Constitution of India.

No.WWF-1081/1078/PH-2-2. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Waharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Additional Director of Health Services (Family Welfare, Waternal Child Health and School Health), in the Waharashtra Medical and Health Services, Class I, in the Directorate of Health Services of the Government of Maharashtra, namely:

- 1. These rules may be called the Additional Director of Health Services (Family Welfare, Mater al Child Health and School Health) (Directorate of Health Services) in the Maharashtra Medical and Health Services, Class-I, (Recruitment), Rules, 1983.
- 2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise :-

- (a) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission;
- (b) "Degree" means a degree of a statutory University;
- (c) "Directorate" means the Directorate
 of Realth Services of the Government;
- (d) "Government" means the Government of 'aharashtra.

3. Appointment to the post of Additional Director of Health Services (Family Welfare, Maternal Child Health and School Health) in the Directorate shall be made either:-

- (a) by promotion of a suitable person to be made by selection from amongst the persons holding the post of Joint Director of Health Services in the Directorate; or
- (b) by transfer of a suitable person in other Serwices possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination in clause (c); or
- (c) by nomination from amongst candidates who :
 - i) unless already in the service of Government, are not more than forty eight years of age;

- 4. . A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- 5. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion, transfer or nomination, shall be required to pass examinations in Hindi and warathi according to the rules made in that behelf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing, those examinations.
- be required to get himself registered under the Waharashtra Wedical Council Act, 1905 (XLVI of 1965) before joining the post, unless he has already so registered or his name is borne on the Indian Wedical Register maintained under the Indian Wedical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956).
- if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service of India, or a post connected with the defence of India, anywhere in or outside India, for a period of not less than four years (inclusive of the period spent on training, if any) on such conditions as may be determined from time to time by the Gowern ment of India:

- ii) possess ".B.B.S.dogree or any other qualification specified in the First or Second Schedule to the Indian Vedical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956);
- iii) possess a post-graduate degree in obstetrics and dynaecology or Paediatrics or Preventive and Social Medicine, but preferably in Preventive and Social Medicine, specified in First or Second Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956);
 - iw) possess experience of health administration, Wedical Relief or Family Welfare under Government, Zilla Farishad, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council or such other local authority, for not less than eight years, gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (iii):

trovided that the age-limit may be relexed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both. Provided that such person shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment or ordinarily after he has attained the age of forty-five years.
