No.RTR.1075/6610/PH-2-(B). In exercise of the powers conferred by the provise to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supergession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf and in force in the State or any part thereof, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to moke the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Deputy Director of Health Services, Class-I, in the Maharashtra Medical and Health Services, namely.-

- These rules may be called the Deputy Director of Health Services (Recruitment) Rules 1981.
- In the rules, unless the context required otherwisd.
- (a) "Commission" means the Maharachtra Public Service Commission.
- (b) "Degree" means a degree of a Statutory University.,
- "Diploma" means a diploma of a Statutory University.,
- "Government" means the Government (d) of Maharashtra;
- (e) "Medical Council of India meens the Madical Council of Irdia constituted under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Appointments to the post of Deputy Directe

of Health Services in_charge of Circles Hoadquarters, Civil Defence, Laprosy, Tuberculais

and B.C.G. shall be made either.-

(a) by promotion of suitable officers in the Maharashtra Medical and Health Services, Class-I, having not less than 4 years continuous service in that cadre; or

- (b) by transfer of suitable efficers in other Services possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination in clause (c) of this rule; or
 - (c) by nomination from amongst condidates who-
 - (i) unless already in the service of the Government, are not more than 45 years of ago;
 - (ii) possess M.B.B.S. degree of a statutory University or any other qualification specified in the first or second Schedulo to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956;
 - (Fi) possess a post-graduate degree or a post-graduate diploma in any of the qualifications specified in the first or second Schedule to the Indian Medical Cauncil Act, 1956, or any other qualification recognised as equivalent thereto by the Medical Council of India; and
 - (iv) passess experience of health administration, mudical inlief (a) family welfare under Government, Zilla Parishad or a Local Body for net less than (5 years in the case of these holding post-graduate degree and for not less than 7 years in the case of those holding post-graduate diploma, gained after acquiring the post-graduate diploma, or or pogt graduate Megree, as the case may be, and auti of which experience for 4 years shedle benin c Class-I post or in A post; equivalent thereto;

Provided that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

- 4. Appointment to the pasts by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio of 50:50.
- 5. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be an probation for a period of two years.
- 7. A person appointed to the post, whether by prometion, transfer or nomination, shall be required to pass examination in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exampted from passing, those examinations.
- 7. A person appointed to the post shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service of India or a post connected with the defence of India, anywhere in or outside India, for a period of not loss than four years (inclusive of the period spent on training, if any) on such conditions as may be determined from time to time by the Gevernment of India,

Provided that such person shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment or ordinarily after he has attained the age of forty-five years.

8. A person selected for appointment to the post shall be required to get himself registered under the Maharashtra Medical Council Act, 1965, before 'joining the post unless he has already se registered or his name is borne on the Indian Medical Register maintained under the Indian
