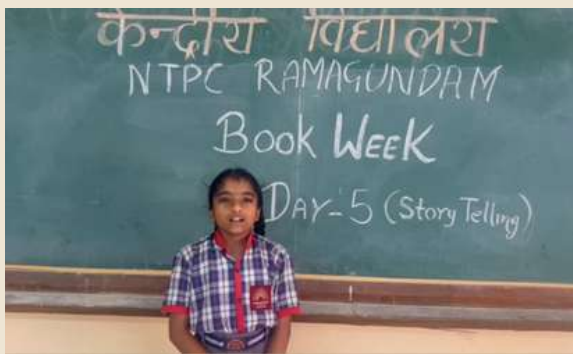
Library Activities for Book Week

## Digital Learning

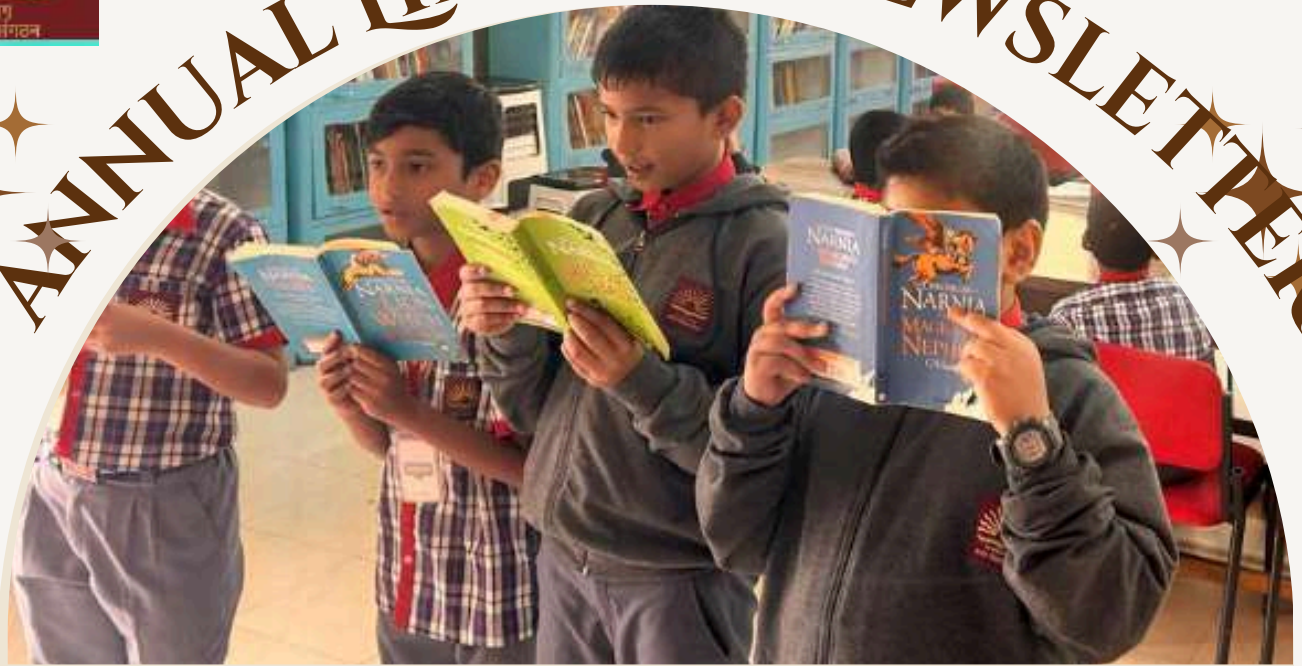

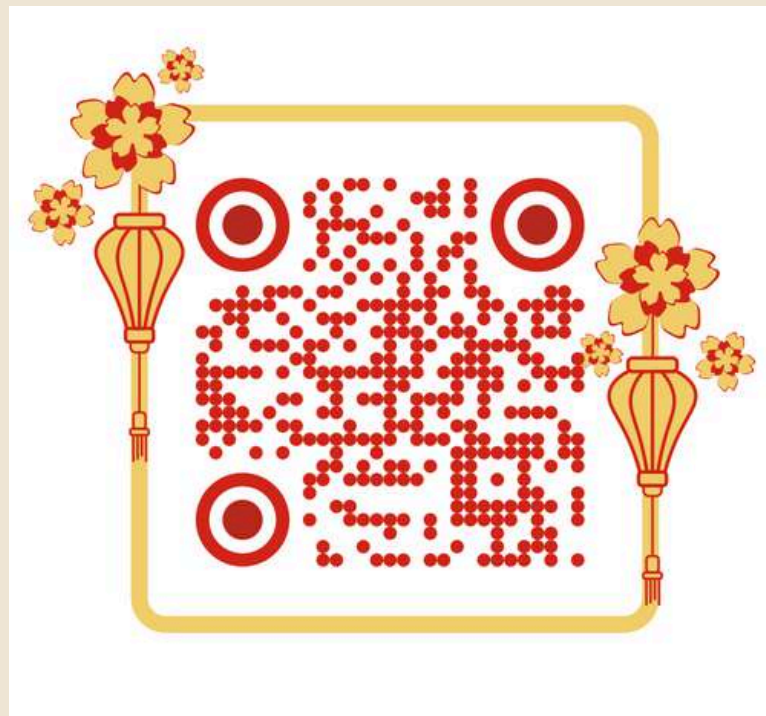
Bar Code for Digital Library
