

Report on the implementation of PM SHRI SCHEME
Session 2023-2024

ORGANISATION OF SWACHHATA PAKHWADA (CLEANUP DRIVES)

A 15 Days "Swachhata Pakhwada (Cleanup Drive)" was organised during the month of September-October of 2023. Under this campaign, various parts of school campus were cleaned by the students of all the classes, teachers and non-teaching staffs of the Vidyalaya. A cleaning drive under the Prime Minister's Swachhata Programme of "Ek Tarik Ek Ghanta Ek Saath" was organised with great enthusiasm on 1st October, 2023. The area chosen by the Vidyalaya to clean up for the above-mentioned Programme was the locality of Sainikpuri, Khaprail. Around 100 students and all the teaching and non-teaching staffs participated in the programme voluntarily with full energy and dedication. Swachhata Awareness Campaign was also organised in the nearby village named Meche Busty and few cleaning materials were also distributed to the villagers.

Items required for cleaning up like brooms, gloves, mask, handwash etc. were purchased under the head of organising Swachhata Pakhwada. Refreshment was also provided to the participants taking part in the Swachhata Campaign. The budget allocated to organise Swachhata Pakhwada is ₹ 20,000 /- under PM SHRI (Recurring) Fund and ₹ 19,995 /- has been spent to organise the Swachhata Pakhwada.



PM SHRI KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA SUKNA AN EXPERT TALK ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

An Expert Talk on the Topic "Sustainable Development and its importance in today's world" was held on 30th of October, 2023 at School Library. Prof. Jeta Sankrityayana, Retd. Professor of Economics & HOD, University of North Bengal & Central University of Sikkim was invited to deliver a special lecture on the topic. Students of Classes X, XI Humanities and XII Humanities participated in the lecture. Students were enthusiastically involved in the discussion related to the lecture.

Expert talk was held as per the guidelines of PM SHRI. The fund allocated under PM SHRI for the head of Expert Talks (Recurring) is ₹ 5000/-. A sum of ₹ 2500 /- (as per KVS norms) has been used up for providing remuneration to the expert.



ORGANIZATION OF HEALTH CAMPS

A Two Days Health Camp for all the students of the Vidyalaya was organised on 16th & 19th of October, 2023 in collaboration with The Greater Lions Club, Siliguri. Routine Health Check Ups of all the students comprising of measurement of BMI, Blood Pressure, Eye Testing etc. was successfully done in the said camp.

The above-mentioned health camp was organised under the head of Organising Health Camps (Recurring) of PM SHRI Fund (Budget Allocated - ₹ 50000/-). The expenditure incurred in the conduct of the mentioned health camp is ₹ 48,440/-.



LIBRARY GRANT (RECURRING)

Under the head of Library Grant (Recurring) of PM SHRI Fund of ₹ 20,000/- have been sanctioned. ₹ 20,000 /- has been spent in the month of October, 2023 to purchase a total of 119 Books comprising of 68 (Hindi) and 51 (English) Books.Purchase of the books has been done as per the KVS purchase procedures through the GeM Portal.

As per the instruction of KVS HQ Delhi and KVS RO Kolkata all the KVs were instructed to prepare a selfie point depicting a cut out of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and few information related to the PM SHRI Scheme of the Government. Selfie Point has been installed in front of the School Building.



CITIZENSHIP SKILLS, CONSTITUTIONAL VALUES AND KNOWLEDGE OF INDIA (RECURRING)

On 25th of November 2023, Constitution Day was observed at Vidyalaya with great zeal and enthusiasm. 26th of November being Sunday, the Constitution Day was celebrated on 25th November. Students of Senior Classes: Classes IX to XII actively participated in the programme by delivering speech, reading Preamble of Constitution in both Hindi and English Languages, performing skit on awareness of Constitution and its importance, organising quizzes in the morning assembly.

An expert talk on the topic "Indian Constitution – its formation and importance in building Modern India" was organised at 01.00 PM in School Library. Mrs. Lalita Prasad, Advocate Siliguri Bar Association & Lecturer Dogra Law College (J&K) was invited to deliver a lecture on the Topic. Students of Classes X, XI Humanities and XII Humanities participated in the programme.

The budget allocated under Citizenship Skills, Constitutional Values and Knowledge of India (Recurring) of the PM SHRI Fund is ₹ 50,000 /-. The expenditure incurred in the conduct of expert talk is ₹ 2500 /- paid towards the remuneration of the expert (as per the KVS norms).



PM SHRI KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA SUKNA ADOLESCENT GIRLS' PROGRAMS (RECURRING)

Under the head of Adolescent Girls' Programs of PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring Fund) there is a provision of ₹ 15,000 / - to organise programs pertaining to the head mentioned above. In this regard, a session on adolescent girls' education was organised at the Vidyalaya level on 30/11/2023. Dr. Sunita Gupta, Senior Consultant Gynaecologist & Obstetrician presented an interesting power point and stories to make our children aware about menstrual health and other issues pertaining to an adult girl. Sanitary napkins were also distributed to the secondary and senior secondary girls during the month of December, 2023. There has been an expenditure of ₹ 12,500 /- on this head.



PM SHRI KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA SUKNA FIELD VISIT TO ICAR-CPCRI Research Centre, Mohitnagar, Jalpaiguri

On 05/12/2023 a field visit to ICAR-CPCRI Research Centre, Mohitnagar, Jalpaiguri was organised for the students of classes IX and XI under the PM Shri Scheme. 206 students along with 12 teachers visited the research centre. Students were made aware about the cash crops like aprecanut and cocoa, which suits the climate of Jalpaiguri and Siliguri and how beneficial it is economically to indulge oneself in the farming of the above two crops.

The funds allocated (Recurring) under the head of Field Visit is ₹ 1 Lakh and ₹ 52,200 / - has been spent for the conduct of field visit to ICAR-CPCRI Research Centre, Mohitnagar, Jalpaiguri.



PM SHRI KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA SUKNA EXPOSURE VISITS TO NORTH BENGAL WILD ANIMALS PARK, SILIGURI

Under the head of Exposure Visit of PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring) the fund allocated to the Vidyalaya is ₹ 7 Lakh. Two exposure visits to the North Bengal Wild Animals Park, Siliguri was organised by the Vidyalaya separately for the students of classes III to V on 27/01/2024 & classes VI to VIII on 02/03/2024. A total of 647 students, 334 (Classes III to V) & 313 (Classes VI to VIII) went for the exposure visits. For the conduct of two exposure visits a total expenditure of ₹ 3,59,640 /- has been spent.



MATHS KIT & MATH CIRCLES

MATHS KIT

A budget of ₹ 40,000 /- is allocated under the head of procuring Maths Kit (Recurring). The entire amount of ₹ 40,000 / - has been spent to procure Maths Kit comprising of charts, models, geo boards etc.

MATH CIRCLES

A budget of ₹ 2.5 Lakh is allocated under the head of Math Circles (Recurring). The amount of ₹ 14,235 / - has been spent to procure stationery items like paper, glue etc. to conduct various activities related to Math Circles.



PM SHRI KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA SUKNA SCIENCE KIT

A budget of ₹ 40,000 /- is allocated under the head of procuring Science Kit (Recurring). The entire amount of ₹ 40,000 / - has been spent to procure Science Kit comprising of bar magnets, horseshoe magnets, conical flasks, litmus papers, chemicals, thermometers, weighing machines etc.



PM SHRI KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA SUKNA SPORTS EQUIPMENT

A budget of ₹ 50,000 /- is allocated for the procurement of Sports Equipment under PM SHRI Scheme Fund (Recurring). A sum of ₹ 49,992 /- has been spent to procure various sports equipment like footballs, volleyballs, throw balls, basket balls, skipping ropes, badminton rackets, Shuttlecocks etc.



KITCHEN GARDEN & DRIP IRRIGATION

KITCHEN GARDEN

A budget of ₹ 9,010 /- is allocated for setting up of vegetable/medical/kitchen gardens under the PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 5050 /- has been spent for setting up the kitchen garden. The expenses incurred are for fencing, procurement of medicinal plants and seeds.



DRIP IRRIGATION

A budget of ₹ 20,000 /- is allocated for setting up Drip Irrigation System at vidyalaya under the PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 16,800 /- has been spent for setting up the Drip Irrigation System in the garden of vidyalaya.



COLOURFUL SORTING OF DUSTBINS

A budget of ₹ 10,000 /- is allocated for the colourful sorting of dustbins for waste segregation in the vidyalaya premises under the PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 9,996 / - has been spent for the said purpose.

TREE PLANTATION

A budget of ₹ 50,000 /- is allocated for covering the area of the school with grass or plantation of trees under the PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 36,750 / - has been spent for the plantation of varieties of trees like Miyazaki mangoes, coconut, jamun, amla etc and procurement of tree guards to protect the saplings from being damaged by monkeys.



ENGAGEMENT OF YOGA/SPORTS COACHES

A budget of ₹ 1 Lakh is allocated for the purpose of engagement of yoga/sports coaches in the Vidyalaya under the PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring) fund. A sum total of ₹ 60,594 /- has been spent for the engagement of Sports Coach (₹ 44,116 /-) for the month of December (2023) & January-February (2024); and engagement of Yoga Instructor (₹ 16,428 /-) for the month of December (2023) & January-February (2024).



FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO SPECIAL EDUCATOR

A budget of ₹ 45,000/- is allocated for the purpose of engagement and financial support to Special Educator of the Vidyalaya under the PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 29,003 /- has been paid to the special educator for the month of December (2023) & January-February (2024).

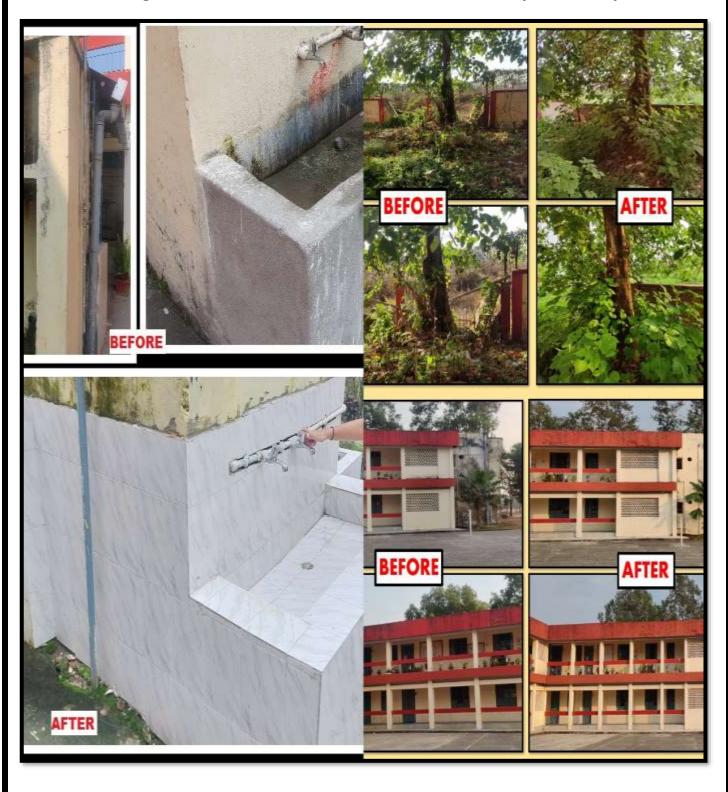
TRAINING TO GIRLS ON SELF DEFENCE

A budget of ₹ 30,000/- is allocated for providing training on self-defence to the girl students of the vidyalaya under the PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 10,552/- has been paid to the karate instructor for the month of December (2023) & January-February (2024).



ANNUAL GRANT

A budget of ₹ 1.5 Lakh is allocated as an annual grant for the purpose of minor repairs in the Vidyalaya under the PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring) fund. A sum total of ₹ 86,506 /- has been spent on minor repairs like whitewashing on certain patches of school on which algae have developed, reconstruction of wash basin, reconstruction of a portion of boundary wall of the Vidyalaya which was damaged by Elephant. The above-mentioned repair works was carried on during the winter vacation and in the month of January & February.

OFFICE EXPENSES/CONTINGENCIES & LED LIGHTENING
A budget of ₹ 20,000 /- is allocated under the head of office expenses/contingencies of the PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 19,700 /- has been spent to procure various stationery items required for vidyalaya's office like pen stand, binder clips, folders etc.
A budget of ₹ 2,000 /- is allocated under the head of LED Lightening of the PM SHRI Scheme (Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 1996 /- has been spent to procure 09 LED tube lights of 18 Watts each and installed in some classrooms.

LAB EQUIPMENT (CHEMISTRY)

A budget of ₹ 75,000 /- is allocated for Chemistry Lab Equipment under the PM SHRI Scheme (Non - Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 75,000 /- has been spent for setting up 16 nos. of LPG gas burner lines with all accessories in the Chemistry Lab of the Vidyalaya in the month of January, 2024.



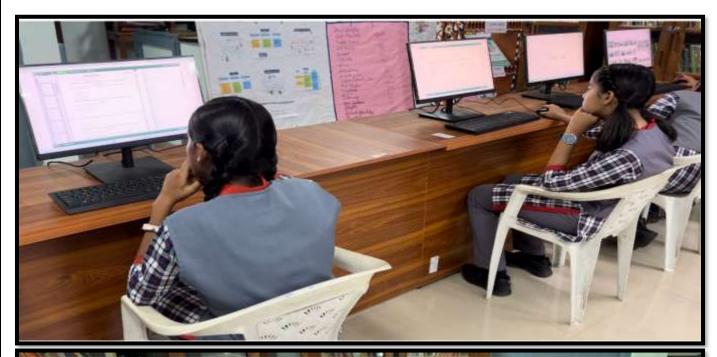
PM SHRI KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA SUKNA LAB EQUIPMENT (PHYSICS)

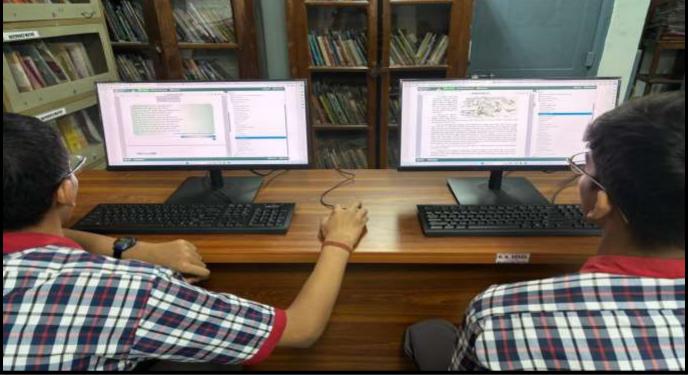
A budget of ₹ 75,000 /- is allocated for Physics Lab Equipment under the PM SHRI Scheme (Non - Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 75,000 /- has been spent for procuring various equipment pertaining to Physics Lab like Battery Eliminator, Meter Bridge, Multimeter, PN Junction Diode, Nichrome Wire, Stop watch, Convex Mirror, Lens, Concave Mirror, Lens, Rubber Pad, Optical Bench, Constant Spring Apparatus etc. in the month of January, 2024.



PM SHRI KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA SUKNA DESKTOP COMPUTERS

A budget of ₹4,82,857 /- is allocated for the procurement of Desktop Computers for setting up Digital Library under the PM SHRI Scheme (Non - Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹4,82,857/- has been spent for procuring Desktop Computers by completely abiding to the MeitY guidelines and the purchase procedure of KVS through GeM procurement in the month of February, 2024.





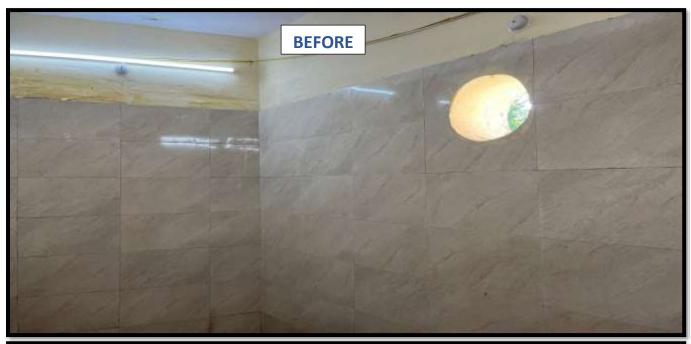
SMART CLASS (INTERACTIVE TOUCH PANEL)

A budget of ₹ 2 Lakh is allocated for the procurement of Desktop Computers for setting up Smart Class by installing Interactive Touch Panel under the PM SHRI Scheme (Non - Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 1,98,637/- has been spent for the installation of Interactive Touch Panel by completely abiding the purchase procedure of KVS through GeM procurement in the month of December, 2023.



PM SHRI KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA SUKNA VENDING MACHINE (SANITORY PADS) & INCINERATORS

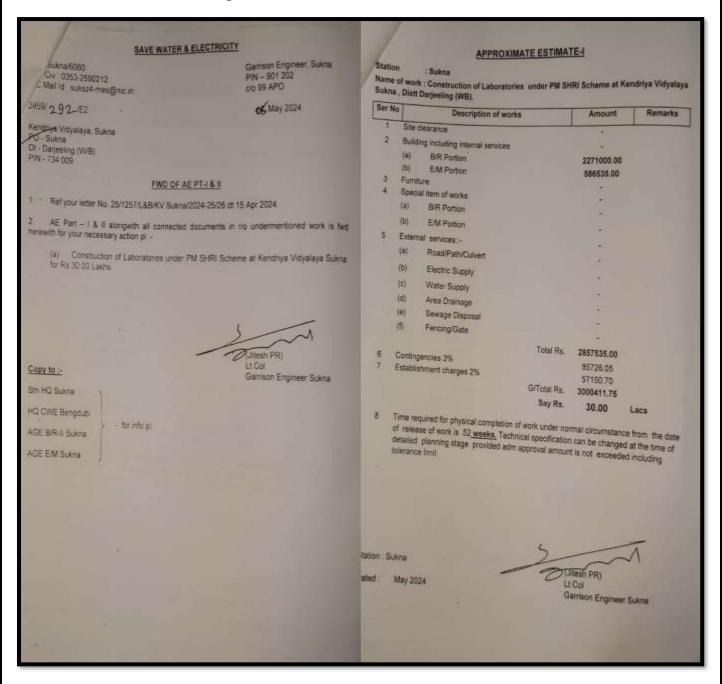
A budget of ₹ 40,000 /- & ₹ 10,000 /- is allocated for the procurement and installation of Vending Machine (Sanitory Pads) & Incinerators respectively in the vidyalaya under the PM SHRI Scheme (Non - Recurring) fund. A sum of ₹ 11,000/- & ₹ 10,000/- has been spent for procuring and installing one unit each of Vending Machine (Sanitory Pads) & Incinerators by completely abiding the purchase procedure of KVS through GeM procurement in the month of November, 2023.





VOCATIONAL LAB CONSTUCTION

As per the letter no. F.No. 110115/13/2023-KVS(HQ)/(Wk-I)/854 dated 15/03/2024 & letter no. F.No. 110115/13/2023-KVS(HQ)/Works dated 09/04/2024 of KVS HQ there has been a sanction of AA&ES for the construction of a vocational lab of the size 7m x 10.6m under the PM SHRI Scheme (Non - Recurring) fund. Vide the letters mentioned above an advance of ₹ 10 Lakh has been transferred to MES Sukna (construction agency) on 22/03/2024 with a request to provide an Approximate Estimates of ₹ 30 Lakh for the construction of a vocational lab. Approximate Estimates within the budget of ₹ 30 Lakh has been provided by the construction agency on 08/05/2024 and the same has been forwarded to KVS HQ through KVS RO Kolkata.
