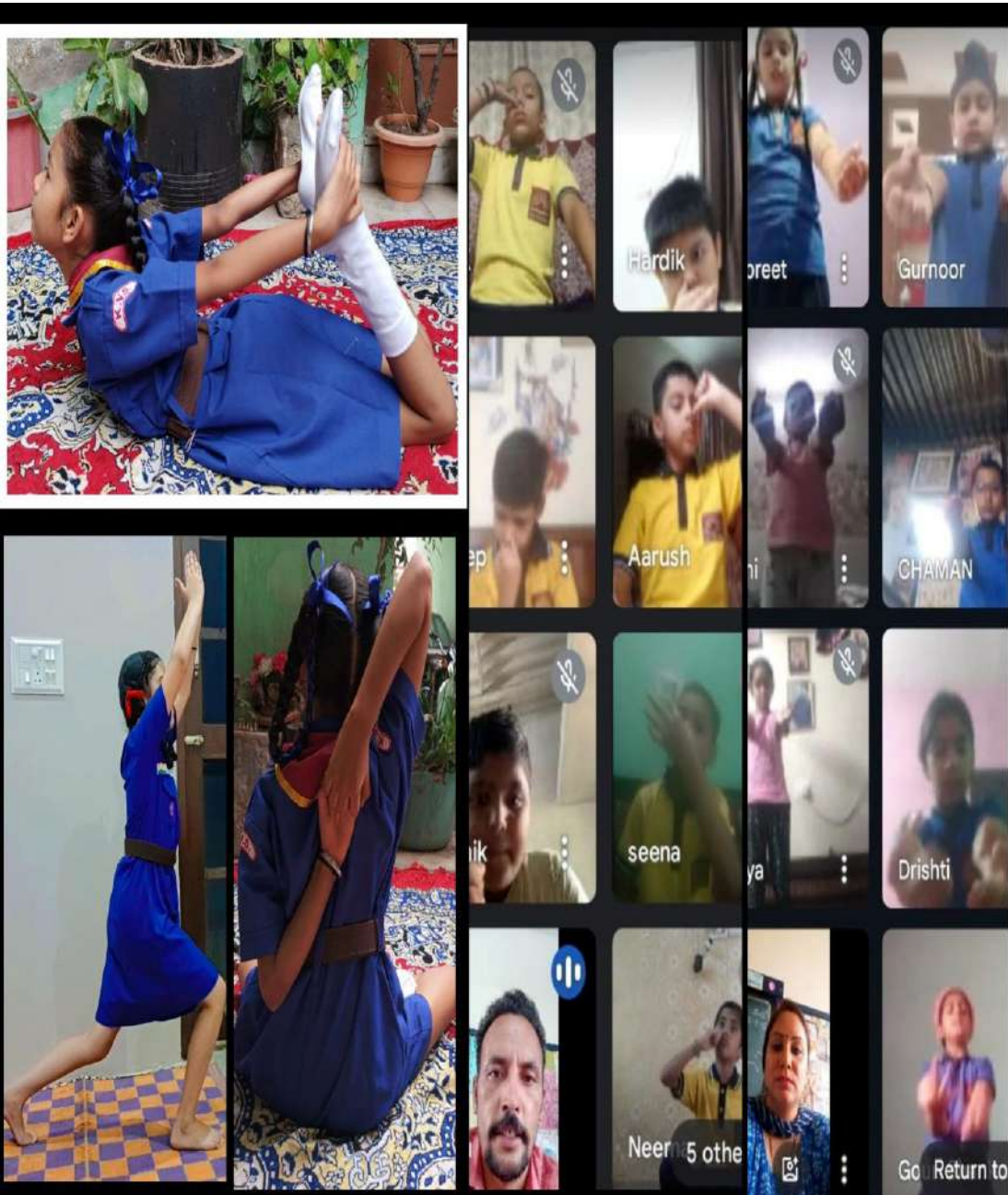


HOUSE MEETING

Our school organized a workshop for teachers on effective teaching methods. The workshop was conducted by our HM Mam and was very informative and interactive.



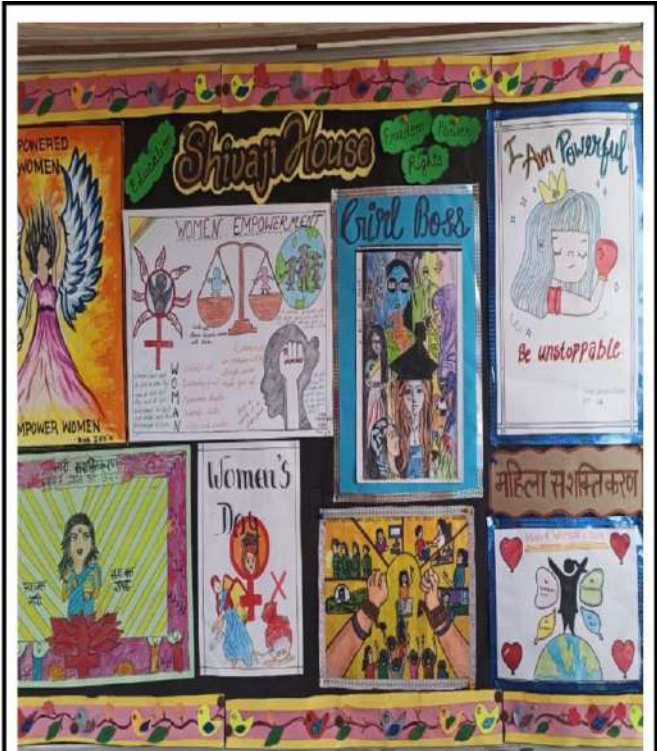
