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IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES FOR THE POST OF TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS(TGTS)-

A. Candidates should possess the professional qualification of B.Ed as on the date of interview.

B. For the post of TGT (S.St)-

1. The candidate should have studied any two subjects out of the following:-

(i) History with at least 50% marks in aggregate and one subject out of Geography/Economics/Political Science with at least 50% marks in aggregate and also at least 50% marks in graduation.

OR

(ii) Geography with 50% marks in aggregate and one subject out of History /Economics/Political Science with at least 50% marks in aggregate and also at least 50% marks in graduation.

2. Geography/History should have been studied in all the years of graduation with at least 50% marks.

3. In case of honors degree in History, the candidate should have studied Geography/Economics/Political Science in first and/or second year of graduation with at least 50% marks in history in aggregate and at least 50% marks in other subject indicated above at graduation level and also at least 50% marks in aggregate at graduation level.

4. Similarly In case of honors degree in Geography, the candidate should have studied History/Economics/Political Science in first and/or second year of graduation with at least 50% marks in geography in aggregate and at least 50% marks in other subject indicated above at graduation level and also at least 50% marks in aggregate at graduation level.

C. For the post of TGT (Maths)-

(i) The candidate should have studied math in all the years of graduation with any two subjects out of Physics, Chemistry, Electronics, Computer Science, Statistics.

(ii) In case of an honors degree in Maths, the candidate should have studied math in all the years of graduation with at least 50% marks in aggregate and any of the two subjects indicated in point no.(i) above with at least 50% marks in each subject at graduation level and also at least 50% marks in graduation.

(iii) B.A.(Hons.) in math and B.Sc.(Hons.) in any subject other than math are not eligible for the post of TGT(Maths).

D. For the post of TGT (Hindi/English/Sanskrit)-

The candidate should have studied Hindi/English/Sanskrit in all the years of graduation with at least 50% marks in Hindi/English/Sanskrit for the post of TGT (Hindi/English/Sanskrit) respectively and also at least 50% marks in graduation.

1. Candidates should download application form for the concerned post (**Separate for each post**) from school website, and submit it on the day of interview from **09:00 am** along with self attested testimonials of all academic years and passport size photo. Kindly bring all original documents for verification.
2. No TA/DA will be admissible for a walk in interview.
3. Age limit – 18 to 65 years as on date of interview.
4. No remuneration will be paid for Summer/Autumn/ winter vacation. For any absence from duty, pro rata basis payment will be paid as per rules.
