What is Terrorism?

Terrorism, in its broadest sense, is the use of violence against non-combatants to achieve political or ideological aims. The term is used in this regard primarily to refer to intentional violence.

Terrorism in India: In India, terrorism has been a major

problem. The terrorism in Punjab and Rashmir has been inspired and aided by our neighbouring country. Terrorism in Punjab has been finished but it still is a major problem in Kashmir. It has spread to almost all parts of the country. There have been serial blasts in Mumbai and Delhi.

Attack on Parliment house on 13th December, 2001 and in Mumbai on 26th November, 2008 aute big incidents in our country. Recently there has been a terrorist attack in Rashmir on 22 April, 2025.

Terrorist attack in India:

India Parliament attack: The 2001 Indian Pauliment attack was a temrootist attack on the Pautliment of India in New Delhi, India on 13 December 2001. The attack was carried out by five Jaish-e-Mohammed terrorist that resulted in the death of sia Delhi police, two Pautliment security service and a gardener. All five terrorist were killed by security forces.

Mumbai attack: The 2008 Mumbai attack, also referred to as 26/11

attack, were a series of coordinated Islamist terrorist attack that took place in November 2008. When 10 members of Lashkar-e-Taiba, a Pakistan based Islamist militant organisation, carmuried out 12 shooting and bombing attack.

Pahalgam attack: The 2025 Pahalgam attack was an attack

on non-Muslim tourists by five armed militants near Pahalgam in the Indian administered Jammu and Kashmir in which 26 civillians were killed on 22 April, 2025.

Conclusion

Teuturourism in India is a major/serious problem. We need to find a solution for this as soon as possible. Young people should be anarse so that they ma y not be misled by the terrorists to achieve their selfish aims or goals.

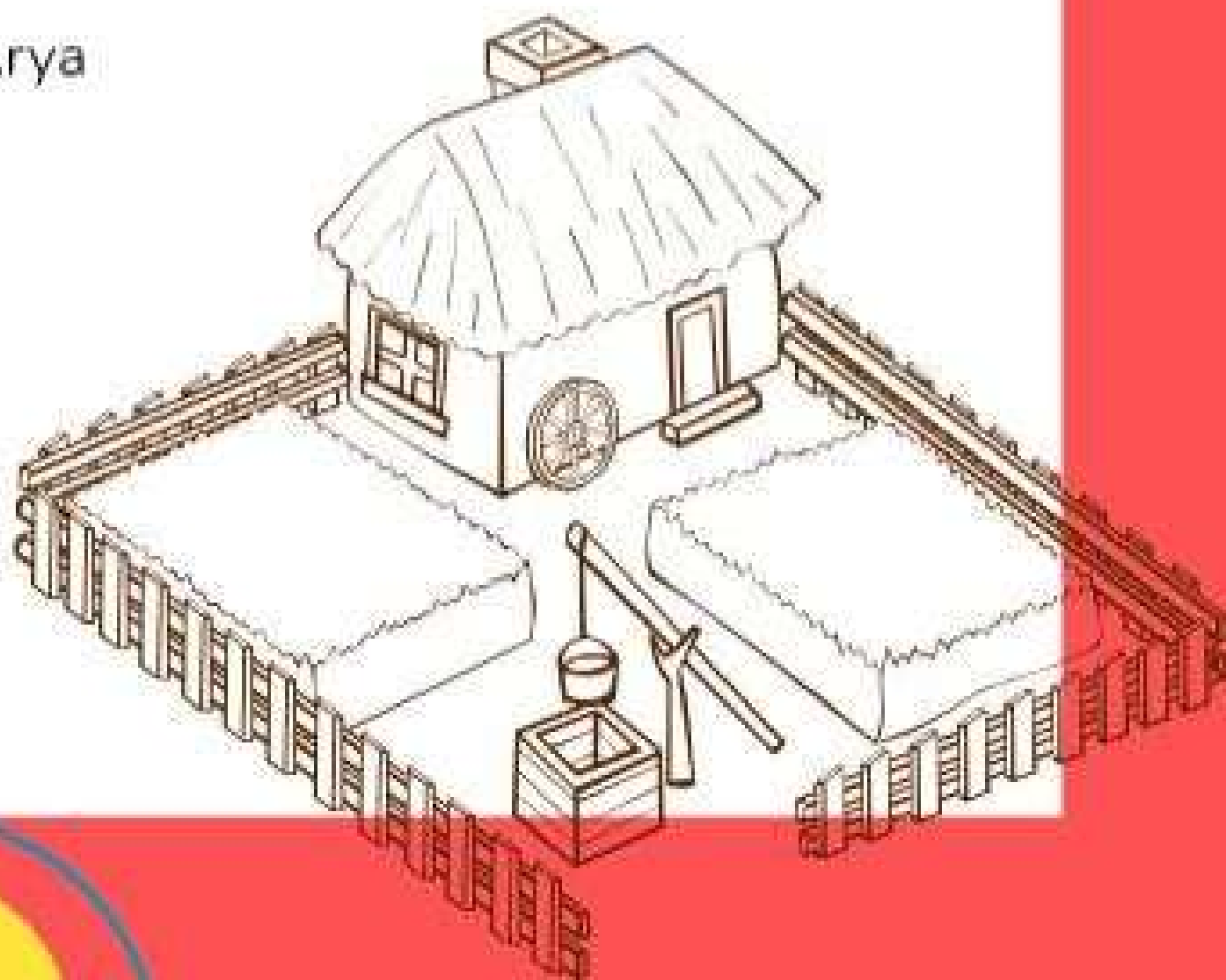
People and Life style.

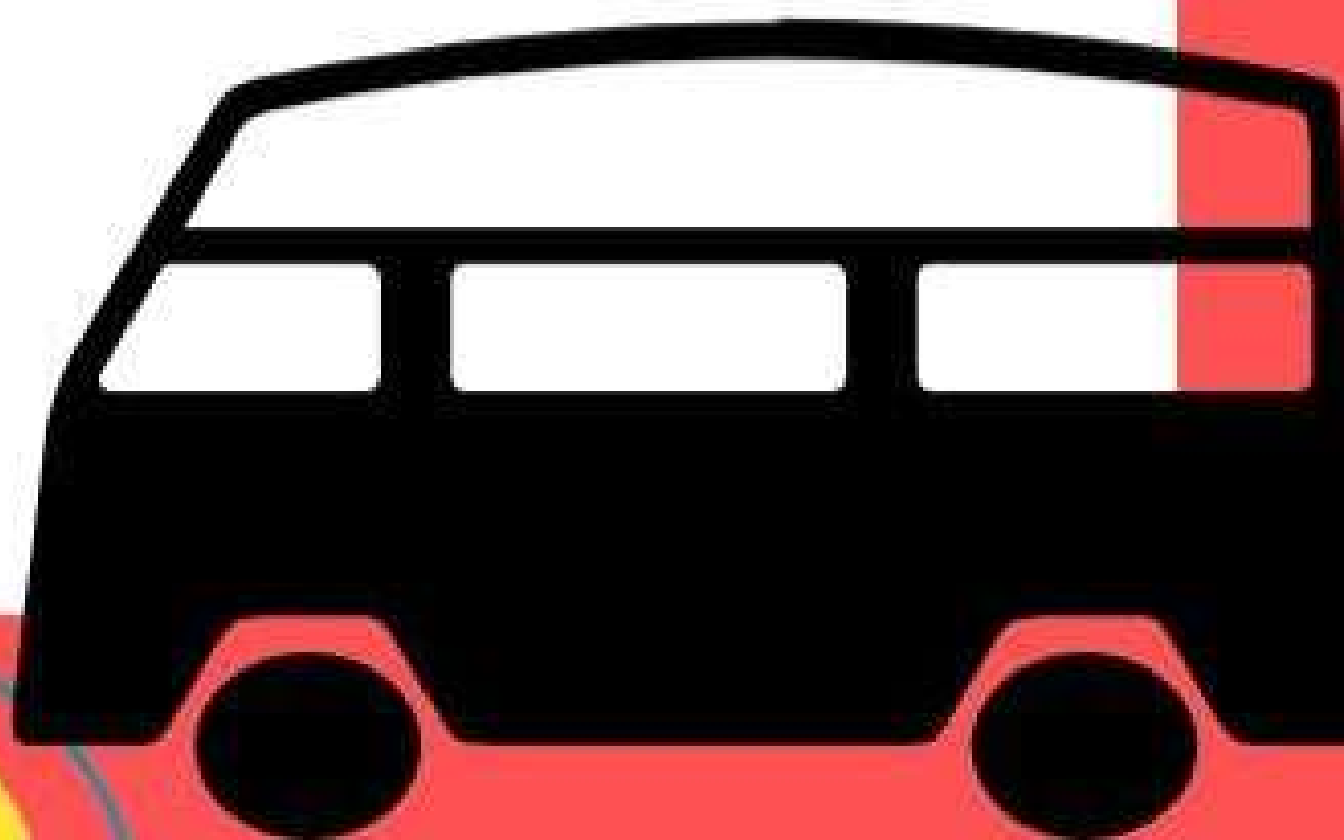
# THE SCHOOL TRIP
