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Report on Educational Exposure Visit to Chanderi

The students visited the magnificent **Chanderi Fort**, where they explored its historical architecture, ancient gateways, bastions, and panoramic views of the town. The visit helped them understand the strategic importance of the fort and the glorious history of the region.
