**Subject:- Procedure for admissions to MDS/Post Graduate Degree/Diploma Courses in Private/Unaided (Dental) Health Sciences Educational Institution– Academic Session 2016.**

1. The Governor of Haryana is pleased to notify following admission procedure to Post Graduate Degree/Diploma Course for the year 2016 onwards in the **Private/Unaided(Dental) Health Sciences Educational Institutions** in the State of Haryana.
2. The Governor of Haryana is further pleased to notify that the procedure laid herein under this Notification shall apply to all the Private/Unaided institutions falling within the purview of the Haryana Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Maintenance of Educational Standards) Act, 2012 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act' in this Notification) [A list, along with the details and allocation of seats available therein, of known institutions is appended to this Notification as Annexure to this Notification. It is obligatory for any Private/Unaided institution falling within the purview of the Act and not finding a mention in the said Annexure to immediately inform the Director, Medical Education and Research, to be included in the said Annexure]. Any admission made in exception to this Notification under the circumstances as elaborated above shall not be acknowledged as 'validly admitted students' in terms of the Act and shall remain liable to the provisions of the Act in the said regard to the said extent.
3. The Governor of Haryana is further pleased to notify that 60% of the seats will be Open Merit Category and the remaining 40% of the seats will be Management Category. Out of 40% seats of Management Category, 15% of the seats will be in the Non-resident Indian (NRI) category.
4. **Process for Admission to Open Merit Category**
  - i. The admission will be made on the basis of the relative merit in the All India Post Graduate Dental Entrance Examinations (AIPGDEE-2016) conducted by the Authority notified by Government of India.
  - ii. The relative merit, among such candidates desiring to seek admissions, shall be drawn as per the merit of AIPGDEE – 2016 in the All India Merit and the State Merit for all such candidates who have cleared

- the AIPGDEE – 2016 with or above such distinction as has been declared as minimum eligibility criteria of proficiency for granting admissions.
- iii. **In case of such AIPGDEE – 2016 qualified candidate are not available in sufficient numbers to meet the requirements, such seats remaining unfilled due to non-availability of AIPGDEE – 2016 qualified candidates shall be transferred under Management Category seats of respective colleges.**
  - iv. The prospectus and forms for applying in the General/Open Merit Category of seats for admission to Private Health Institutions will be issued by Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak and will be available with the University.
  - v. The applications for admission to General/Open Merit Category of seats shall be received by the Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak. The University shall ensure that the application form is submitted with three attested photographs of the candidate taken within one year preceding the date of submission of application form.
  - vi. The Counseling for the candidate for General/Open Merit Category of seats will be held at Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak.
  - vii. The choice(s) of courses/institutions shall be exercised by the candidate at the time of counseling/interview.
  - viii. Following shall be the composition of the Admission committee:-

- ix. The Director, Medical Education and Research, Haryana will be the final Appellate Authority in all cases of admission related disputes for all institutions and decision, in case of any dispute, made by him shall be final.
- x. The candidates applying for seats in the Open Merit Category on the basis of AIPGDEE – 2016 qualification should submit their result of the AIPGDEE – 2016 as per All India Merit/ State Merit as applicable.
- xi. Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak shall prepare the merit list of the candidates appearing for the counseling on the basis of AIPGDEE – 2016 result of All India Merit/ State Merit.
- xii. One year compulsory Rotatory Internship shall be an essential pre-qualification for acquiring eligibility for admission to Post Graduate Degree/Diploma Course for the year 2016. The cutoff date for completion of internship shall be 31st March of Corresponding year for Dental Graduation. However, the candidates who have passed their BDS Course prior to 1991 and are registered with the Haryana Dental Council will be exempted from the applications of this pre-condition.
- xiii. Candidates applying on basis of AIPGDEE – 2016 should fulfill the eligibility criteria for being granted admission as fixed under AIPGDEE – 2016.
- xiv. In case of a tie between two or more candidates having equal Marks/Merit, the *inter se* raking of such candidates shall be determined by the following factors in the following order of preference:-
  - (a) Candidates with higher aggregate marks in qualifying examination.
  - (b) Candidates older in age.
- xv. The allotment in the specialty and allocation to the institution shall be made by the Admission Committee on the basis of AIPGDEE – 2016 merit of the candidate. The choice of the specialty and station by the candidate at the time of the counseling shall be taken as final.
- xvi. Personal appearance in the counseling/interview of the candidate shall be compulsory.

- xvii. If the candidate once admitted drops out or leave the Post Graduate Degree Course in between he/she shall be debarred for a period of three years for seeking admission to any PG Course in the State of Haryana. However, a student admitted to a Post Graduate Diploma Course shall not be debarred for admission to Post Degree Course. The University shall display the list of the names and addresses etc. of such debarred persons.
- xviii. In case there is a vacancy after the first round of admission/counseling for any reason, such seats shall be filled through the same process in the Second/Third counseling as the case may be. However, no such subsequent process shall be undertaken after the prescribed last date of admission.
- xix. Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak may fix and charge processing fee for counseling and further, determine and charge the cost of the prospectus, etc.
- xx. Even if the candidate is having PG Diploma, he/she should be allowed to choice of subject as per merit, irrespective of the subject in which he holds such diploma.
- xxi. Candidates shall give a declaration that they have not abandoned the Post Graduate seats after opting for admission or after getting admitted in Post Graduate Courses in the State of Haryana.

#### **5. Admission to Management Category**

- i. Admission to Management Category will be done strictly in a fair and transparent manner by adhering to the Directions of the Government of India/ Dental Council of India.
- ii. The admissions will be made in the following order –
  - On the basis of Relative merit in AIPGDEE-2016
  - On the basis of Relative State Merit in AIPGDEE-2016
  - Relative merit in Common Competitive Entrance Examination approved by the State Government.
- iii. Candidates interested in seeking admission under Management Category shall apply online on the website of the Examination Body approved by the State Government for conducting examination for the Management seats.
- iv. The Prospectus and the Forms for applying in the Management Category of seats for admission to Private Health Institutions will be issued by the respective institution and the same shall be uploaded on their respective websites.
- v. The Private Health Institutions will widely publicize by way of advertisements in leading newspapers and publicizing the same on their respective websites- the place of sale of prospectus, the Last Date for sale & receipt of Application forms and other relevant information.
- vi. There shall be a Centralized Counseling for Management Category seats for all the Private/Unaided Dental Institutes under the close observation of Observer appointed by University Health Sciences, Rohtak and State Observer appointed by Director, Medical Education & Research. No counseling shall be held in individual institutions.
- vii. In case there is a vacancy after the first round of admission/counseling for any reason, such seats shall be filled through the same process in the Second/Third counseling as the case may be. However, no such subsequent process shall be undertaken after the prescribed last date of admission.
- viii. Left over seats under NRI category shall also be filled up under the Management category.

#### **6. Fee structure for all categories of seats**

The fee structure for all the categories of seats will be as under:-

- i. The fees will be Rs. 6.85 lac per annum per student for MDS/PG Diploma Course, which will include tuition fee and Development Charges. This fee is subject to any modification authorized by the Government or any other competent authority empowered to change it.
- ii. The fee will be payable on annual basis.
- iii. The fee shall be Refunded/Adjusted if candidate is shifted from one institute to another in the subsequent counseling on operation of the waiting list. If the said fee is not Refunded/ Adjusted within 15 days, the said institution will be liable to pay Bank interest as well as Penal interest to the said

student as laid by RBI. Fee will be deposited by the successful candidates to the respective institution in shape of Demand Draft.

- iv. Hostel, Mess, Library and Security Charges, etc. will be charged and levied in addition to the tuition fee and development fee i.e. Rs. 6.85 lac. However, such charges proposed to be levied must be notified to the Director General, Medical Education & Research, Haryana by each individual institution and his approval must be obtained before receiving these charges from the students.

#### 7. Admission to NRI Category

Category I: Actual NRI candidates who originally belong to the State of Haryana.

Category II: Children/ Wards of NRI who originally belong to the State of Haryana.

Category III: Actual NRI who originally belong to an Indian State and Union Territories other than Haryana.

Category IV: Children/ Wards of NRI who originally belong to an Indian State and Union Territories other than Haryana.

- i. If sufficient numbers of eligible candidates under first category are available then they will be admitted first even if students under subsequent category are higher in merit.
  - ii. The NRI students will have to give a bank guarantee/surety bond for the balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in installment as provided.
  - iii. Any seats remaining vacant under NRI/Sports category till last date of admission shall go to the Management category.
  - iv. It will be obligatory on the part of University to provide registration number to all candidates once duly admitted.
  - v. Merit should be the priority for NRI Seats.
8. The Director General, Medical Education & Research, Haryana will be the final Appellate Authority in all cases of admission related disputes for all institutions and decisions, in case of any dispute, made by him shall be final.

## निर्देश

दिनांक 31 मार्च, 2016

**संख्या 19/6/2016-5P.**— ऊर्जा संरक्षण अधिनियम, 2001 (2001 का केन्द्रीय अधिनियम 52), की धारा 18 द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए, हरियाणा के राज्यपाल, इसके द्वारा उपरोक्त ऊर्जा संरक्षण भवन संहिता को लागू करने के लिए निम्नलिखित निर्देश जारी करते हैं, अर्थात्:—

1. **परिभाषाएं.**— इन निर्देशों में, जब तक संदर्भ से अन्यथा अपेक्षित न हो,—
  - (क). “केवीए” से अभिप्राय है किलोवॉल्ट—एम्पीयर;
  - (ख). “केडब्ल्यू” से अभिप्राय है किलोवाट;
  - (ग). “विहित प्राधिकरण” से अभिप्राय है, भवन नक्शों को स्वीकृत करने, भवनों का निरीक्षण करने, और/अथवा परियोजना विकासकों या उनके प्राधिकृत अभिकर्ताओं को समापन/अधिभोग प्रमाण पत्र जारी करने से सम्बंधित सुसंगत विधि द्वारा सशक्त सम्बद्ध विभाग अर्थात् स्थानीय निकाय या संगठन या प्राधिकरण;
  - (घ). “परियोजना विकासक” से अभिप्राय है, भवन समूह का स्वामी।
2. इन निर्देशों में प्रयुक्त किंतु अपरिभाषित शब्दों तथा अभिव्यक्तियों के वही अर्थ होंगे जो उन्हें क्रमशः ऊर्जा संरक्षण अधिनियम, 2001 तथा ऊर्जा संरक्षण भवन संहिता में दिए गए हैं;
3. ऊर्जा संरक्षण भवन संहिता के उपबन्ध 100 केडब्ल्यू या इससे अधिक के सम्बद्ध भार अथवा 120 केवीए या इससे अधिक अनुबन्ध मांग वाले सूचीबद्ध सभी वाणिज्यिक भवनों के प्रवर्गों को लागू होंगे.—
  - (i) व्यावसायिक समूहों, शॉपिंग माल्स, व्यवसायिक भवनों;
  - (ii) होटल्स, मोटल्स, रेस्तरां, ट्रांजिट कम बोर्डिंग हाउस, समारोह स्थल, जंज घर, सैरगाह;
  - (iii) सिनेमाघर, सभागार, क्लब, गौष्ठी केन्द्र, संगीत हाल;
  - (iv) कार्यालय भवन, बैंक, जन सहायता संस्थाएं;
  - (v) अस्पताल, संस्थागत देखभाल केन्द्र, संस्थागत भवन, सूचना एवं प्रौद्योगिकी पार्क, साईबर पार्क तथा व्यावसायिक प्रोसेस आउटसोर्सिंग भवन;
4. ये निर्देश उपरोक्त क्रम संख्या 3 में विनिर्दिष्ट वाणिज्यिक भवनों पर लागू होंगे जिनका भवन नक्शों राजपत्र में इन निर्देशों के प्रकाशन की तिथि के 120 दिन के बाद विहित प्राधिकरण को प्रस्तुत किए गए हों।
5. कोई भी भवन नक्शा किसी विहित प्राधिकरण द्वारा इन निर्देशों के लागू होने के बाद तब तक स्वीकृत नहीं किया जाएगा जब तक वे नक्शे ऊर्जा संरक्षण भवन संहिता में उपबंधित विशिष्टियों के अनुरूप न हों। इस प्रयोजन के लिए परियोजना विकासकों अथवा उनके प्राधिकृत अभिकर्ताओं से किसी पंजीकृत वास्तुकार द्वारा जारी प्रमाण पत्र यह पुष्टि करते हुए कि भवन नक्शा ऊर्जा संरक्षण भवन संहिता और ऊर्जा दक्षता ब्यूरो, भारत सरकार के द्वारा निर्धारित प्रारूपों के अनुरूप है, सहित भवन नक्शा प्रस्तुत करने की अपेक्षा की जाएगी।
6. उपरोक्त उपबन्धों के अनुसार भवन नक्शा स्वीकृत करने के दौरान, विहित प्राधिकरण भवन संरचना के विभिन्न चरणों को विनिर्दिष्ट करेगा जिन पर भवन ऊर्जा संरक्षण भवन संहिता की अनुपालना सुनिश्चित करने के लिए इसके निरीक्षित किया जाएगा।
7. सभी उन भवनों को, जिन पर ये निर्देश लागू हैं, समापन प्रमाणपत्र केवल तभी दिया जाएगा यदि वे ऊर्जा संरक्षण भवन संहिता के अनुसार निर्मित किए गए हैं तथा भवन योजना इन निर्देशों के अनुसार स्वीकृत की गई है।
8. विहित प्राधिकरण ऐसे भवनों की, जिन पर यह निर्देश लागू हैं, एक पंजिका बनाएगा तथा अक्षय ऊर्जा विभाग को इन निर्देशों के लागू होने के उपरांत स्वीकृत किए गए भवनों अथवा जारी किए गए समापन प्रमाणपत्रों की सूची सहित त्रैमासिक सूचना भेजेगा।
9. यदि परियोजना विकासक अथवा उसका अभिकर्ता द्वारा ऊर्जा संरक्षण भवन संहिता के उपबन्धों अथवा इन निर्देशों के किन्हीं उपबन्धों की उल्लंघना करता है तो विहित प्राधिकरण द्वारा ऐसे परियोजना विकासक के विरुद्ध उपयुक्त कार्यवाही की जाएगी जिसमें निरस्तीकरण अथवा समापन सर अधिभोग प्रमाणपत्र की मनाही अथवा ऐसी अन्य शास्ति, जो विहित की जाए, भी शामिल हो सकती हैं।
10. ऊर्जा संरक्षण भवन संहिता को कड़ाई से लागू करने के लिए तथा इसके उल्लंघन की दशा में शास्तियाँ विहित करने के लिए विहित प्राधिकरण राजपत्र में इन निर्देशों के प्रकाशित होने की तिथि से चार मास की अवधि के भीतर अपनी भवन उपविधियों में संशोधन करेगा।

**Directions**

The 31st March, 2016

**No. 19/6/2016-5P.**— In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 18 of the Energy Conservation Act, 2001 (Central Act 52 of 2001), the Governor of Haryana hereby issue the following directions for enforcement of the Energy Conservation Building Code, namely:-

1. **Definitions.**- In these directions, unless the context otherwise requires,—
  - (a) “kVA” means kilovolt-Ampere;
  - (b) “kW” means kilowatt;
  - (c) “Prescribed authority” means the concerned department i.e. local body or organization or authority, empowered by relevant law to sanction building plans; to inspect the building; and/or to issue the completion/occupation certificate to the project developers or their authorized agents.
  - (d) “Project developer” means the owner of the building complex.
2. Words and expressions used and not defined above but defined in the Energy Conservation Act, 2001 (Central Act 52 of 2001) and Energy Conservation Building Code, shall have meanings respectively assigned to them in that Act/Code.
3. The provisions of Energy Conservation Building Code shall be applicable to all buildings of categories listed below having connected load of 100 KW or above or a contract demand of 120 KVA or above,-
  - (i) Commercial Complexes, Shopping Malls, Trade Buildings.
  - (ii) Hotels, Motels, Restaurants, Transit-cum-Boarding Houses, Banquet Halls, Janj Ghars, Resorts.
  - (iii) Cinema Halls, Auditoriums, Clubs, Convention Centers, Concert Halls.
  - (iv) Office Buildings, Banks, Public Assistance Institutions.
  - (v) Hospitals, Institutional Care Centers, Institutional Buildings, Information and Technology Parks, Cyber Parks and Business Process Outsourcing (BPO) Buildings.
4. These directions shall be applicable on the buildings specified in Serial Number 3 above, of which the building plans are submitted to the prescribed authority 120 days after the date of publication of these directions in the Official Gazette.
5. No building plans shall be sanctioned by any prescribed authority after coming into force of these directions unless those plans confirm to the specifications provided in the Energy Conservation Building Code. For this purpose the project developers or their authorized agents shall be required to submit, a certificate issued by a Registered Architect confirming that the building plans confirm to the Energy Conservation Building Code along with the building plan and formats prescribed by Bureau of Energy Efficiency / Government of India.
6. While sanctioning the building plan in accordance with the aforesaid provisions, the prescribed authority shall specify various stages of construction of the building at which the building shall be got inspected by it to ensure strict adherence to the Energy Conservation Building Code.
7. The completion certificate to all those buildings on which these directions are applicable shall be granted only if they are constructed in accordance with the Energy Conservation Building Code and the building plan sanctioned in accordance with these directions.
8. The prescribed authority shall maintain a register of the buildings to which these directions are applicable and send a quarterly information to the Department of Renewable Energy containing therein a list of the buildings sanctioned or completion certificates awarded after coming into force of these directions.
9. In case a project developer or his agent violates the provisions of the Energy Conservation Building Code, or any provisions of these directions, appropriate action shall be taken against such project developer by the prescribed authority which may include cancellation or denial of the completion or occupation certificate or such other penalty as may be prescribed.
10. The prescribed authority shall amend its building Bye-Laws within a period of four months from the date of publication of these directions in the Official Gazette for strict enforcement of the Energy Conservation Building Code and for prescribing penalties in case of its violation.
