Meghalaya-eCabinet Launched 30th September 2025

The Chief Minister of Meghalaya, Shri Conrad K. Sangma, launched the Meghalaya-eCabinet at the Cabinet Room, Yojana Bhavan Shillong on the 30th Sept. 2025 in the presence of the Cabinet Ministers, Chief Secretary, Shri D. P. Wahlang, IAS, Commissioner & Secretary IT Department Shri. Pravin K Bakshi IAS, Commissioner & Secretary Cabinet Affairs Department, Shri Cyril V. D. Diengdoh IAS, Shri Santhosh V T, SIO NIC Meghalaya, officials from NIC Meghalaya and officials from Cabinet Affairs Department.

Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Minister said that with the introduction of Meghalaya-eCabinet, the Government has achieved a significant milestone in transforming the Cabinet Meetings from the paper based meeting to a paperless platform. He appraised the Cabinet Ministers to use the Android Tab provided, in all Cabinet Meetings in the future. The Agenda for the meeting schedule on 30th Sept has been digitized and for the first time, the Ministers browsed through the Agenda Items on the tab itself.

The Honourable Chief Minister congratulated the NIC Team for bringing the new transition into the Cabinet Meetings of Meghalaya.

The Chief Secretary also congratulated and commented on the efforts taken by NIC in the designing and developing of the Meghalaya-eCabinet as per the requirements specified.

Shri. Benos Lyngskor, Scientist-F & Addl. SIO made a short presentation and demonstration of the application to the distinguished participants followed by a short video on the application.

The Commissioner Secretary of Cabinet Affairs department briefed the Honourable Chief Minister that the Meghalaya-eCabinet Application is already integrated with the eProposal/eFile system of the State Government. He also made it clarified to the participants that the integration made it possible for the department officials to do their work with Single-Sign in.

Meghalaya-eCabinet is an online solution designed to digitize the processes involved in conducting Cabinet meetings of the Councils of Ministers. It streamlines tasks such as the submission and preparation of all documents required before the meeting is scheduled. It facilitates the handling of documents like Cabinet Memos, Notices, Agenda, Minutes, and Endorsements.

The Meghalaya-eCabinet workflow is divided into two major components (i) Online Web portal and (ii) Mobile App. The web portal is developed for the officials of the administrative departments, Cabinet Affairs Department, Chief Secretary and Chief Minister. The Mobile App is only for the use of the Chief Minister, Cabinet Ministers and Chief Secretary for viewing Cabinet Meeting related information.

The application is designed with the following security features enabled

- Two-level authentication login process is enabled.
- Departments will be able to view the documents submitted by their own department only.
- Cabinet Affairs Department, Commissioner & Secretary of Cabinet Affairs Department, Chief Secretary and Hon Chief Minister only will have access to documents of all departments.
- Cabinet memos once uploaded into the system will have a Watermark "Confidential Document" throughout the document.
- The App has been designed for the Cabinet Ministers, where they will be able to view the documents related to the Meeting like Notices, Agenda and Cabinet Memo.
- For security reasons, desired by Chief Secretary, the Cabinet memos are made not downloadable and screenshots are disabled from the registered Android device for security reason.
