Students showcased creativity in the diya decoration activity with vibrant colours and intricate designs. The event highlighted cultural significance and artistic skills fostering creativity and tradition.



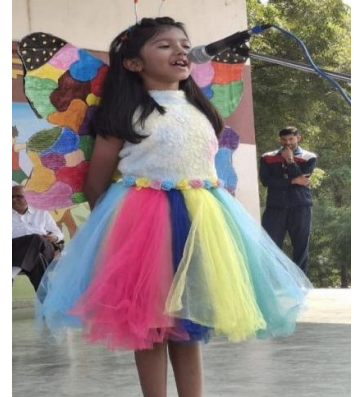
Solo Action Song

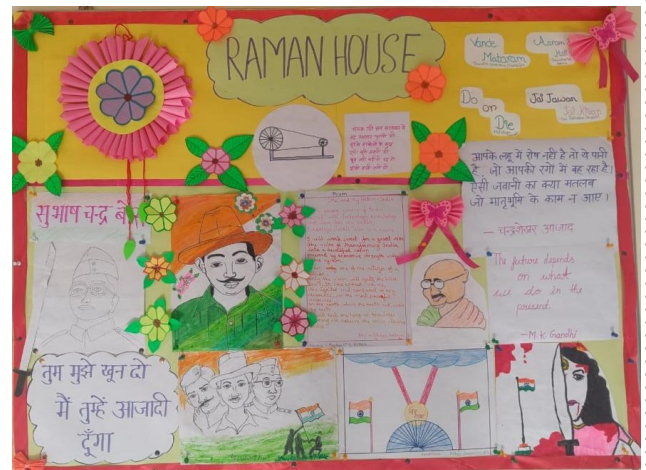
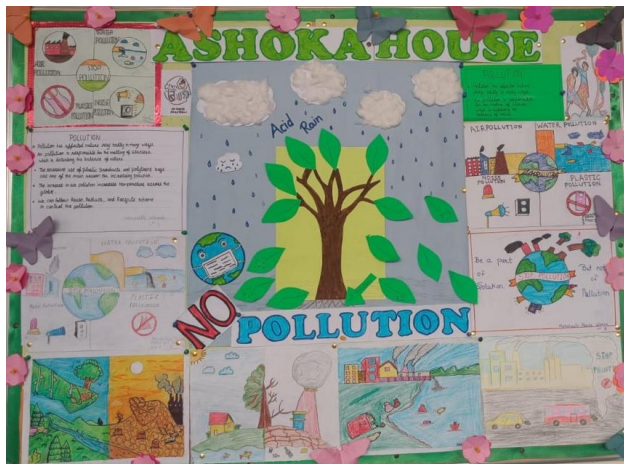
Fancy dress competition-

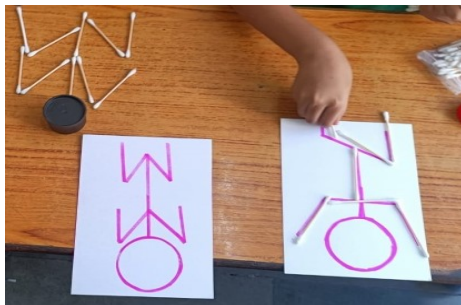
