Subject: Implementation of Swachh Evam Harit Vidyalaya Rating (SHVR) 2025-26 - reg.

Madam/Sir,

With reference to the letter dated 05.08.2025 received from Joint Secretary (I&T), DoSE&L, MoE, Govt. of India, regarding the subject cited above, it is to inform that Swachh Evam Harit Vidyalaya Rating (SHVR) 2025-26, launched on 29th July 2025 by the Hon'ble Minister of Education, is an initiative under which all schools will be rated and recognized based on a comprehensive 60-indicator framework, aligned with the NEP 2020 and India's vision for a clean, green, and inclusive school environment.

This programme aims to promote institutional transformation, environmental sustainability, and climate resilience in school education through a structured framework. For implementation, the SHVR portal and mobile application have been developed to facilitate digital participation, self-assessment, and monitoring.

In view of the above, and as desired by MoE, for the effective implementation of SHVR 2025-26, it is requested to disseminate the following directions to Kendriya Vidyalayas under the Region:

- 1. All Kendriya Vidyalayas shall mandatorily participate in SHVR 2025-26 through selfassessment on the official SHVR portal or mobile application between 04 August 2025 and 30 September 2025.
 - SHVR website for sign-up: https://shvr.education.gov.in
 - o KVs are required to SIGN UP, by entering their UDISE code and associated mobile number to generate an OTP on the registered mobile number, complete the school profile details on the page, create a password, and proceed.
 - The portal also provides QR codes for downloading the Android and iOS apps.
- 2. SHVR 2025-26 aims to empower schools to self-assess and improve across six key categories: Water, Toilets, Hand washing with soap, Operation & Maintenance, Behaviour change and capacity building and Mission LiFE activities.

3. KVs shall **complete the self-assessment against 60 defined indicators** across six themes and upload photographic and documentary evidence for each indicator. (*Reference Manual with detailed instructions and the event timeline is attached.*)

Further, a list of District Nodal Officers (Assistant Commissioners) of the regions is enclosed. They will ensure effective utilization of the available window, achieve 100% participation, and ensure proper monitoring of the project. Additionally, an online orientation program will be organised for nodal officers soon for which date and time will be intimated separately.
