2. Brief Facts:

The present matter pertains to a complaint seeking the halting of construction of an alleged unauthorized tower being erected in the vicinity of Khande Rao Temple, Dhule.

3. Proceedings and Appearance:

The matter was listed for hearing on 18th March 2026. The Complainant, however, remained absent during the said hearing. It is noted that the Complainant had, vide letter dated 16th March 2026, informed this Authority of his inability to attend the scheduled hearing.

4. Submissions by Indus Towers:

Subsequent to the submissions made by the Mr. Amar Meshram, Senior Executive, Indus Towers:

4.1 Senior Executive, Indus Towers furnished a copy of the agreement to the Nodal Officer.

4.2 Furthermore, a copy of the Geo-Technical Soil Investigation Report pertaining to the ground-based tower was also submitted for consideration.

4.3 It was further submitted that the aforesaid documents have already been furnished to the Dhule Municipal Corporation.

5. Submissions by Dhule Municipal Corporation:

The Dhule Municipal Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "DMC") appeared through Mr. Kamlesh Sonawane, Assistant Engineer, DMC and made the following submissions:

5.1 The exact location of the subject premises was clarified before this Authority.

5.2 Assistant Engineer, DMC stated that all requisite documents Such as copy of agreement, structural stability report, and other reports pertaining to the construction have been duly received from Indus Towers.

5.3 The DMC further confirmed that, upon examination, the site in question has been found to be structurally and technically safe.

6. Consideration and Findings:

Upon perusal of the material placed on record and considering the submissions made by the Dhule Municipal Corporation and Indus Towers, it is observed that:

6.1 The requisite documentation has been submitted and verified by the competent municipal authority.

6.2 The concerned authority has confirmed the safety and compliance of the site.

6.3 There is no material placed on record at this stage to substantiate the allegation of unauthorized construction.

7. Decision by Nodal Officer:

In view of the foregoing facts and circumstances, and upon consideration of the submissions made as well as the material placed on record, it is evident that the requisite permissions and documents have been duly furnished and verified by the competent municipal authority, which has also affirmed the safety and compliance of the site in question.

Further, in the absence of any substantiated material or representation from the Complainant to support the allegations of unauthorized construction, it is found that the present complaint is **devoid of any merit**.

Accordingly, no grounds are made out for granting the relief sought, and the present complaint stands **disposed of**.
