Regarding mentioning of correct date of Work Orders in the online generated

JCRs of solar pumps through PM-KUSUM Portal.

In continuation of the above-referenced letter, wherein all district officers were instructed to utilize the PM-KUSUM Portal for generating and downloading the compiled list of JCRs and the 90-day RMS completion report for solar pumps, it has been observed that incorrect work order dates are being recorded on the portal in some cases. This happened because the correct date was not entered on the portal for some cases and the portal automatically picked the date on which the pump was allotted to the vendor. Further, work orders are issued physically and after that the date of the work order is entered on the portal by M/s Advait Energy Transitions Limited, but still the date of some work orders is to be uploaded/corrected. Consequently, the incorrect dates are reflected on the portal, leading to the issuance of JCRs with inaccurate work

In view of the above, all district officers are requested to manually correct the work order dates in the online-generated JCRs before issuing them.
