3. Appointment to the post of Deputy Director (Family Welfare Extension) in the Directorate shall be made either, -

- (1) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the post of District Extension Media Officer having not less than three years' service in that post; or
- (2) by nomination from amongst candidates who,
 - (a) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 40 years of age;
 - (b) possess -
 - (i) a degree and
 - (ii) a degree or diploma in Journalism;
 - (c) have adequate knowledge of Marathi ;and
 - (d) have experience in the field of Journalism, editing and the like for not less than seven years in a newspaper, news agency or a publicity organisation, gained after acquiring the qualifications mentioned in clause (b) of sub-rule (2) of this rule.

Provided that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both;

No. RTR. 1089/4141/CR. 67/89/SER. 2.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Deputy Director (Family Welfare Extension) Class I, in the Directorate of Health Services under Public Health Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Deputy Director (Family Welfare Extension) Class I, in the Directorate of Health Services (Recruitment) Rules, 1991.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

(a) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission;

(b) "degree" means a degree of a statutory university;

(c) "diploma" means a diploma of a statutory university or an institution recognised by Government;

(d) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Health Services, Maharashtra State;

(e) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra.

3. Appointment to the post of Deputy Director (Family Welfare Extension) in the Directorate shall be made either—

(1) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the post of District Extension Media Officer having not less than three years' service in that post; or

(2) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(a) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 40 years of age;

(b) possess—

(i) a degree; and

(ii) a degree or diploma in Journalism;

(c) have adequate knowledge of Marathi; and

(d) have experience in the field of Journalism, editing and the like for not less than seven years in a newspaper, news agency or a publicity organisation, gained after acquiring the qualifications mentioned in clause (b) of sub-rule (2) of this rule.

Provided further that, preference may be given to candidates having a degree or a diploma in Health Education, or Master's degree in Social Science with experience of producing publicity material, pamphlets or brochures and the like for Family Welfare Programme.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in clause (d) of sub-rule (2) of rule 3, if at any stage of selection, the Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates possessing the requisite experience are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes or Nomadic Tribes, then the Commission may, in the matter of such selection, relax the requirement in respect of the period of experience, set out therein, and select suitable candidates belonging to such Castes or Tribes.

5. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

6. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion or nomination, shall be required to pass examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing those examinations.
