ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR DIFFERENT POSTS AS PER KVS RULES

FOR TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS – Maths, Science, Social Studies (Rs. 26,250/Month):

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:

(A) Four years integrated degree course from NCTE recognized university with at least 50% marks in the concerned subject as well as in the aggregate including B.Ed. component.

OR

Bachelors/Honours Degree from a recognized university with at least 50% marks in concerned subject, combination of subjects and also in aggregate ii. B.Ed. Degree from NCTE recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks OR Three years Integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. from NCTE recognized Institution/ University with atleast 50% marks

OR

** One year B.Ed. (Special Education) from Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) with atleast 50% marks.

(B) Qualified in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (Paper-II) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

(C) Competence to teach through English and Hindi Languages

Note: Post wise elective subjects in the combination of subjects are as under:

FOR TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS – Hindi, English & Sanskrit (Rs. 26,250/Month):

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:

(A) 1. Four years integrated degree course from NCTE recognized Institution/ University with at least 50% marks in the concerned subject(s) as well as in the aggregate including B.Ed. component.

OR

2. i. Bachelor/Honours Degree from a recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks in concerned subject, combination of subjects as well as in the aggregate.

ii. B.Ed. Degree from NCTE recognized institution/University with atleast 50% marks.

OR

Three years integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. from NCTE recognized institutions/University with at least 50% marks

OR

3. **Graduation in concerned subject with at least 50% marks and 1-year B.Ed. (Special Education) from Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) with at least 50% marks.

(B) Qualified in the Central Teachers Eligibility Test (Paper-II) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) TGT (Hindi, English, Sanskrit and Regional Languages).

(C) Competency to teach through English and Hindi Medium.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATION:

1. Experience of working in a school.

2. Knowledge of Computer applications.

3. Working knowledge of English and Hindi/ other Bhartiya Bhasha.

Note: The concerned subject mentioned above means the post wise Main / Elective subject(s) and the combination of subject(s) if any are as under:

FOR PRIMARY TEACHER (Rs. 21,250/Month):

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:

1. Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate (10+2) with at least 50% marks and 2year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) from recognized Institute/Board.

OR

Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate (10+2) with at least 50% marks and 4year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B. El. Ed.) from recognized Institute/Board.

OR

**Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate/Class-XII with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Education (Special Education) from Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI).

2. Qualified in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (Paper-I) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

3. Proficiency to teach through Hindi & English medium. Desirable: Knowledge of working on Computer.

** Training to be undergone- A Person with D.Ed. (Special Education) qualifications shall undergo, after appointment an NCTE recognition 6-month Special Programme in Elementary Education.

FOR SPECIAL EDUCATOR (PRIMARY TEACHER) (Rs. 21,250/Month):

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:

1. XII Passed with minimum 50% marks in aggregate.
2. Any of the following from recognized university/Institute:
Two-year D.Ed. Special Education in any of the category of disability.

OR

One year Diploma in Special Education (DSE) in any of the category of disability.

OR

Diploma in Community Based Rehabilitation (DCBR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Post Graduate Diploma in Community Based Rehabilitation (PGDCBR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Diploma in Multi Rehabilitation Worker (MRW) with 6 months Certificate Course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Junior Diploma in Teaching the Deaf OR Primary level Teacher Training course in Visual Impairment.

OR

Diploma in Vocational Rehabilitation-Mental Retardation (DVR-MR)/Diploma in Vocational Training and Employment- Mental Retardation (DVTE-MR) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Diploma in Hearing Language and Speech (DHLS) with 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

XII passed with any RCI recognized qualification of minimum one year duration and 6 months Certificate course in Education of Children with Special Needs.

OR

Any other equivalent qualification approved by RCI

3. Qualified in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) (Paper – 1) conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). Relaxation up to 5% in the qualifying marks shall be allowed to the candidates belonging to reserved categories such as SC/ST/OBC/PwBD in CTET.

4. Registration with Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) and having valid CRR number.

5. Proficiency to teach in Hindi and English Desirable:

- (i) Knowledge of Computer Applications
- (ii) Working knowledge of English and Hindi/ other Bhartiya Bhasha.

FOR BALVATIKA (Rs. 21,250/Month):

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:

- a) Senior Secondary class (Class XII or its equivalent) from a recognized Board with at least 50% marks and
- b) Diploma in nursery Teacher education / Pre – school Education / Early Childhood Education Programme (D.E.C.Ed.) of duration of not less than two years or B.Ed. (Nursery) from NCTE recognized institutions.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION FOR COUNSELOR (Rs. 21,250/Month):

B.A./B.Sc (Psychology) with certificate of Diploma in Counselling.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATION REQUIRED: Minimum of One Year Experience in Providing Career/Educational Counselling to students at schools Or Working knowledge and experience in Placement Bureaus.

Or

Registration with rehabilitation Council of India as Vocational Counsellor.

FOR VOCATIONAL TEACHER/TRAINER (Rs. 25,000/Month):

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:

- B.E., B.Tech/M.Tech (Electronic & Communication Engineering).
- Minimum One Year Experience
- Working knowledge of English and Hindi/ other Bhartiya Bhasha.

FOR PRIMARY TEACHERS – MUSIC (PRT-MUSIC) (Rs. 21,250/Month):

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:

- i) Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary/Intermediate (CLASS XII) with 50% marks from recognized board.
- ii) Bachelor Degree in Music/Performing Arts from a recognized Institution/University, provided that music subject is studied in all the years of degree as main subject. ii) Working knowledge of Hindi & English

Note: Candidates having Diploma in Music are not eligible for the post. Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Applications.

Telugu Teacher(Rs. 21,250/Month):

Must possess a Bachelor's Degree with Telugu as the main subject or one of the three equal optional subjects or Bachelor's Degree in Oriental Language in Telugu (B.O.L) or its equivalent and B.Ed with Telugu as methodology or Telugu Pandit Training or its equivalent.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION for Computer Instructor:

B.E. / B. Tech (Computer Science)/BCA /MCA/M.Sc. (Computer Science) M.Sc.(Electronics with Computer Science component)/M. Sc.(IT)/B, Sc. (Computer Science).

Or

Bachelor's/Master Degree in any Science subject/ Mathematics from recognized University with Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications from government recognized University/ Institute.

Or

Postgraduate degree in any subject from recognized university with Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Applications from government recognized University/'O' level from DOEACC.

Or

Postgraduate degree in any subject with minimum 'A' level from DOEACC.

B. Proficiency in teaching Hindi and English media.

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Interviews are conducted for preparing the panel of contractual staff and to appoint on purely contractual basis & need basis.
2. No TA/DA will be paid for attending interview or for joining if appointed on contractual basis.
3. The employee, if appointed on contractual basis, will cease to be the employee and the contract stands automatically terminated on the joining of regular incumbent / till the end of the session/ need basis in case of instructors or coaches, whichever is earlier.
4. Coaches / Instructors services are on need basis, hence as per the need they will be appointed and not for entire session.
5. Remuneration will be paid as per the KVS rules and regulations for contractual staff.
6. No other service benefits, like CL/ EL/ TA & DA/LTC etc., will be extended to contractual staff, if appointed.
7. Services of contractual teacher will be evaluated on a regular basis and services will be terminated if the performance is not up to the desired mark.

8. A contractual teacher, if appointed, and later wants to discontinue for any reason, at least one month notice must be given for allowing the management to make further alternative arrangements.
9. Before end of the contract, or before quitting with one month notice the contractual teacher must produce no dues certificate, failing which the salary due will be withheld.
10. Contractual teacher, if appointed shall maintain absolute integrity towards his/ her profession and justify his/her services. The students must be benefited with class room transaction / any allied academic activity. He /She should take almost care of students under his/her care, as the safety and security of the students is paramount. He /She should not resort to corporal punishment. He /She should maintain himself / herself in such a way as the society expects from a teacher.
11. They should follow the Code of Conduct for Teachers (KVS Education Code)
12. Private tuitions will not be allowed.
13. He/ She should perform all the assignments / tasks allotted by Principal /HM / senior teacher/ In charges of Committees, from time to time. Based on exigency / need of the services of the teacher, lower classes / higher classes may be assigned.
14. In case of vacancy the panel will be operated. If a candidate refuses / does not join in, he / she will not be considered further. Hence, it is made abundantly clear that no individual choice will be entertained.
15. A contractual teacher if appointed, should immediately join. No extension / long leave /absenteeism will be allowed.
16. Attending interview does not confer right of claim / right of employment/ appointment / place in panel. A candidate will be placed in Panel if the performance is up to the mark.
17. Candidates are advised to check the eligibility criteria, before applying / attending interview. If a candidate does not possess the requisite qualification, she/he will not be interviewed. Even if interviewed, found ineligible at later stage, will not be placed in Panel / appointed. Due to furnishing wrong information and appointed and found later, services will be terminated and appropriate action will be initiated against such candidates.
18. Canvassing in any form leads to the disqualification of candidature.
19. Contractual staff will not be paid for vacations /breaks.
