**IMPORTANT POINTS:**

Consolidated payment on monthly basis shall be made to the contractual teachers.

Teachers appointed on contractual basis will not be entitled for vacation pay and during Summer - Vacation/Autumn Break/Winter Break.

Payment shall be calculated on the basis of KVS norms.

Teachers will not be entitled for pay, if remain absent on working day. In case of absence from duty, payment will be calculated on basis of KVS norms.

As per the rules of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, a panel is prepared before the commencement of the academic session for subjects applicable in Kendriya Vidyalayas, even if there is no vacancy in a particular subject, as a contractual teacher may be required temporarily during the session due to transfer or leave of a regular teacher.

Candidates must submit separate applications for each post for which they are eligible / wish to apply and produce self-attested copies of the required documents at the time of interview along with each application.

All information provided in the application must be correct. If any information is found incorrect during verification, legal action may be initiated.

Salary / honorarium shall be payable as per the rules of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan applicable from time to time to contractual teachers / instructors, etc.

In the interest of the school, the Principal reserves the right to terminate the services of any contractual employee without assigning any reason.

Adequate knowledge of both Hindi and English is essential for all posts.

Kendriya Vidyalayas follow the CBSE curriculum and the medium of instruction is primarily English; therefore, candidates must be proficient in teaching in English.

Basic knowledge of computers is desirable for all posts.

The age limit as on 01/04/2026 is 18–62 years. Contractual appointees shall not be entitled to any other allowance, service benefits, or regularization.

Candidates must bring original copies of all academic documents along with one set of self-attested photocopies at the time of interview. [Original documents will be returned immediately after verification; however, the application form and photocopies of other documents will not be returned.

Attach mark sheets of each year / semester of Class 10, 12, Graduation / Post-Graduation (as applicable), all certificates of B.Ed / D.El.Ed, CTET Qualified [PRT/TGT], other diploma / degree certificates, experience certificate, and one copy of identity proof with address [Voter ID / Ration Card / Aadhaar Card / Passport, etc. with the form. [All documents must be self-attested.

Eligibility criteria and qualification details:

Candidates must carefully verify the required / essential qualifications and subject combinations for eligibility.

No TA/DA shall be admissible to candidates for attending the interview.

The services of contractual teachers in Kendriya Vidyalaya are purely temporary and are utilized only when vacancies arise. If the work is not found satisfactory / not in the interest of students, or if a regular employee is appointed by KVS, the Principal reserves the absolute right to terminate the services of the contractual employee without assigning any reason. Therefore, there is no provision for reservation in the appointment of contractual staff, as it is impossible to determine when a teacher of any subject may be transferred or proceed on long leave due to unavoidable circumstances. Selection is made solely on the basis of minimum qualifications, experience, and marks awarded by the panel.
