

Progress report on replacement of Kota stone in classrooms	The committee was informed that the replacement of Kota stone flooring in classrooms was being carried out in a phased and piecemeal manner through the contractor, keeping in view the smooth conduct of classes. Change in Question Paper pattern (Social Science & Science) Members discussed the need to familiarise students with the revised/question paper pattern in Social Science and Science. It was emphasised that adequate practice and orientation would help students adapt smoothly and perform confidently in examinations. 2. Pre-Board Examination performance 	

	<p>The committee noted that the first Pre-Board examination served as a diagnostic assessment. Members observed that improvement in results is a matter of time, provided students continue with consistent practice and guided support.</p> <p>3. Academic preparedness and examination readiness It was observed that sustained effort during preparation reduces examination stress. Chairman, VMC echoed the view that "the more one sweats in peace, the less one bleeds in war," highlighting the importance of rigorous preparation.</p> <p>4. Board examinations Members opined that with structured preparation, regular testing, and focused guidance, the Board examinations would appear more manageable and less stressful for students.</p> <p>5. Appreciation of teachers Members placed on record their compliments to the teachers for their dedication, hard work, and commitment towards students' academic progress and overall development.</p> <p>6. Student well-being and mental health Concerns related to social media influence, stress, and depression among students were discussed. Members highlighted the importance of guidance, counselling, and positive engagement to help students cope with such challenges effectively.</p>
