

REPORT ON CPD FOR THE SESSION 2023-24

The National Education Policy 2020 suggests that each school should ensure that its teachers participate in a minimum of 50 hours of CPD.

Many in-house workshops and training sessions were organised for the teachers with an aim to provide them adequate opportunities for self-improvement and to learn about the latest innovations and advancements in their profession.

1. A workshop on FAMILIARISATION WITH NEW ASSESSMENT SCHEME & COMPETENCY BASED QUESTIONS was conducted for teachers teaching classes VI to XII on 22.09.2023 FROM 3.00 PM to 5.00PM in the ACTIVITY HALL, PM SHRI KV MEG & CENTRE (2 hours). The workshop was organised by Jaya Shaji, PGT Maths. In her presentation, Jaya Shaji quoted the recommendations of The National Education Policy, 2020 which affirmed the need to move from rote learning to learning more focused on developing the creative and critical thinking capacities of students to meet the challenges of the 21st century proactively.

2.NEP : Inclusive education : Mrs. Malathy Menon PGT Chem shed light on the topic encompassing the teaching -learning environment which is welcoming and supports all learners regardless of learning styles, abilities and disabilities on 4.10.2023 for 2 hours.

4.Capacity building for teachers in subject committee meetings : Experienced and senior teachers take demonstration lessons and train teachers on new teaching strategies. Every last working day of the month is used for the same . Oct - Feb(6 hours.)

PM Shri KV MEG & Centre successfully completed the 10 Days In-Service Training for Teachers under Vocational Education.

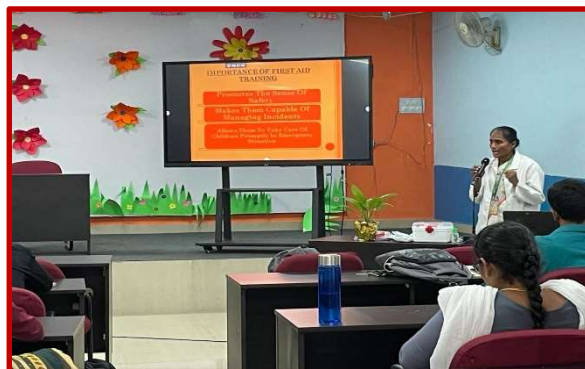
