Subject: Calendar of Activities under Adobe Digital Creativity & AI Skills Programme for the Session 2026-27 – reg.

Madam/Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, Adobe continues its collaboration with KVS in alignment with NEP 2020 to promote digital creativity and AI skills among teachers and students. Building upon the initiatives undertaken in previous sessions, the following activities are proposed for the session 2026-27:

(a) CPD Programme for Teachers: A 10-hour CPD programme (5 modules) will be conducted w.e.f. 1 April 2026 for all teachers (PGT, TGT & PRT), including a dedicated component for Principals/Vice Principals. The training will focus on AI, digital tools, and classroom integration, with certification upon completion. **(Refer to Annexure-1).**

(b) Digital Worksheets & DCAIS Integration: NCERT-aligned digital worksheets (Classes VI–VIII) will be implemented across subjects, to be assigned regularly by teachers. The subject teachers will be expected to assign classwork/homework using the developed digital worksheets **at least two to three times** per week. Digital Creativity & AI Skills (DCAIS) will be integrated within ICT curriculum using 2 periods per month, facilitated by PGT-CS/ICT teachers. **(Refer to Annexure 2)**

(c) Student Sessions (Classes VI–XII): Digital creativity sessions will continue across all regions with quarterly schedules, focusing on hands-on learning and project-based activities. **(Refer to Annexure 5)**

(d) Boot Camps & Creativity Challenges: Boot Camps will be conducted during May–June, October, and December–January, along with Creativity Challenges in June, August, November, and January, aligned with the KVS academic calendar.

To enhance students' Creative AI and digital skills, the following programmes will be organized: **(Refer to Annexure 3)**

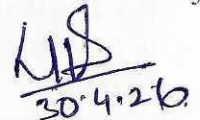
- Summer Boot Camps – May & June **(Refer to Annexure 4)**
- Winter Boot Camps – December & January
- Autumn Boot Camps – October
- Additionally, Creativity Challenges will be conducted:
 - a) Creativity Challenge - 1 - International Yoga Day - 20-June -30 July 2026
 - b) Creativity Challenge - 2 - National Science Day - 1 Aug – 30 Aug 2026
 - c) Creativity Challenge -3 - Swachhta Pakhwada 15 Sept – 02 Oct 2026
 - d) Creativity Challenge - 4 National Education Day - 01-Nov to 30-Nov 2026
- Final year exam preparation through NCERT- Digital worksheet created for Grades VI to VIII (10-Jan & 28-Feb'27)
