Scheme of phonics worksheets and how to use them.

The main objective of designing these worksheets is to enable the students of classes 1 and 2 to decode i.e. sounding the words by connecting the letter sounds properly. The two national-level surveys (FLS study 2022 and TARA app survey in KVS 2023) indicate that many students struggle to decode or read the words properly. Hence, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has introduced the phonics method in classes 1 and 2. Extensive training programs were conducted through offline and online modes across the country. It was observed that teachers largely considered phonics as a separate entity and dealt with it as an additional job. These phonics worksheets are designed by integrating phonics methods in their textbook lessons to enable the students to read (decode) at least the lessons prescribed in their textbooks. They are expected to serve as support material for teachers as well as students.

All the words found in English and Mathematics textbooks were meticulously analyzed, categorized, and incorporated into a range of phonics worksheets. In addition to that, many familiar words that are commonly used in our day-to-day lives were also included in the worksheets.

There are two volumes, Volume -1 is for class 1 and volume -2 is for class 2. Each volume is further divided into four parts. In each part, a particular number of lessons/units are dealt with as given in the table above.

The worksheets of each part can be used, before and while teaching the concerned units/chapters. There is no specific worksheet for a particular lesson. For example, words from first three chapters of mathematics and Unit-1 of English are used in all the worksheets of part 1.

Some worksheets are suitable for beginners. Teachers may use them judiciously as per the level of the students in Balvatika or class 1. They need not stick to the sequence of the worksheets strictly. Teachers are encouraged to take photocopies of the worksheets and distribute them to students regularly. While taking photocopies, teachers should consider paper economy and environmental concerns and hence advised to take print on both sides of the paper.

Besides using the worksheets, the teachers may also watch the model videos of various phonics activities and conduct such activities in their classes as per the level of the learners. More videos will be uploaded, as and when we receive new videos on phonics activities from enthusiastic teachers. Word inventory

A word list organized according to the number of parts (syllables) is given by the end of part 2 and part 4 of the worksheet book. All the words from the lessons of the textbooks as indicated in the table above are listed after eliminating the repetitions. This can be printed and laminated on A1 size sheet and displayed in the classroom. It will be helpful for the teachers to conduct various activities like 'clap for the parts of the word', dictation, multiple kinds of word games and exercises, puzzles, etc. to ensure students learn all the words in effortless and joyful ways.
