

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs) for JEE (Main) - 2022

Section I (Changes for JEE (Main) – 2022)		
S. No.	Parameter	JEE (Main) - 2022
1.	Number of Sessions	It will be conducted in Two Sessions (April/May) . During the Registration, in the first session, only Session 1 (April) will be visible, and Session 2 (May) will be visible when the window will be opened again.
2.	Authentication of Mobile Number and e-mail Address	When Candidates register, they have to enter the OTP received at their registered Mobile Number, and before submitting the fees, they have to enter the OTP received at their registered e-mail address.
3.	Correction Facility	No correction facility will be given at any stage under any circumstances.
4.	Choice of Cities	The Choice of exam cities will be displayed to the candidates based on the permanent and Present address filled in the Online Application Form.
5.	Parents/Guardian Income details	Family Annual Income (inclusive of Father's/ Guardian's Gross Annual Income, Mother's/ Guardian's Gross Annual Income, and Annual Income of Father's/ Mother's/ Guardian's from other sources, if any) is a mandatory field.
6.	E-mailing the Confirmation page and Scorecard	A copy of the Confirmation Page and final Score Card will be sent to the registered e-mail address of the candidates.
7.	SANDES Application	Candidates are requested to download and install the SANDES Application on their smartphone as a secondary channel (apart from SMS/E-mail) to receive notifications from NTA.
8.	Online Application Form	For ease of the candidates, Application Form has been upgraded so that candidates can fill the Application Form in small sections. The updated process is as below - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Step 1 - Registration Form ➤ Step 2 - Application Form And this includes filling of personal details, applying for examination cities, qualification details, additional details (if any), and document upload) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Step 3 - Fee Payment.
9.	Photograph of the Candidate	Cross-checking of the photograph in real-time is being done during filling in the Online Application Form.
10.	AADHAAR Number	A column/field has been added in the Online Application Form for capturing the AADHAAR number of the candidates and it will be on a voluntary basis. The candidate will be asked to verify their particulars i.e. Name, Date of Birth, and Gender, and authenticate again. If not matched, the candidate has to select the second radio button - <i>My Information on Aadhaar is not the same as entered in the Application Form</i> and then proceed further.
11.	Use of Scribe	Scribe will be provided by the NTA as per the norms.
12.	Umang and DigiLocker	NTA is facilitating to all candidates with an additional platform of UMANG and DigiLocker to download their documents like Confirmation Page, Admit Card, Score Cards, etc.
13.	Negative Marking	There will be Negative Marking for both Sections i.e. Section A (MCQ) and Section B (Numerical value).
14.	Is there any link available where the candidate can practice or get familiar with the CBT mode examination?	Candidates can familiarize themselves with logging into the system, go through the detailed instructions regarding the test, use the mouse or numeric keyboard on-screen (virtual) for attempting each question, scroll down to the next question, navigate between questions, review and edit their options and submit answer at the mock link: https://test.cbexams.com/Jeepractice/login.aspx

1	What is JEE (Main) - 2022?	The Joint Entrance Examination, JEE (Main) comprises two papers. Paper 1 is conducted for admission to Undergraduate Engineering Programs (B.E/B.Tech.) at NITs, IITs, other Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs), Institutions/Universities funded/recognized by participating State Governments. JEE (Main) is also an eligibility test for JEE (Advanced), which is conducted for admission to IITs. Paper 2 is conducted for admission to B. Arch and B. Planning courses in the Country.
2.	What is the responsibility of NTA for, JEE (Main) - 2022?	NTA has been established as a premier, specialist, autonomous, and self-sustained testing organization to conduct entrance examination (JEE (Main)-2022) for admission to Undergraduate Engineering Programs at NITs, IITs, other Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs), Institutions/Universities funded/recognized by participating State.
3.	When will the Online Application form for JEE (Main) – 2022 Session 1 be available on the website?	The Online Application Form for JEE (Main) - 2022 is available from 01.03.2022 to 31.03.2022 (up to 17:00) on the website https://jeemain.nta.nic.in/ for Session 1 .
4.	When will JEE (Main) - 2022 Examination be conducted?	The tentative date of examinations are as follows: Session- 1: 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 April 2022 Session -2: 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 and 29 May 2022
5.	Whether the examination will be offline or online?	JEE (Main) - 2022 Examination will be held in “Computer Based Test” (CBT) Mode only, except that the Drawing Test for B.Arch. will be held in “Pen & Paper” (offline) mode.
6.	How to fill up the ‘Online’ Application Form for JEE (Main)-2022? Are there any guidelines for the students before filling out the application form?	Yes, instructions to apply online for JEE (Main) - 2022 are available in the Information Bulletin under the heading ‘ Important Information at Glance ’. For more details please go through the Information Bulletin Appendix-VII (Replica of Application Form)
7.	Whether a candidate has to fill up the separate Application Form for each session?	Yes. Candidates can fill up the Application Form and pay the requisite examination fee for each session separately at the time of opening the portal for that session. Note: The candidate can not apply for both sessions together.
8.	What action is to be taken if the candidate has opted for English as a medium for examination and wants to appear in the Hindi medium?	The medium should be filled up while applying online. However, in CBT mode, the candidate can also choose/select his/her opted medium of Question Paper during the examination.
9.	Is Thumb Impression mandatory while filling JEE (Main) - 2022 Application?	There is no need to upload a thumb impression in the online Application Form of JEE (Main) - 2022.
10.	What should I do, if ‘continuous timeout’ or ‘file not found error’ occurs while filling the online Application Form of JEE (Main)-2022?	Use an updated version of Mozilla Firefox/Google chrome and a good internet connection while filling out the Application Form. In case of continuous-time out clear cookies and history of the browser and fill in off-peak hours.
11.	Can Candidates require to	No. Candidates are not required to send/submit any

	send/submit any document(s) including Confirmation Page to NTA through Post/ Fax/ By Hand?	document(s) including Confirmation Page to NTA through Post/Fax/WhatsApp/Email/by Hand.
12.	Is it mandatory to upload Gen-EWS, SC, ST,OBC (NCL), and PwD certificates?	Yes, Gen-EWS/SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/PwD candidates are required to upload original certificates as per prescribed formats issued by the Competent Authority of their respective State. In case, any candidate does not have the certificate readily available with him/her, he/she can upload the self-undertaking as available in the Information Bulletin.
13.	If any candidate did not apply for Session 1, can he/she apply for session 2?	Yes, if a candidate has missed filling up the Application Form for Session 1, he/she can fill up the Application Form for Session 2 at the time of opening the portal for that session. The Application window for Session 2 will be re-opened later on.
14.	Whether a candidate can appear in any one session or has to appear in both Sessions?	It is the choice of the candidate. A candidate need not appear in both Sessions. However, if a candidate appears in more than one Session then his/her best of the JEE (Main) - 2022 NTA Scores will be considered for preparation of Merit List/ Ranking.
15.	Will NTA reserve its discretion to fix the center in a city which is given in Appendix-I ?	As far as possible, the exam centres are allotted as per the choice of cities of the candidates made in their online Application form. Efforts are made to allot the centre as per their choice (s) and within city jurisdiction. However, due to administrative/logistic reasons, a different city may be allotted.
16.	Can a center be allotted by the NTA manually?	No.
17.	The dates of Examination of JEE (Main) - 2022 clashes with any other National/State level examination.	NTA will check the issue, and rectify it as per the availability of examination dates.
18.	How can I select the Date and Slot of Examination of JEE (Main) - 2022?	Date/shift/slot of examination is allotted by computer randomly which is required for the normalization process. Hence the choice of date and shift/slot cannot be provided by the candidate himself/herself.
19.	In case, the Candidate has uploaded a Blue Signature instead of a Black Signature in the application form of JEE (Main) - 2022. Is it okay?	No, your Application Form will not be rejected merely for this mistake.
20.	Is there any helpline for JEE (Main) - 2022 examination for the aspirants?	Yes. Details of Helpline Numbers and Email are as follows: The Helpline Nos.- <u>01169227700</u> and <u>011-40759000</u> E-mail: jeemain@nta.ac.in
21.	Can the Candidate correct/change his/her particulars including the City of Exam Centre in the Online Application Form?	As per the instructions given to the candidates for filling up their Online Application Form, they are supposed to fill up their particulars in the same care and NTA is not responsible for any mistake committed by them in this regard.

		Moreover, no opportunity will be provided to the candidates for any corrections once the Application Form is submitted.
22.	Can anyone cancel the application submitted for JEE (Main) - 2022?	Online Application forms once submitted successfully cannot be cancelled/ withdrawn.
23.	Can anyone submit the multiple Application forms with the same mobile no. and Email ID?	For each Application, the e-mail address will be unique.
24.	Is it mandatory to fill in the Parents/Guardian Income Details?	Yes, Family Annual Income (inclusive of Father's/ Guardian's Gross Annual Income, Mother's/ Guardian's Gross Annual Income, and Annual Income of Father's/ Mother's/ Guardian's from other sources, if any) And it will be a mandatory field.
25.	How will the Candidate get the confirmation Page of the JEE (Main) - 2022?	The Confirmation Page of the online Application Form for a session will be generated only after successful payment of the fee by the Candidate. <i>A copy of the Confirmation Page of JEE (Main) - 2022 will be sent to the registered e-mail address of the Candidates.</i>
26.	If one does not get Admit Card, whom should be contacted?	<i>The Candidates may please note that Admit Cards will not be sent by post.</i> The candidate has to download the Admit Card from the NTA website https://jeemain.nta.nic.in/ . For any assistance, candidates can call the NTA Helpline numbers: 011 40759000 or 011 69227700 or write to NTA at: https://jeemain.nta.nic.in/ .
27.	Can a candidate change the examination Center after the allotment of roll number?	City of allotted Examination Centre cannot be changed, in any case. Note: Choice of exam cities displayed to the candidates will be based on the permanent and correspondence addresses filled during the Online Application Form of JEE (Main) – 2022.
28.	What do the candidates need to bring to the exam center?	The candidate is required to bring the following to the Examination Centre: Admit Card along with passport size photograph affixed on it. One passport-size photograph is to be affixed on the attendance sheet. Candidates are advised not to bring any other items to the examination centers. There will be no arrangement for the safekeeping of any material at the Centre. Neither NTA nor the Centre will be responsible for any loss, delay, etc. Please refer to Information Bulletin for details.
29.	Will any candidate be able to leave early if he finishes the test before the allocated test time?	No, the candidate will not be allowed to leave the examination hall/room before the test concludes.
30.	How to download and install the SANDES App on Mobile Device?	The SANDES APP can be downloaded and installed on Mobile devices. Steps to download/install this App are as follow: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit the Google Play Store on your Mobile Device. • Search for the “Sandes App” in the search bar.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It then displays the app in the play store. • Click on Install, and then the app gets downloaded into your mobile. • Now, mobile users can enjoy the services of the Sandes Mobile App.
31.	Is it mandatory to download and install the SANDES App?	<i>Candidates are requested to download and install the SANDES application as a secondary channel to receive time to time notifications/updates from NTA.</i>
32.	What will be the advantages of Two Sessions in JEE (Main) - 2022?	<p>The JEE (Main) - 2022 will be conducted in 02 (two) Sessions for admissions in the next academic session. The candidates will thus benefit in the following ways:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) This will give two times opportunities to the candidates to improve their scores in the examination if they are not able to give their best in one attempt. (2) In the first attempt, the students will get a first-hand experience of taking an examination and will know their mistakes which they can improve while attempting for the next time. (3) This will reduce the chances of dropping a year and droppers would not have to waste a full year. (4) If anyone missed the examination due to reasons beyond control (such as the Board examination), then he/she will not have to wait for one full year. (5) A candidate need not appear in both Sessions. However, if a candidate appears in more than one Session then his/her best of the JEE (Main) - 2022 NTA Scores will be considered for preparation of Merit List/ Ranking.
33.	Whether NTA has changed the syllabus of JEE (Main) - 2022?	<p>No, the syllabus of JEE (Main) - 2022 is the same as that of the last year. However, keeping in view the decision taken by different Boards all over India, NTA has decided that there will be a total of 90 Questions in the Question Paper and the candidates will be required to attempt 75 questions only.</p> <p>The syllabus is available in Appendix-VI in the Information Bulletin available on the website https://jeemain.nta.nic.in/.</p>
34.	Is there any Negative Marking in the JEE (Main) - 2022?	<i>There is negative marking in both Sections i.e. Section A (MCQ-type questions) and Section B (Numerical value).</i>
35.	What is the duration of the examination of the Timing of the Examination for those candidates who wish to appear for B. Arch as well as B.Planning?	Those candidates who wish to appear for Paper 2A , as well as Paper 2B , will have the duration of the examination 3.30 hrs. i.e. from 3:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.
36.	What is the duration/timing/shift of JEE (Main) - 2022	Duration, Shift & Timing of examination is available at Important dates (IMPORTANT INFORMATION AT A GLANCE) in the Information Bulletin of JEE (Main) - 2022. Please refer to Information Bulletin for details.

37.	How will one know the result of the JEE (Main) - 2022?	The result of JEE (Main) - 2022 will be uploaded on the NTA website www.nta.ac.in and https://jeemain.nta.nic.in/ as per schedule. Moreover, a <i>copy of the Final Scorecard of JEE (Main) – 2022 will be sent to the registered e-mail address of the Candidates.</i>
Section - III Eligibility Criteria		
1.	What is the minimum eligibility criteria/qualification for appearing in JEE (Main) - 2022?	Only those candidates who have passed the Class 12/equivalent examination in 2020, 2021, or those who are appearing in Class 12/equivalent examination in 2022 , are eligible to appear in JEE (Main) - 2022. For more details refer to the Information Bulletin.
2.	What are the age limit/relaxation criteria for the candidates appearing in JEE (Main) - 2022?	For appearing in the JEE (Main) - 2022, there is no age limit for the candidates. The candidates who have passed the class 12/equivalent examination in 2020, 2021, or appearing in 2022 irrespective of their age can appear in JEE (Main) - 2022 examination. However, the candidates may be required to fulfill the age criteria of the Institute(s) in which they are desirous of taking admission.
3.	What will be the pattern of examinations?	The Question Paper has been divided into two sections. There will be 90 Questions in the Paper 1 and candidates will be required to attempt 75 questions only. There will be no negative marking for 15 optional questions. Paper-wise details are as follows: B.E./B.Tech. (Paper 1-): Each Subject will have two sections. Section A will be of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs) and Section B will contain Questions whose answers are to be filled in as a numerical value. In Section B, candidates have to attempt any five questions out of 10. B. Arch. (Paper 2A)-: *Part -1 will have two sections. Section A will be of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs) and Section B will contain Questions whose answers are to be filled in as a numericalvalue. In Section B, candidates have to attempt any five questions out of 10. B. Planning (Paper 2B)-: * Part -1 will have two sections. Section A will be of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs) and Section B will contain Questions whose answers are to be filled in as a numericalvalue. In Section B, candidates have to attempt any five questions out of 10.
4.	How do I accept the choice of attempting Five Questions in Section B of Paper 2A & 2B?	You can select any five questions, you wish to answer. You are also allowed to change the answers to the selected questions before final submission. You can select questions different from the ones selected by you earlier and answer them before the final submission of the Question Paper. At any point in time, you will be permitted to answer only five questions in Section B.
5.	Which score will be considered in the compilation of Result and Preparation of Merit List/Ranking:	A candidate has a choice to appear in one or both sessions. He/ she will be awarded an NTA score in each session based on his/her performance. The candidate's best NTA Scores of both sessions in which he/she has appeared will be

		considered for preparation of Merit List/Ranking.
6.	Whether the JEE (Main) - 2022 will be held in a different medium?	Yes, drawing from the National Education Policy (NEP), the JEE (Main) - 2022 will be conducted in <i>Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, Urdu in addition to Hindi and English.</i>
7.	What is the State code of eligibility?	<p>State code of eligibility means the code of the State from where the candidate has passed Class 12 (or equivalent) qualifying examination by virtue of which the candidate becomes eligible to appear in JEE (Main) - 2022.</p> <p>If a candidate has passed Class 12 (or equivalent) qualifying examination from one State but appeared for improvement from another State, the candidate's State code of eligibility will be from where the candidate first passed the Class 12.</p> <p>Candidate passed/appearing class 12th from NIOS should select the State of Eligibility according to the State in which the study Centre is located.</p> <p>For Indian nationals passing the Class 12 (or equivalent) examination from Nepal/Bhutan, the State code of eligibility will be determined based on a permanent address in India as given in the passport of the candidate.</p> <p>The State code of eligibility of OCI/PIO passing Class 12 (or equivalent) examination in India is at par with Indian nationals. However, OCI/PIO passing the Class 12 (or equivalent) examination from an institution abroad are eligible for Other State quota seats or All India quota seats (but NOT for Home State quota seats) in all NITs, IEST and Other-CFTIs</p> <p>For more details, please refer to the Information Bulletin of JEE (Main) - 2022 which is available at NTA website: https://jeemain.nta.nic.in/.</p>
8.	Does NTA have an exemption for the Divyangjan candidates?	<p>Yes, Divyangjan candidates may be permitted to use a Scribe or allowed for a Compensatory time or both as given below :</p> <p><i>The facility of Scribe</i>, in case he/she has a physical limitation and a scribe is essential to write the examination on his/her behalf, being so certified in the prescribed format (Annexure-IV to VIII) by a CMO/Civil Surgeon/ Medical Superintendent of a Govt. Health Care Institution.</p> <p><i>Compensatory time</i> of one hour for examination of three hours duration, whether such candidate uses the facility of Scribe or not.</p> <p><i>Scribe will be provided by NTA. Candidates will not be allowed to bring their own scribes.</i></p> <p>For more details, please refer to the Information Bulletin of JEE (Main) - 2022 which is available at NTA website: https://jeemain.nta.nic.in/.</p>

9.	Will B. Tech/ B. Arch Scores of JEE (Main) - 2022 will be used for admission to Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University (AKTU), Lucknow, and Madan Mohan Malviya University of Technology, Gorakhpur?	Yes, B. Tech/ B. Arch Scores of JEE (Main) - 2022 will also be used for admission to Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University (AKTU), Lucknow, and Madan Mohan Malviya University of Technology, Gorakhpur.
10.	For the academic year 2022-23, admissions under MEA (Welfare) quota seats shall be based on the Joint Entrance Examination (Main)?	Yes, admission against the Engineering seats provided to MEA for Wards of Government of India personnel posted in Indian Missions/Posts Abroad will be based on the JEE (Main) – 2022.
11.	How many times a candidate can appear in JEE (Advanced) - 2022.	Details may be obtained from the Information Brochure of the JEE (Advanced) 2022. Please see link: https://jeeadv.ac.in/
12.	What is the validity of the Category Certificate (SC/ST/OBC/EWS-Gen.) and PwD certificate?	In this regard, please follow the rules of relevant admitting institutions.
13.	In case of foreign nationals candidates (OCI/PIO), what will be the pin code in the address section?	Such candidates are required to put 000000 in the field of Pin Code.
14.	Will the selection for Admission of students under Direct Admission of Students ABROAD (DASA) be made through JEE (Main) - 2022?	Yes. The Ministry of Education, Govt. of India vide its O.M. F.No.35-9/2016-TS. III MHRD dated 21st December 2018 has approved that the selection for Admission of students under Direct Admission of Students ABROAD (DASA) will be through JEE(Main). This may be applicable from the academic year 2022-23 onwards. The NTA has been conducting JEE (Main) on Computer Based Test (CBT) in India and Abroad for Admission in undergraduate courses in IITs, NITs, IIITs, CFTIs. The Admission for DASA will be done on the basis of the Rank obtained in JEE (Main) from the Academic Session 2022-23.

1.	Whether the application fee excludes the Common Service charge?	Yes. For more details please refer to the 'Information at a Glance' given in the Information Bulletin.
2.	How can one remit fee for JEE (Main) - 2022?	The examination fee for JEE (Main) - 2022 can be remitted in the following manner: Through any Debit/Credit/UPI Card using SBI/Canara/HDFC/ICICI/Paytm on-line gateway payment facility/ Net Banking.
3.	If any candidate faces any problem in remittance of fee due to failed transaction, what can he/she do?	If the payment status of an online transaction (by credit/debit card) is not communicated by the payment gateway in real time then fee payment is not completed and the candidate will not be able to download the Acknowledgement page. In this case, the candidate is required to pay the fee again through online mode and download the acknowledgment page. The amount due to failed transaction of credit/debit card will be refunded back after the declaration of the result

of Session 2 of JEE (Main) – 2022.

1.	Is AADHAAR mandatory for JEE (Main) - 2022?	The Aadhaar number is one of the types of identification and is on a voluntary basis.
2.	How can I use UMANG Mobile Application?	You can download UMANG Mobile Application from Android Play Store or Apple App Store. Open Mobile Application and search for National Testing Agency (NTA). Select your examination and enter the desired details. Example: Select JEE (Main) 2022 -> Enter Application Number & Date of Birth -> Download Confirmation Page
3.	How can I use DigiLocker Mobile Application?	You can download DigiLocker Mobile Application from Android Play Store or Apple App Store. Open Mobile Application and search for National Testing Agency (NTA). Select your examination and enter the desired details. Note: The demographic information (Aadhaar Name, Date of Birth, and Gender) will be matched with the data filled by the candidate. On a successful match, the candidate will be able to download the requested document. Example: Select JEE (Main) 2022 -> Select Year and Enter Application Number -> Download Confirmation Page

1.	Class 10 number of Subjects?	The class 10 Subjects will be considered based on criteria decided by the concerned Board.
2.	Candidate's Information of AADHAAR is not the same as entered in the Application Form	The candidate will be asked to verify their particulars i.e. Name, Date of Birth, and Gender, and authenticate again. If still not matched, the candidate has to select the second radio button - <i>My Information on Aadhaar is not the same as entered in the Application Form</i> and then proceed further.
3.	Validity of Certificate regarding category certificate.	As per the new guidelines from the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, GoI, the candidates are required to submit the OBC-NCL certificate issued on or after 1 January 2022. If a candidate has not been able to collect the said certificate on time, he/she may be allowed to write JEE (Main) - 2022 provisionally. The candidate will submit a fresh certificate (issued on or after 1 January 2022) before the declaration of the result/at the time of reporting after seat allocation.
4.	School/College Pin Code	Pin Code of the City is to be entered where the School/College is situated.
5.	12 Class passed in 2020 and also given improvement exam in 2021, which marksheet will be considered?	The passing year will be considered when the candidate has passed the Class 12/equivalent examination.
