ELIGIBILITY AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ATL INSTRUCTOR

Role and Responsibilities of ATL Instructor

- Functioning: To take care of the functioning of ATL Lab in the KV Schools.
- Management of ATL Labs: The ATL Instructor will manage the ATL Lab and activities of the students inside the ATL Lab.
- Monitoring the ATL Lab Activities: The ATL Lab instructor will hand hold the students ATL Lab activities and train the students inside the Lab.
- Maintenance of ATL Labs: The ATL Lab instructor will be responsible for the maintenance of ATL Labs.
- Assisting in Hackathon Activities

Educational and other Qualification of ATL Instructor / teachers

- B.E/B.Tech in Electronic & Communication Engineering
- Minimum One Year Experience in any reputed institution in the field of innovation/robotics/STEM/Artificial Intelligence etc.
- Proficiency in teaching through Hindi & English medium.
- Interview to be conducted as per existing KVS norms. No TA/DA is admissible for interview.
- Rs. 25,000 per month to be given to Vocational teachers on pro rata basis and as per PMSHRI / KVS guidelines.

1. Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate (10+2) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) from recognized Institute/Board.

OR

- Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate (10+2) with at least 50% marks and 4-

year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B. El. Ed.) from recognized Institute/Board.

OR

**Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate/Class-XII with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Education (Special Education) from Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI).

2. Qualified in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (Paper-I) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

3. Proficiency to teach through Hindi & English medium.

Diploma in Community Based Rehabilitation (DCBR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Post Graduate Diploma in Community Based Rehabilitation (PGDCBR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Diploma in Multi Rehabilitation Worker (MRW) with 6 months Certificate Course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

Junior Diploma in Teaching the Deaf

OR

Primary level Teacher Training course in Visual Impairment.
