#### REPORT - DAY 1

**Date**: 04-08-2025

Introduction

The first day of the 3-Day Orientation Course for Master Trainers on the newly introduced English textbooks began on 4th August 2025 with a focused objective of familiarizing educators with the pedagogical shifts, content changes, and implementation strategies embedded in the New Curriculum Framework (NCF 2023) and National Education Policy (NEP 2020).

#### Inaugural Session

Participants were divided into groups and tasked with designing three inquiry-based questions and three inquiry-driven activities for selected chapters from Classes 6, 7, and 8.

The first day of the orientation set a strong foundation for the next two days, focusing on deepening understanding, practical application, and assessment strategies aligned with the new textbooks.


