- Contractual Payment Management System



A system that facilitates the flow of funds between the state and central governments for Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS). It's designed to improve cash management and release funds "just-in-time".

Uses an integrated network of State IFMIS, PFMS, and RBI's e-kuber. The system allows for the monitoring of fund release by central ministries, departments, and state governments.

Helps to return unspent funds to the Consolidated Fund of India (CFI) and the Consolidated Fund of the State.

Helps to monitor the utilization of funds released for CSS. It helps to facilitate more effective cash management.

Single Nodal Agency (SNA) is responsible for managing funds for Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS).


Implementing Agencies (IAs) are responsible for making payments to vendors and beneficiaries. The IAs generate payment files in the State Integrated Financial Management Information System (State IFMIS).

Works Accounting System is a specialized financial management tool designed to handle the accounting needs of construction and infrastructure projects. It ensures accurate tracking, reporting and management of financial transactions related to various work projects.

It handles funds that are not routed through Treasuries. These funds are held in the bank accounts of the Departments, and both receipts and expenditures are processed directly by the respective Departments.

# Application Coverage



## At each MC level:

- The proposals and various requests are submitted by the Councillors to the concerned MCs.
- After scrutiny and adding estimates/other necessary documents, the proposals are sent to the House Secretary through the hierarchy starting from HoD, Joint Commissioner, Commissioner and Mayor of the concerned MC.
- Agendas are prepared and resolutions are passed by the concerned MCs.
- After adding Commissioner comments, each Municipal Corporation/Council submits the resolutions to the Local Government for approval.

## e-Ward Area Management

- Councillors may send complaints, information or demands of wards to the respective MCs and know the action taken on their requests.
- Ward-wise Monitoring of projects/works

## At Local Government level:

- The Director LG has options either for approval, rejection, sending back for clarification, taking comments from experts at State level or sending for approval to the higher authority of Local Govt. viz. Secretary, Minister and Chief Minister.
- After approval of the resolutions, the Local Govt. authority has to monitor the implementation of approved resolutions in various Municipal Corporations/Councils of Punjab.
- Local Govt. authorities has option to monitor the activities of Wards in each MC of the Punjab.







## Old DISE

DISE is a randomization software based on Client/Server architecture for Election Department for formation of various parties/teams, EVM machines etc. as per ECI guidelines and has been developed using Microsoft Technology. The software is designed to handle Assembly, Parliament, Panchayat and Municipal Elections. DISE-MC, DISE-GP and DISE-ZP are randomization softwares developed for State Election Commission to handle Elections for Municipal Corporation, Zila Parishad and Gram Panchayat Elections respectively.

**Besides Punjab, DISE is being used in Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Delhi, Chandigarh, Mizoram and Manipur**

## Challenges of Client/Server DISE

Technology used is very old and obsolete.

There are compatibility issues with newer Operating Systems and database software's

As the technology used is obsolete, it is difficult to maintain and support.

Seagate Crystal reports is out-of-date hence difficult to maintain existing reports and incorporate new reports

Data entry and consolidation is difficult because data entry capsule is installed in various offices and the data entered by offices is consolidated in district election offices through CDs or USB Drives.

Installation and configuration is difficult because of obsolete technology

Web-based Application for importing available employees data from iHRMS/ Treasury using APIs/ CSV/ Excel files.

Random distribution of staff among various venues and scheduling of rehearsals.

Management of Exemptions, Absentees & Cancellations etc.

Generation of Duty Orders, Form 12, 12A and EDC etc.

Identity cards with photo for staff deployed on election duty.

Flexibility to tweak selection criteria depending upon the availability of staff in the districts.

Role based Dashboards and various types of reports.

Regular alerts and updates to the stakeholders using SMS.

AI model for detecting discrepancies in submitted data (Gender Classification AI model)

Implemented successfully in Punjab for General Election'24 to Loksabha, covering 13 PCs, 23 districts, 117 ACs and 24522 polling stations.


Replicated successfully for Loksabha 2024 Elections in Himachal Pradesh for all 4 PCs, 68 ACs and 7618 polling stations.

NCT Delhi has tested the software during Lok Sabha elections and it will be implemented for upcoming elections to State Legislative Assembly scheduled to be held in February 2025.


## YOJNA App

## District Dashboard Fatehgarh Sahib


This mobile app has been developed in house for providing and dissemination of more and more information
