economy. Therefore, the project has been developed for close monitoring of such power projects in the private/public sector. The LADF payment & usage is being monitored.

The software is under implementation and User IDs have been given to the Project developers and producers to enter the status of projects for monitoring purposes.



42. Rohtang Pass Permit Issuance System

This application is used by common citizens as well as the authorities of District Kullu to generate permits for the vehicles going to and across Rohtang pass. In addition, Special Rohtang Pass permit, Hamta Pass permit and Manali Entry Green Tax permits are also being issued and managed through this application. The application is developed as per the guidelines of National Green Tribunal where vehicles are permitted daily as per the defined quota.

The project was implemented on September, 2015. Over 9,94,180 permits have been issued through this application and approximately ₹ 41.62 Crores of tax has been collected in lieu of the issuance of various permits.

43. Special Road Tax System

The SRT is a web based application used by the RTO authorities of Transport Department, Himachal Pradesh for time table and route permit issuance of Stage Carriage Vehicle. Application auto- calculates the monthly prepaid Special Road Tax using formula based on the Road Permit parameters like seating capacity, distance and category of roads.

RTOs have collected over Rs. 92.67 Crores as Tax since 2013.



44. Swayam Sidham Education Portal

The portal has been developed to facilitate the teachers and students in improving quality of education in Government schools by providing online interface for quality content. Online training of teachers is latest teaching aids is possible through this portal.

Online Books, Multiple choice question-answer, tests, previous board exam papers, lesson plans, indicators, queries of students, best answer sheets are available.

45. eStock Management System

Web enabled solution for handling purchase, inventory control & maintenance activities of consumable & Non-consumable stock items. The module for procurement and issuance of consumable items has been implemented. The modules for Non-consumables and maintenance of hardware are under development

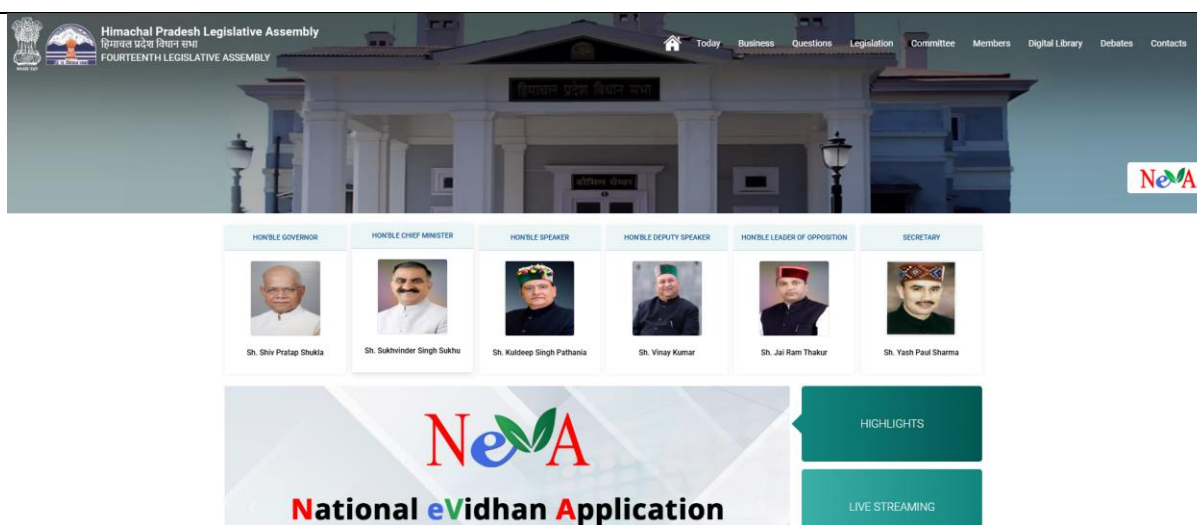

**48. Mid Day Meals Automated Reporting & Management System (SMS based)**

With a view to enhance the enrolment, retention and attendance and simultaneously improve the nutritional levels among children, the National Programme of Nutritional Support to Primary Education (NP-NSPE) was launched as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme on 15th August 1995. The scheme underwent many changes over the years and is now known as "PM Poshan". Over 10 crore eligible school children in over 11 lakh schools have been benefited from the scheme. In order to efficiently manage the enrolment and meals being served in the Schools of various States, the MDM-ARMS software has been developed as a product so that any State Education Department can use it. The data collected will be reflected on the National Portal on daily basis. The software is available at <https://mdmhp.nic.in> and has been implemented in 17 States covering more than 5 Lakh schools of the country.

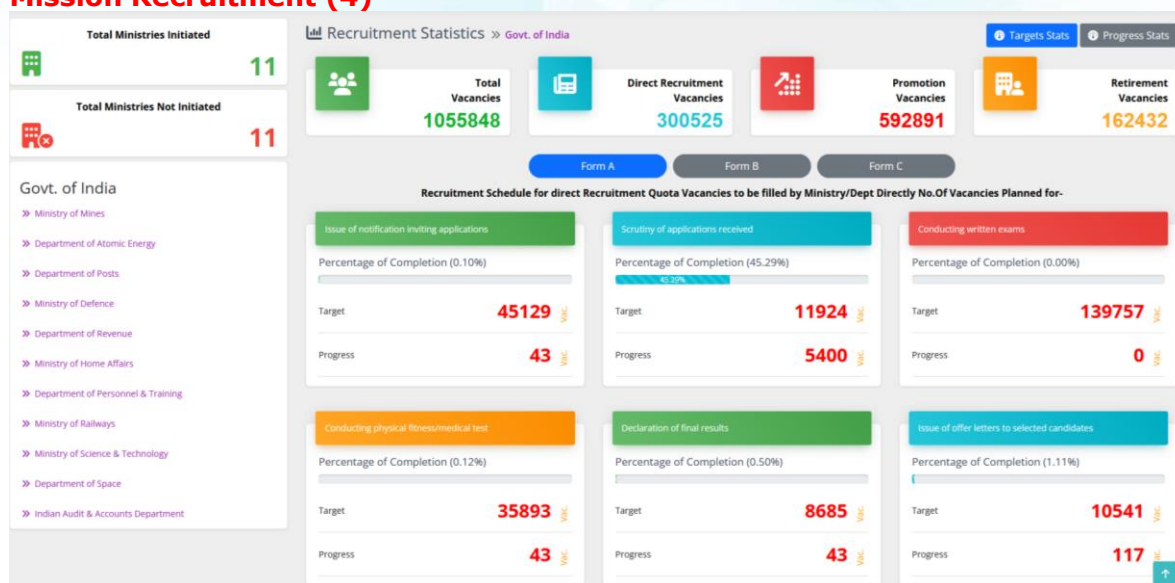
6. Name of the Project: GAC ePortal

Notification as a Service (NaaS)

NaaS enables users of various Government software applications to get notifications on their Mobile and Desktop. The only assumption is that the software application captures either the Email or the Mobile number of the User/ Beneficiary/ Employee/ Trader. The end-user will be able to get notifications from multiple sources on a single device.

The application owner will need to register for NaaS using official Government Email ID, as the portal works on Single Sign On (SSO). A signed Verification document will need to be uploaded. Once the User is verified by the NaaS, the user will be able to register the software application and get the web-service to link their software with NaaS. The User will also get the steps to use the web-service in this Email.
