

The salary for KVS teachers, including Post Graduate Teachers (PGTs), Trained Graduate Teachers (TGTs), and Primary Teachers (PRTs), will be determined according to the 7th Pay Commission. The Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has officially released the salary details for these positions. Additionally, KVS has announced a 25% increase in specific allowances, such as the Children Education Allowance (CEA), Hostel Subsidy, and Special Allowance for Child Care, in line with the recent enhancement of Dearness Allowances.

The revised salary structure includes information on Basic Pay, the new DA, revised House Rent Allowance (HRA), and Dearness Relief (DR) for pensioners. For more detailed information, please refer to the official notification provided by KVS authorities.

#### KVS Increase Allowances

Effective January 1, 2024, the Central government introduced a revised reimbursement structure for its employees. Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has announced an enhancement for Central Government employees with disabilities and their families. Following an increase in Dearness Allowance, KVS has significantly raised the Children's Education Allowance, Hostel Subsidy, and the Special Child Care Allowance for women with disabilities by 25%. Details of the KVS allowance increases are provided below.

#### KVS Salary 2024 for Non-teaching Posts

The salary structure for various positions at KVS is as follows: The KVS Principal earns between ₹78,800 and ₹2,09,200, while the KVS Vice Principal's salary ranges from ₹56,100 to ₹1,77,500. Both the KVS Librarian and KVS Assistant (Group-B) receive salaries ranging from ₹44,900 to ₹1,42,400. Additionally, the salary for a KVS Primary Teacher or Primary Teacher (Music) falls between ₹35,400 and ₹1,12,400. #### KVS Teacher Salary 2024 Allowances & Perks

Working as a KVS employee comes with a wide range of allowances and perks. These benefits make the government job very attractive to job seekers. Below is a list of the allowances that are added to the basic pay of KVS employees:

#### KVS House Rent Allowance(HRA)

HRA varies as per the city you are living in. It is mostly higher in X & Y cities than in Z cities. The rate of HRA will be calculated as 30 %, 20% and 10 % for X, Y, and Z class cities respectively. Classification of Cities/Towns Rate of House Rent Allowance per month as a percentage of Basic Pay only. The admissibility of House Rent Allowance (HRA) shall be as under:-

#### KVS Transport Allowance (TA)

The transport allowance is given to cater to the daily travelling needs of the employee. The Employees posted in the cities will get Rs.3600 as TA whereas the Employees posted at all other places will get Rs.1800 as TA.

#### KVS DA on TA

The Dearness Allowance (DA) on Travel Allowance (TA) has also been updated and will be calculated based on a 50% Dearness Allowance. DA on TA will be applicable in two categories of cities: High TPTA and Other Cities. Employees from High TPTA cities will receive ₹1,800. For positions with a Grade Pay of ₹4,200, ₹4,600, and ₹4,800- such as PRT, TGT, and PGT- the KVS DA on TA will remain unchanged.

#### How to Calculate DA?

Dearness allowance is calculated based on the All India Consumer Price Index for Industrial Workers Base Year 2001=100. The index has been released by the Labour Bureau every month.

7th CPC DA Percentage = (12 Monthly Average) – 261.42) / 261.42 x 100

#### KVS Children Education Allowance (CEA)

The Children Education Allowance (CEA) is a financial benefit provided by the Indian government to Central Government employees, which includes KVS teachers. It aims to help them meet the education-related expenses of their children.

Here's a breakdown of the CEA for KVS teachers:

**Eligibility:** All KVS teachers, as Central Government employees, are eligible for the CEA.

**Reimbursement:** There are fixed monthly reimbursement rates:

**Rs.2,812.50 per child:** This is the standard rate for each child of a KVS teacher.

**Rs.5,625.00 per child:** This double rate applies specifically to Divyang children (children with disabilities) of KVS teachers.

**Fixed Amount:** The CEA is a fixed amount, regardless of the actual education expenses incurred by the teacher for their children.

#### Hostel Subsidy for KVS Teachers

The Hostel Subsidy is a financial benefit offered to Central Government employees, including KVS teachers, to help them manage the costs associated with their children residing in hostels while pursuing education.

**Eligibility:** KVS teachers can claim the Hostel Subsidy if their children are enrolled in a hostel facility while pursuing education away from home.

**Reimbursement:** The current fixed monthly reimbursement rate for the Hostel Subsidy is Rs.8,437.50.

**Fixed Amount:** Similar to the CEA, the Hostel Subsidy is a fixed amount, regardless of the actual hostel expenses incurred by the teacher.

#### Special Allowance for Child Care (Women with Disabilities)

The Special Allowance for Child Care (Women with Disabilities) is a financial benefit provided by the Indian government specifically for women with disabilities employed by the Central Government. This allowance is designed to offer extra support for managing the unique challenges they may encounter while caring for young children. Below is a breakdown of the Special Allowance for Child Care (Women with Disabilities):

**Eligibility:** This allowance is exclusively for women with disabilities who are employed by the Central Government, including potentially KVS teachers.

**Minimum Disability:** There might be a minimum disability threshold (often 40%) to qualify for this allowance.

Increased Amount: The current revised rate for this allowance is Rs.3,750.00 per month. This represents an increase compared to previous amounts.

Focus on Early Years: This allowance is typically provided from the time of the child's birth until they reach the age of two.
