Appointment to the post shall be made either-

- (A) By promotion from among the Joint Directors of Health Services or
- (B) By transfer of an officer from any Department of the Government of Maharashtra possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination, or
- (C) By nomination from among candidates who-
- (i) unless already in the service of the Government of Maharashtra are not more than 50 years of age;
- (11) Possess the M.E.P.S. degree of a statutory university or any other qualifications specified in the First or Second Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act 1956.
- (iii) possess possess a post-graduate degree in any of the clinical subjects specified in the First or second Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act 1956 or
- a Fellowship of one of the Royal Colleges of Surgeons of Great Fritain or a Membership of one of the Royal Colleges of Physicians of Great Britain; and
- IV. a diploma equivalent to a post-graduate degree in preventive and social Medicine recognised by the Indian Medical Council; or
- a post-graduate degree or diploma in Public Health or Sanitary Science or Hygiene of a statutory Indian or Britainh University or of the Royal Colleges of Physicians and surgeons recognised as an additional qualifications in public health and;
