Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission to,

1. First Year of 3 Years Diploma Course in Handloom & Textile Technology (DHTT) and
2. Second Year of 3 Years Diploma course in Handloom & Textile Technology (DHTT) directly under LATERAL ENTRY SCHEME.

Eligibility Criteria & education qualifications:-

Name of the course	Duration	Eligibility
Diploma in handlooms & Textile Technology (DHTT)	3 years	Passed 10 th standard/SSC examination. Obtained at least 35% marks in the qualifying examination with English as a subject of study.
Diploma in handlooms & Textile Technology (DHTT) (Direct Second Year Admission under Lateral Entry Scheme)	2 Years	Should have passed 10+2 examination with Mathematics Physics, Chemistry OR Should have passed 10+2 examination in vocational stream of any textile discipline.* OR 10 th Pass +2 Years of ITI, shall be eligible for admission to Second Year Diploma Course.*

Note:-

1. *The candidate will undergo bridge courses for Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry, offered by IIHT Jodhpur, as per the guidelines.
2. In case of the Board having system of grading in 10th/12th Examination, the candidate must endorse the proof of details of Mark with their application form to enable the selection committee to prepare merit list which is prepared on the basis of marks secured.

Number of seats to be admitted:

Admission to I Year of DHTT	08 seats (including one seat for EWS candidate)
Admission to II year directly under LE System*	01 seat*

Age

The age limit for admission to first year of Diploma Course in Handlooms & Textile Technology for all the categories except SC/ST should be between 15-23 years and for SC/ST candidates it should be between 15-25 year as on 01st July of the admission year.

Stipend

Each student admitted into the course, both to I year and II year under lateral entry, will be eligible for a monthly Stipend of Rs. 2500/- to be paid 50% by Central and 50% by State Govt. as per the guidelines, for the

duration of course (tenable for 10 months per annum).

- i. The payment of stipend is linked to the attendance and academic performance. Accordingly, the student must have 80% of class attendance to become eligible for the monthly stipend.
- ii. The student must not have any back paper and in special cases, one back paper is allowed.
- iii. The student selected for admission will be required to submit a declaration on a non-judicial stamp-paper (Rs. 100/-) duly attested by Notary in the prescribed form.

Application form, free of cost, may be obtained from the O/o of Joint Director/Deputy Director and Assistant Director, District MSME Centres, located in each district or the same may be downloaded from the website of the Department.

The application form, complete in all respect should reach to the Director General Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), Haryana, C-3, 3rd Floor, HSVP Complex, Sector-6, Panchkula on or before 15th July, 2022 (for First Year Admission) and 25th July, 2022 (for Second Year Admission - LE) through Joint Director/Deputy Director, District MSME Centres of the concerned district.

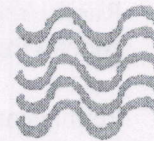

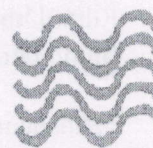

1. Eligibility Criteria and Educational qualifications:

Diploma in Handlooms & Textile Technology (DHTT) (Direct Second year admission under Lateral Entry scheme)	Two (2) Years	Should have passed 10+2 examination with Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry OR Should have passed 10 + 2 examination in vocational stream of any textile discipline.* OR 10 th Pass + 2 Years of ITI, shall be eligible for admission to Second Year Diploma Course*

Note:

1. * The candidates will undergo bridge courses for Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry, offered by IIHT Jodhpur, as per the guidelines.
2. In case of the Board having system of grading in 10th/12th Examination, the candidate must endorse the proof of details of marks with their application form to enable the selection committee to prepare merit list which is prepared on the basis of marks secured.

6. Preparation of merit list

All the eligible Candidates who have submitted Application Form on or before the last date specified in the Application Form / Advertisement shall be allotted a merit number.

- i. Merit List of all the eligible candidates will be prepared by the Selection Committee comprising Director of Handlooms Textiles/Director of Industries & Director, IIHT, Jodhpur or his representative to verify the qualifying standard and other eligibility conditions depending upon the State reservation policy. A common merit list of all eligible candidates (prepared based on reservation/category wise) will be submitted to IIHT Jodhpur, for issue of offer of counselling to the eligible candidates.
- ii. Aggregate of marks obtained in class 10th or equivalent qualifying examination in case of Admission to First Year /12th or equivalent qualifying Examinations in case of Admission to Second Year under lateral entry, shall be basis for the purpose of determining the merit.
- iii. State Government shall decide and mention the actual no. of seats to be reserved for various categories as per their prevailing reservation policy and for weaver's community out of total seats allotted to the state.
- iv. In the event of two candidates securing identical marks in aggregate then the candidate who had secured more marks in the Science subject will stand higher in the merit.
- v. If under extra ordinary circumstances the above conditions also remain identical, the eligible candidate having less age will be on higher merit. However, even if this also remains identical, the alphabetical order of the name of the candidates will be criteria for merit i.e. English alphabet A to Z.

In case of LATERAL ENTRY ADMISSION, the following order of preference and the methodology shall be followed to decide the merit, in case of two candidates securing identical marks.


- i. Higher percentage of marks in the subject of Mathematics at HSc.
- ii. Higher percentage of marks in the subject Science (aggregate of physics & chemistry) at HSc.
- iii. Higher percentage of marks in the subject English at HSc.
- iv. Merit shall be determined by the date of birth, the older candidate being the senior.

8. Stipend

Each student admitted into the course, both to I year and II year under lateral entry, will be eligible for a Monthly Stipend of Rs. 2500/- to be paid 50% by central and 50% by state Government as per the guidelines, for the duration of course (tenable for 10 months per annum).

- i. The payment of stipend is linked to the attendance and academic performance. Accordingly, the student must have 80% of class attendance to become eligible for the monthly stipend.
- ii. The student must not have any back paper and in special cases, one back paper is allowed.
- iii. The student selected for admission will be required to submit a declaration on a non-judicial stamp- paper (Rs. 100/-) duly attested by Notary in the prescribed form.

9. Counseling and admission will be conducted on the dates as per the extant guidelines issued by the Development Commissioner for Handlooms, New Delhi.
