The 1/11/21 Initiative is fostering a culture of reading among students of classes 1-8 across all 41 Kendriya Vidyalayas of the Tinsukia Region. Every month, on the 1st, 11th and 21st, students receive a new book covering diverse themes such as fiction, non-fiction, culture, reasoning and general knowledge.

Through reading, discussions and engaging follow-up activities, the initiative nurtures creativity, imagination, curiosity and critical thinking.

One book, three times a month—building lifelong readers, one page at a time!



TARGETED OUTCOMES OF 1/11/21 INITIATIVE

The 1/11/21 initiative has been undertaken to achieve the following outcomes:

1. To develop *basic book sense and proper book handling* in young learners.
2. *To improve literacy levels* among students, thereby contributing to the *achievement of FLN Lakshyas*.
3. To encourage *independent reading* among students.
4. To enhance the reading levels of students in *ORF assessment*.
5. To help in *cultivating a sense of responsibility* through regular borrowing and care of the books.
