For oral language development:

1. Poem Recitation: Teachers will give the students some topic i.e. My wants, What I want to become? And tell them to learn poem related to that topic with expression which helps in oral language development as well as boost the confidence level of the students.





2. Simon Says: Teacher will make two groups of students and make one leader in both the groups and that leader will speak an action and others have to do opposite of the action .Example if a leader (Simon) says clap your hand then others have to scratch their heads.





For reading development:

- **1. Shared Reading:** Teacher will give students various types of books to them for reading after reading the book they will exchange with their friends and after that they will share the stories to each other.
- 2. Choral Reading: Give the student a copy of the passage and keep one for yourself. Tell the student that you will read from the passage, and then the student will join you in reading the passage together. Read a few sentences or a paragraph from the passage while the student listens to you read. After modeling fluent reading of this selection, ask the student to join you in reading aloud the same sentences or paragraph. Repeat reading the text two to three more times together with the student. Then continue with the rest of the passage in this manner.



For Writing development:

1. Anagram: Teacher will give one word to the students where the letters of a word or phrase are rearranged to form a new word or phrase. They can range from simple to complex, witty to profound, and they can be a fun and interesting way to improve your vocabulary and spelling skills.





2. To-do List: Teacher will give 6 slips for a week to the students to make a list of the things they do in a whole day to make their day more efficient and also inculcate time management skills along with writing skills.
