NOTE: Self-Attested copies of the prescribed documents would be required to be submitted along with the application form for registration.
g) Note:	1. All admissions will be done only as per the priority category as per the Admission Guidelines 2026–27. 2. Mere Registration will not confer a right to admission. 3. Incomplete application forms shall normally be rejected. 4. Admission secured on the basis of wrong certificate shall be cancelled by the principal forthwith and no appeal against such action of the principal shall be entertained. 5. The address entered and the address proof submitted by the parent during the application process shall be treated as final for determining the neighborhood. No request for change of address will be entertained for this purpose, except in cases of government employees shifting to government accommodation, after the lists of provisional admissions are out.
