



Every week on Wednesday, Bhasha Sangam was held. Through this activity students got exposure to Alphabets, proverbs and sentence in the language of the partnering state.






#### QUIZ, QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSIONS

Community Singing – Under this activity students rendered mellifluous folk songs of the state of Bihar representing its rich culture and heritage.






# WEBINAR ON CULTURAL ACTIVITIES
