Bagless Day Activities

The National Education Policy 2020, released by the Ministry of Education (MOE), emphasizes a range of enriching courses and 'Bagless' days for students. In accordance with the guidelines, Bagless Days will be promoted throughout the academic year, offering various enrichment activities in Art and Vocational crafts. The primary objective of implementing 10 bagless days is to integrate vocational subjects into the teaching-learning process for students in classes VI to VIII. This approach aims to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and its practical application, while also exposing children to different job skills, thereby aiding them in making informed choices about their future career paths. On these designated days, a variety

of activities are organized. Students can participate in hands-on skill workshops where they learn traditional Art & crafts from different cultures. Through these activities, students gain insights into the richness of the target Art and culture, fostering a deeper appreciation and respect.
