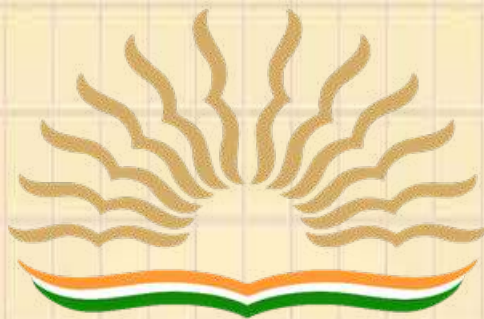

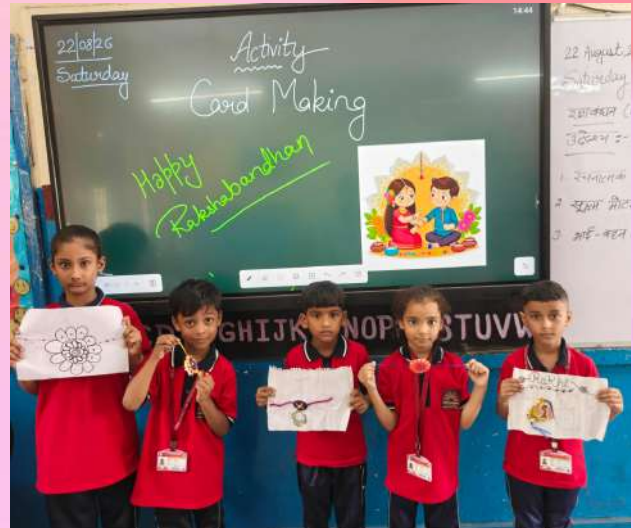


Calligraphy
