Shri Varun Mitra, Deputy Commissioner & Chairman extended welcome to all Members of RJCM. After brief introduction of official side and staff side, Action taken report on the minutes of RJCM held on 10.03.2022 was discussed and confirmed.

The Agenda was thereafter discussed as under:-

1) Implementation of CGHS as soon as possible :- The Chairman has informed that it is a policy matter and not under the purview of RJCM. However, the case relating to extension of CGHS facility has already been taken up with local CGHS authority at Silchar and the same has been referred by the Addl. Director, CGHS, Guwahati to the Addl. DDG, New Delhi for extending the benefit by relaxing/amending the rules. The decision of the competent authority is awaited.

2) Timely payment of Retirement benefits:- The Finance Officer informed the meeting that retirement benefits to the retired teaching and non-teaching staff have been disbursed on time.

3) Timely grant of Senior Scale & Selection Scale & MACP benefits and confirmation of services :- The Chairman has informed the meeting that the DPC/DSC has cleared all the eligible cases regarding Senior Scale, Financial benefits under MACP scheme and Confirmation of services due up to 31.12.2021 and orders have already issued in this respect. Regarding grant of Selection Scale, the said benefit is granted by the KVS (HQ) New Delhi centrally. The proposals with APAR(s) grading of eligible cases of teachers have already been sent to KVS (HQ) as per the criteria fixed by KVS (HQ) New Delhi.

4) Filling up of Vacant Post SSA/JSA/Sub-Staff:- The Staff side expressed concern about large numbers of vacant post of SSA/JSA & Sub- Staff in this region. The Chairman has informed the meeting that this office has been sending the Vacancy position to KVS (HQ) New Delhi time to time and filling up of vacancies could be done by KVS (HQ) New Delhi and this office has no power in this respect.

5) Deployment of Data Entry Operator in the absence of Clerical staff:- The Chairman desired that Data Entry Operator may be engaged in Kendriya Vidyalayas as per the norms through agencies by following the KVS Guidelines.

6) Circulation of list of AMA under Various Station:- The matter has already been taken up with the Principals and the Chairman desired that matter may be taken up by the Cluster In-Charge Principal with top priority. Regarding Emergency indoor treatment and taking of treatment in CGHS Hospital, Chairman desired that KVS(HQ) circular Dated-02.03.2000 in this matter should be followed by all.

7) Providing a photo copy of Service Book to all employees:- The Chairman desired that a photo copy of service book should be provided to all employees as per KVS (HQ) New Delhi instructions.
