No. RTR 1078/4734/CR-40/SER-I. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Joint Director of Health Services, Maharashtra Medical and Health Services, Class-I in the Directorate of the Health Services of the Government of Maharashtra, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Joint Director of Health Services, Maharashtra Medical and Health Services, Class-I, in the Directorate of Health Services of the Government of Maharashtra (Recruitment) Rules, 1985.

2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise, -

a) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission;

b) "degree" means a degree of a statutory University;

c) "Diploma" means a diploma of a statutory University;

d) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Health Services of the Government of Maharashtra.

e) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;

f) "Medical Council of India" means the Medical Council of India constituted under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956,

3. Appointment to the post of Joint Director of Health Services in the Directorate shall be made either, -

a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of selection from amongst the persons holding the post of Deputy Director of Health Services, Maharashtra Medical and Health Services Class-I in the Directorate; or

b) by transfer of a suitable officer from any other Government Department, possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination in clause (c) of this rule; or

c) by nomination from amongst candidates who,

i) unless already in the service of Government, are not more than forty-five years of age;

ii) possess M.B.B.S. degree or any other qualification specified in the first or second Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956;

iii) possess a Master's degree in Obstetrics and Gynaecology or Paediatrics, or in Preventive and Social Medicine specified in the First or Second Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 or any other qualification declared by the Medical Council of India to be equivalent thereto;

iv) possess experience of health administration, medical relief or family welfare for a period of not

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permitted
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less than 7 years gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-class (iii), in a Government Department or Local Authority established by the Government:

Provided that age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

4. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion, transfer or nomination, shall be required to pass the examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing, these examinations.

6. A person selected for appointment to the post shall be required to get himself registered under the Maharashtra Medical Council Act, 1965, before joining the post, unless he has already so registered or his name is borne on the Indian Medical Register maintained under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

7. A person appointed to the post shall if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service of India or a post connected with the defence of

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India, anywhere in or outside India, for a period of not less than four years (in-clusive of the period spent on training, if any) on such conditions as may be determined from time to time by the Government of India:

Provided that such persons shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment or ordinarily after he has attained the age of forty-five years.
