Welcome Address:

The meeting commenced with a welcome to the Chairman & all RSCB members by the Member Secretary, RSCB, KVS RO Ernakulam and it was followed by self-introduction by the members.

Key-note Address by Dr. D. Manjunath, Deputy Commissioner & Chairperson of RSCB, KVS RO Ernakulam.

Chairman, RSCB in his key note address laid emphasis on the purpose of the meeting that it was to develop a roadmap for the new academic session in the domain of Sports. He highlighted that Sports and Games play a vital role in the overall development of a child. According to him, participation in sports helps children build resilience, enhance their ability to cope with adverse situations and improve their emotional strength. To illustrate his points, Hon' Chairperson cited anecdotes & underscored the transformative power of sports in channeling youth energy into positive and constructive activities.

He reiterated that sports are as important as academics for the holistic development of students. Stressing the need for proper infrastructure, he advocated for the development & maintenance of facilities in all Vidyalayas for the physical well-being and development of all students . He also emphasized that 'student safety' must be given the highest priority during the conduct of any sports events. The speaker appreciated the dedicated efforts of all TGTs (Physical & Health Education) , whose hard work have led to very good results in preceding years.

In conclusion, Hon' Chairman appealed all members to ensure proper prior plan & conduct of extra-curricular activities including sports by all Principals & TGTs (P&HE) in all Kendriya Vidyalayas of Ernakulam Region to nurture & support the students who are keenly interested in Sports so as to groom them as elite athletes.

Performance of KVS RO Ernakulam was reviewed during Academic Year 2025-26 with achievements & shortfalls. Hon' Chairman expressed hope for better performance in 2026-27 with renewed efforts and pledged support from KVS RO for the same. Decline in medal tally in 2025-26 in RSM & SGFI events is a serious concern. The Vidyalaya wise decline in performance was analyzed based on comparison of cash awards disbursed to KVs in the past years. However, some KVs have improved their medal tallies during 2025-26 which is appreciable.
