Areas for Improvement (To Be Addressed)

- 1. The library, which serves as the heart of our school, TGT librarian joined in Dec 2023. He is issuing books to all the students according to their interest. New magazines are purchased in Library.
- 2. Category-5 students, coming from areas with limited academic facilities, face challenges in adapting to their new learning environment.
- 3. The development School ground is under progress and TGT (PH&E) joined in Dec 2023. She is active with students in the ground. Indoor Badminton Court is prepared and students are utilizing it in beneficial manner. 400 mtr Running track is under planning.
- 4. Ground water is salty so not useful in developing park and watering plants but Vidyalaya planted the more than 1300 saplings and trying hard to make them trees.

Opportunities (To be Encashed)

- 1. This school is selected in the prestigious scheme of PM SHRI School.
- 2. Opportunities exist for the expansion and enhancement of our sports facilities.
- 3. We are benefited from exceptional cooperation and support from the local community, administration, and VMC (Vidyalaya Management Committee).\
- 4. Vidyalaya has approach local MLA with request to extend the area of assembly ground so students easily involve various activities during morning assembly.

Threats (To be removed and reduced)

- 1. Inconsistent power and internet supply, along with difficulty in maintaining cleanliness during adverse weather conditions.
- 2. Thorny grass and plants are developed on the playground.
- 3. A prevalent issue of excessive mobile phone and social media usage among students at home.
- 4. The need to shift parents' focus from merely students' marks to the holistic development of their children.
