Festivals like Navratri, Ganesh Chaturthi and Gudi Padwa are celebrated with great enthusiasm. The region is also known for its forts, palaces, temples, handicrafts and traditional cuisines, reflecting its glorious history and diverse cultural identity.

North India

CULTURAL HERITAGE OF INDIA

Northern India, including Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand, has a rich heritage of history, spirituality, art and architecture.

The region is home to magnificent monuments, temples, forts and pilgrimage sites. Festivals such as Diwali, Holi, Baisakhi and Lohri, along with folk dances like Bhangra and Kathak, represent its vibrant cultural traditions.

Southern India, comprising Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Kerala and Tamil Nadu, is renowned for its ancient temples, classical music, dance and literature. Bharatanatyam, Kuchipudi, Kathakali and Carnatic music are important cultural traditions of the region. Festivals such as Onam, Pongal and Ugadi, along with traditional art, architecture and cuisine, beautifully reflect the rich heritage of South India.
