Minutes of the 5<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the General Council of Indian Sign Language Research and Training Centre (ISLRTC) held under the Chairpersonship of Smt. Shakuntala Gamlin, Secretary, DEPwD and President, General Council, ISLRTC on 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2019 at 03.00 PM in the Conference Room, Pt. Deendayal Antyodaya Bhawan, CGO Complex, New Delhi-03.

The 5<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the General Council of ISLRTC was held under the Chairpersonship of Secretary, DEPwD & President, General Council, ISLRTC on 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2019 at 03:00 PM in the Conference Room, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, B-III Block at Pt. Deendayal Antyodaya Bhawan, C.G.O. Complex, New Delhi-03. The list of participants is at **Annexure-I.** 

Smt. Shakuntala D. Gamlin, Secretary, DEPwD & President, GC, ISLRTC welcomed the members and briefed them about the progress of ISLRTC. She stated that efforts should be made to make the Centre a leading Institute in the field of Indian Sign Language and to mark its presence at International level. She also added that the Centre should have its own building to expand its activities in a big way. Thereafter, agenda items were discussed as under:-

# Item No.5.1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> General Council meeting held on 31.01.2018 in the DEPwD, CGO Complex, New Delhi.

Minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of General Council (GC) of ISLRTC held on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2018 in Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, CGO Complex, New Delhi, were confirmed.

# Item No.5.2: <u>Action Taken Report on minutes of 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of GC held on</u> 31.01.2018.

The General Council noted the action taken on the minutes of the previous meeting held on 31.01.2018.

#### Item No.5.3: Recruitment Rules for the post of Director, ISLRTC.

The General Council discussed the draft RRs for the post of Director, ISLRTC, in detail and decided that the RRs need to be reviewed keeping in view the job requirements for the post, personnel available in the country with the proposed essential qualifications and the set format of RRs regarding qualifications/eligibility.

#### Item No.5.4: Recruitment Rules for the post of Associate Professors, ISLRTC.

The General Council approved the Recruitment Rules for the posts of Associate Professors, as approved by the Executive Council in its 9<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20.08.2018 with a minor modification that clause (e) of essential qualifications may be amended as 'At least 2 Publications in National and /or international Journals', instead of 'At least 2 two publications in National and International Journals'. Approved RRs for the posts of Associate Professors as at **Annexure-II**.

## Item No.5.5: Recruitment Rules for the post of Assistant Professor- Interpreting, ISLRTC.

The General Council approved the Recruitment Rules for the post of Assistant Professor-Interpreting, as approved by the Executive Council in its 9<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20.08.2018 with modifications that clause (a) of essential qualifications may be amended as 'MA Linguistics/translation studies with good academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)', against the existing clause 'MA Linguistics/translation studies'. Further, clause (b) of essential qualification may be amended as 'Excellent Communication skills in Sign Language required (to be tested through proficiency test for Sign Language, minimum acceptable level: C of ISL)', against the existing minimum acceptable level B of ISL.

Approved RRs for the post of Assistant Professor-Interpreting as at Annexure-III.

#### Item No. 5.6: Pay Scale of the Faculty and Librarian of the Centre.

The General Council discussed the matter and recommended that the Department may take up the matter with Ministry of Finance, Dept. of Expenditure, explaining that the faculty posts in ISLRTC were initially created in UGC pay-scales with their approval. Further, the nature of work being performed by the faculty of the Centre is highly technical. The main objective of the Centre is to develop manpower for using sign language, teaching and conducting research in Indian Sign Language. The Centre, in collaboration with NCERT, is working on the plans to make NCERT textbooks accessible to hearing impaired children and their parents/teachers by converting /adapting the textbooks from Primary to Higher Secondary, subject-wise and chapter-wise into Indian Sign Language.

#### Item No. 5.7: Filling up of the post of Consultant (Deaf) in ISLRTC.

The General Council discussed the matter and decided that the post of Consultant (Deaf) may be filled up as per RRs, since the post of Director, ISLRTC has not yet been filled up on regular basis.

#### Item No. 5.8: Annual Report and Audited Accounts of ISLRTC for 2017-18.

The Council approved the Annual Report and Audited Accounts of the Centre for 2017-18.

#### Item No.5.9: Consideration of Budget proposal for 2019-20.

The Council approved the proposed budget of the Centre for the year 2019-20, as at **Annexure-IV**.

#### Item No.5.10: Any other items with permission of the Chair.

- (i) It was decided that the Centre may develop the contents for various Diploma courses and send the same to RCI.
- (ii) The Centre should work towards introducing Graduation level courses.
- (iii) Composite Regional Centres (CRCs) working under National Institutes of the Department may conduct Diploma in Sign Language Interpretation (DISLI).
- (iv) The Centre, in co-ordination with RCI, may work out the requirement of interpreters in the country.
