FOR POST GRADUATE TEACHERS

(a) Integrated Post Graduate Course from NCTE recognized institution/University, in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate including B.Ed. component.

OR

Master Degree from a recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks in aggregate in the concerned subject AND

(b) B.Ed. Degree from NCTE recognized institution/University with atleast 50% marks OR Three years Integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. from NCTE recognized Institution/University with atleast 50% marks

OR

Four years Integrated Degree with at least 50% marks from NCTE recognized Institution/ University including B.Ed. component

(c) Proficiency to Teach in Hindi and English medium.

1. Bachelor's degree in Drawing and Painting/Sculpture/Graphic Art/ Fine Arts from a recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks provided that the candidates should have studied Drawing and Painting as main subject in all the years of graduation.
2. B. Ed. degree from NCTE recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks.

Desirable:

1. Working knowledge of English and Hindi/other Regional language
2. Working knowledge of computers.

TGT (P & HE)

Four year integrated course / Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education/ Bachelor of Physical Education and Sports offered by NCTE recognized Institution/University with at least 50% marks

OR

Graduation from a recognized university and B.P.Ed. offered by NCTE recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks in Graduation and B.P.Ed. separately.

Desirable:

- i) Represented at least State at National Level in any of the Sports/ Games recognized by Sports Authority of India (SAI)/the concerned federation.
- ii) Working knowledge of English and Hindi/other Regional Language.
- iii) Experience of working in a school.
- iv) Diploma from National Institution of Sports

TGT (Work Experience)

Essential Qualification:

- i) Bachelor Degree in Electrical Engineering/ Electronics Engineering/ Electronics & Communication Engineering from a recognized Institution/University with atleast 50% marks.
- ii) B.Ed. Degree with atleast 50% marks from NCTE recognized Institution / University.
- iii) Knowledge of Computer Applications.
- iv) Proficiency to teach in Hindi and English medium

Desirable:

One year practical experience in a recognized workshop/ institution/factory

FOR Special Educator (TGT)

Essential Qualification:

1. Graduation Degree from a recognized institution/University with minimum 50% Marks
2. Any of the following from recognized institution/University: B. Ed. (Special Education) with atleast 50% marks;

OR

B. Ed. (General) with atleast 50% marks alongwith one year Diploma in Special Education;

OR

B. Ed. (General) with atleast 50% marks alongwith two years Diploma in Special Education;

OR

B. Ed. (General) with atleast 50% marks alongwith Post Graduate Professional Diploma in Special Education (PGPD);

OR

B. Ed. Special Education with atleast 50% marks and Post graduate professional Certificate in Special Education (PGPC);

OR

PG Diploma in Special Education (Mental Retardation);

OR

PG Diploma in Special Education (Multiple Disability: Physical and Neurological);

OR

PG Diploma in Special Education (Locomotor impairment and Cerebral Palsy);

OR

Secondary Level Teacher Training Course in Visual Impairment;

OR

Senior Diploma in Teaching the Deaf;

OR

B.A.B. Ed. with atleast 50% marks in Visual Impairment.

OR

Any other equivalent qualification approved by RCI

3. Qualified in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) (Paper - II) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). Relaxation up to 5 percent in the qualifying marks shall be allowed to the candidates belonging to reserved categories such as SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwBD in CTET.

4. Registration with Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) with valid CRR number.

5. Proficiency to teach in Hindi and English.

Note: B.A. B.Ed. in Visual Impairment being integrated course of graduation and B.Ed. Special Education, separate graduation is not required in the case of candidate possessing this degree

Desirable:

Knowledge of Computer Applications

FOR PRIMARY TEACHERS – MUSIC (PRT-MUSIC)

i) Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate (CLASS XII) with 50% marks from recognized board.

ii) Bachelor Degree in Music/Performing Arts from a recognized Institution/University, provided that music subject is studied in all the years of degree as main subject.

iii) Working knowledge of Hindi & English Note: Candidates having Diploma in Music are not eligible for the post.

Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Applications.

FOR PRIMARY TEACHER

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:

1. Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate (10+2) with at least 50% marks and 2- year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) from recognized Institute/Board.

OR

Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate (10+2) with at least 50% marks and 4- year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B. El. Ed.) from recognized Institute/Board.

OR

**Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate/Class-XII with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Education (Special Education) from Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI).

2. Qualified in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (Paper-I) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

3. Proficiency to teach through Hindi & English medium.

Desirable: Knowledge of working on Computer

FOR SPECIAL EDUCATOR (PRIMARY TEACHER)

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:

1. XII Passed with minimum 50% marks in aggregate

2. Any of the following from recognized university/Institute: Two-year D.Ed. Special Education in any of the category of disability.

OR

One year Diploma in Special Education (DSE) in any of the category of disability.

OR

Diploma in Community Based Rehabilitation (DCBR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Post Graduate Diploma in Community Based Rehabilitation (PGDCBR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Diploma in Multi Rehabilitation Worker (MRW) with 6 months Certificate Course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Junior Diploma in Teaching the Deaf OR Primary level Teacher Training course in Visual Impairment.

OR

Diploma in Vocational Rehabilitation-Mental Retardation (DVR-MR)/Diploma in Vocational Training and Employment- Mental Retardation (DVTE-MR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Diploma in Hearing Language and Speech (DHLS) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs. OR XII passed with any RCI recognized qualification of minimum one year duration and 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Any other equivalent qualification approved by RCI

3. Qualified in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) (Paper – 1) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). Relaxation up to 5% in the qualifying marks shall be allowed to the candidates belonging to reserved categories such as SC/ST/OBC/PwBD in CTET.

4. Registration with Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) and having valid CRR number.

5. Proficiency to teach in Hindi and English

Other instructions:

- Interviews are conducted for preparing the panel of contractual staff and to appoint on purely contractual basis & need basis.
- No TA/DA will be paid for attending interview or for joining if appointed on contractual basis.
- The employee, if appointed on contractual basis, will cease to be the employee and the contract stands automatically terminated on the joining of regular incumbent / till the end of the session/ need basis in case of instructors or coaches, whichever is earlier. Coaches / Instructors services are on need basis, hence as per the need they will be appointed and not for entire session.
- Salary will be paid as per the KVS rules and regulations.

5. No other service benefits, like CL/ EL/ TA & DA/LTC etc will be extended to contractual staff, if appointed.
6. Services of contractual teacher will be evaluated on a regular basis and services will be terminated if the performance is not up to the desired mark.
7. A contractual teacher, if appointed, and later wants to discontinue for any reason, at least one month notice must be given for allowing the management to make further alternative arrangements.
8. Before end of the contract, or before quitting with one month notice the contractual teacher must produce no dues certificate, failing which the salary due will be withheld.
9. Contractual teacher, if appointed shall maintain absolute integrity towards his/ her profession and justify his/her services. The students must be benefited with class room transaction / any allied academic activity. He /She should take utmost care of students under his/her care, as the safety and security of the students is paramount. He /She should not resort to corporal punishment. He /She should maintain himself / herself in such a way as the society expects from a teacher. They should follow the Code of Conduct for Teachers (KVS Education Code)
10. Private tuitions will not be allowed.
11. He/ She should perform all the assignments / tasks allotted by Principal /HM / Senior teacher/ In-charges of Committees, from time to time. Based on exigency / need of the services of the teacher, lower classes / higher classes may be assigned.
12. In case of vacancy the common panel will be operated. If a candidate refuses / does not join in a KV (either KV 1 / KV 2 AFA as per allotment & as per merit list), he / she will not be considered further. Hence, it is made abundantly clear that no individual choice will be entertained. Hence note that the list is common. Once allotted to particular KV He/ She cannot be shifted to other KV.
13. A contractual teacher if appointed, should immediately join. No extension / long leave /absenteeism will be allowed.
14. Mere attending interview does not confer for any claim / right of employment/ appointment/place in panel. A candidate will be placed in Panel if the performance is up to the mark.(scores 50%&above in interview). No separate weightage / marks for higher qualifications / experience. Everything will be evaluated as a whole in interview.
15. Candidates are advised to check the eligibility criteria, before applying / attending interview. If a candidate does not possess the requisite qualification, she/he will not be interviewed. Even if interviewed, found ineligible at later stage, will not be placed in Panel. Due to furnishing wrong information and appointed and found later, services will be terminated and appropriate action will be initiated against such candidates.
16. Canvassing in any form leads to the disqualification of candidature.
17. Contractual staff will not be paid for vacations /breaks. (No work no pay).
18. For attending interview the candidate must carry ID proofs to submit at gate as they need to undergo screening for entry in to Air Force Academy, Dundigal.

19. If appointed as contractual teacher, it is the responsibility of candidate to submit the required documents for obtaining the Security Pass. Upon the termination of contract / service/quitting service, the original Security Pass issued by AFA must be returned without fail.(This is very very important).
