Constitution of India

No.RTR 1088/1554/SER 2: In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is nereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Medical Officer (Ear, Nose and Throat), in the Maharashtra Medical and Health Services, Class I, in the Directorate of Health Services, Maharashtra State, namely:-

- 1. These rules may be called the Medical Officer (Ear, Nose and Throat) (in the Directorate of Health Services) (Recruitment) Rules, 1990.
- 2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise -
 - (a) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission;
 - (b) "Degree" means a degree of a Statutory University;
 - (c) "Diploma" means a diploma of a Statutory University;
 - (d) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Health Services, Maharashtra State;
 - (e) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra.
- 3. Appointment to the post of Medical Officer (Ear, Nose and Throat), in the Maharashtra Medical and Health Services, Class I, in the Directorate shall be made either,-
- (A) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the post of Medical Officer, Class II, in the Manarashtra Medical and Health Services, possessing the qualifications and experience ...2..

prescribed for ap ointment by nomination mentioned in clause (B) of this rule; or

- (B) by nomination from amongst candidates who,-
- (i) unless already in the service of Government, are not more than thirty-five years of age;
- (ii) possess M.B.B.S. degree or any other qualification specified in the First or Second Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (CII of 1956), and
 - (iii) possess either,-
 - (a) post-graduate degree in Ear, Nose and Throat or post-graduate degree in General Surgery with Diploma in Ear, Nose and Throat, and have experience in Ear, Nose and Throat surgery in a major hospital for a period of not less than five years, gained after acquiring M.B.B.S.degree, or
 - (b) post-graduate diploma in Ear, Nose and Throat or any other qualification & degree recognised as equivalent thereto by the Medical Council of India, and have experience in Ear, Nose and Throat Surgery in a major hospital for a period of not less than seven years, gained after acquiring M.B.B.S. degree;

Provided that, preference may be given to candidates having experience of teaching the subject;

Provided further that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

- Appointment to the posts by promotion and by nomination shall be made in the ratio of 50:50.
- A person appointed to the post, by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion or by nomination shall be required to pass

examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing these

- A person selected for appointment to the post examinations. shall be required to get himself registered under the Maharashtra Medical Council Act, 1965 (Mah. XLVI of 1965), before joining the post, unless he is already so registered or his name is borne on the Indian Medical Register maintaired under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (CII of 1956).
 - A person appointed to the post, shall if so required, be liable to serve in any defence service of India, or a post connected with the Defence of India, anywhere in India or abroad, for a period of not less than four years (including the period spent on training, if any) on such conditions as may be determined from time to time, by the Government of India.

Provided that such person shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment and ordinarily after he has attained the age of forty-five years.

A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra,
