Subject :-Observing the Jal Pakhwada from 16th to 30th April 2025-reg

Madam/Sir,

As per instruction of Ministry of Education, Govt of India is observing Jal Pakhwada from 16th to 30th April 2025 ensuring focused participation of students, teachers and parents with all stakeholders to promote Water conservation, setting up Jal Shakti Kendra intensive afforestation and awareness generation in schools.

Following suggested participatory activities may be undertaken during this period:-

1. Jal Shapath may be organized by all schools and educational institutions on the first working day of the pakhwada and during morning assemblies every day, wherein all students and teachers/staff may participate.
2. Holding meeting of SMC/PTAs or workshops in the first week of the Pakhwada to highlight the importance of "Water Conservation" in school as well as home. **Workshops on Water Conservation** may also be included in the school syllabi to spread awareness for water conservation.
3. Competitions may be held for conserving water in schools; Debates/Essay/Quiz competition for students for conserving water in schools' Painting competition for students, teachers and parents.
4. Debates on conserving water awareness messages to be posted on the website of the Vidyalayas. Alternatively, Photographs on water conservation may be displayed in school Website.

Other suggested Action Plan for Jal Pakhwada (16th- 30th April, 2025) is also attached for ready reference.

Therefore, it is requested to disseminate the contents of this letter to the Principals under the Region and instruct them to observe the Jal Pakhwada in a befitting manner following the Suggested Action Plan given in the attached circular laid down by the Government. Further all the Regional Offices will upload the day wise activities on the Google Tracker (Data) and Google drive (Photos & videos). The details of Google tracker and drive will be shared separately. Social Media handles of the KV's/ ROs to be used by uploading videos and Photos using before and after photographs of the cleanliness and sanitation.

Suggested Action Plan for Jal Pakhwada (16th – 30th April, 2025)

1. A Shapath namely Jal Shapath may be organized wherein all students and teachers/staff may participate. Children to take pledge for water conservation.
2. Water Conservation awareness messages to be posted on the website of the Department/ Organisations/ Schools.
3. Holding meeting of SMCs/SMDCs/PTAs to highlight the importance of Water Conservation.
4. A status check/ review can be done for piped water supply connection in the school in view of Jal Jeevan Mission.
5. To educate students learn about conservation of water. To sensitize students about the impact of scarcity of water. To empower students to learn to protect the natural sources of water. To help every students to save at least one litre of water per day. To encourage students towards judicious use and minimum wastage of water at home and school.
6. Essay, Slogan, Elocution, Quiz, Painting, Skit, Poem, slogan writing competitions and Model making competition on Water.
7. Students may be taught about checking wastage of water.
8. Electronic banners may be created and uploaded on the departmental/state web portals to highlight the observance of the Jal Pakhwada. Publicity and awareness generation may be done through use of social media, as well as electronic and print media.
9. All teachers may visit nearby villages to address the local communities on Water Conservation. They may also sensitize local community to stop wasting of water resources and to make them aware ongoing Jal Shakti Abhiyan.
10. Teachers and students in association with local representatives should propagate the theme of Jal Pakhwada among public in local areas.
11. Students may be asked to come out with imaginative slogans, posters and pamphlets on different themes such as water conservation etc, which can be later displayed in school exhibitions and on village/ town walls/ school premises.
12. Competitions can be held in districts/blocks/clusters on Water.
13. Debates on Water conservation.
14. Water from hand washing unit to be channelled to school gardens.
15. Children may be taught about the water borne diseases/diseases, safe handling of drinking water so that they practice proper hand and oral hygiene.
16. Audio visual programme to be undertaken to motivate students/employees and other for Water Conservation.
17. Convene small group meeting of Bal Sansad/School Cabinet specially to discuss the Jal Pakhwada activities in the school.
18. Encourage community members and students to make suggestions as to what new activities can be included under Jal Pakhwada and forward such suggestions to DoSEL, MoE.
19. Prize distribution for participation of children, teachers and parents in competitions viz. Painting, Essay, Debate, Quiz, Slogan, Inter-school and Crafting, model making etc. to encourage Water Conservation.
20. All Schools/educational institutions may sum up their activities and work undertaken during the Jal Pakhwada and select best activity for forwarding to district/state authority for uploading on the website i.e. in public domain.
