

DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF HEALTH SERVICES
(TRANSPORT)

Appointment to the post shall be made -

(A) by transfer of an officer from any Department of the Government of Maharashtra, possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination; or

(B) by nomination from among candidates who -

i) unless already in the service of the Government of Maharashtra, are not more than forty-five years of age;

ii) possess a degree in Mechanical Engineering of a statutory University or an equivalent qualification; and

iii) possess experience in inspection, repair and maintenance of vehicles, for not less than ten years, of which not less than five years should be in a managerial capacity;

Provided that preference will be given to a candidate who has experience in the inspection, repair and maintenance of imported

vehicles;

Provided further that the age limit may be relaxed in favour of candidates with exceptional qualifications and/or experience.

2. A candidate appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for two years.
3. A person appointed to the post shall be required to pass examinations in Marathi and Hindi according to the prescribed rules.

4. A person appointed to the post shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service or a post connected with the defence of India, anywhere in India or abroad, for a period of not less than four years including the period spent on training, if any, on such conditions as are determined by the Government of India:

Provided that the person shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment and ordinarily after attaining the age of 40 years.
