Merits list of students will be decided by the overall % as per CBSE/Dir/SE/2023, 2nd January, 2023 Circular No.: Skill-01/2023 which says "If a student studies three compulsory subjects (i.e., Science, Mathematics and Social Science) and also chooses to study a Skill subject (offered as sixth optional subject), then the aggregate % of best five including two languages (Subject 1 & 2) and the best three (from subjects 3, 4, 5 & 6, including Skill subject) can be considered for calculation of percentage."

9. METHOD OF ADMISSIONS IN CLASS XI- KV STUDENTS

Admission in different streams i.e. Science, Commerce & Humanities be based on merit up to maximum 50 strength in case of KV students as per availability of streams in the Kendriya Vidyalaya. Choice of streams will be taken from students with parent consent before declaration of merit list. Streams will be allotted on the basis of marks obtained in Class X CBSE Board Examination. Once the seats exhausted in one streams students have to take admission in the other available streams in that Vidyalaya. Undertaking is to be obtained from students before finalization of merit list by KV.

Merit List is to be prepared for registered own KV students only. (However, if the nearby KV is having highest Class X (KV is running in temporary Building or due to non-availability of infrastructure to start class XI), then the combined merit list will be prepared and admitted. In that case, Deputy Commissioner of the Region will decide nearby KV based on availability of streams in KVs immediately after declaration of CBSE Results.

10. **ADMISSIONS IN CLASS XI- NON-KV STUDENTS:** If seats remain vacant in Class XI even after admitting the children of KV/ neighboring KVs, then the admissions to non - KV children may be granted on the same criteria, in the sequence of categories of priority as per Point 'c' of this Para.

Note: Concessions wherever applicable shall be incorporated while preparing the Merit List.

- a. In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in aggregate of all subjects, the inter-se merit of such candidates may be determined as follows:
 - (i) Candidates obtaining higher marks in Mathematics will get precedence in admission.
 - (ii) If two or more candidates have got the same marks in Mathematics, then the candidates securing higher marks in Mathematics and Science taken together will get precedence over the others.
 - (iii) In case of a tie between two or more candidates obtaining same marks in Mathematics and Science taken together, the student older in age as per the Date of Birth (DOB) will be given precedence over the other.
- b. In case of KV students, normally the class strength be restricted to 50. However, to accommodate the eligible KV students over 50, the Deputy Commissioner of the region shall be consulted for allotment / adjustment in the neighbouring KVs, if feasible.
- c. Principal may admit non-KV children to class XI only within the class strength prescribed i.e 40 for fresh admissions as per the Priority categories. Admission may be granted to fill up the vacant seats within the class strength prescribed in the Table given at PART-A, Para-5 and according to the order of priority category of the parents.

- a. In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in aggregate of all subjects, the inter-se merit of such candidates may be determined as follows:
- Candidates obtaining higher marks in Mathematics will get precedence in admission.
 - If two or more candidates have got the same marks in Mathematics, then the candidates securing higher marks in Mathematics and Science taken together will get precedence over the others.
 - In case of a tie between two or more candidates obtaining same marks in Mathematics and Science taken together, the student older in age as per the Date of Birth (DOB) will be given precedence over the other.
- b. In case of KV students, normally the class strength be restricted to **50**. However, to accommodate the eligible KV students over **50**, the Deputy Commissioner of the region shall be consulted for allotment / adjustment in the neighbouring KVs, if feasible.
- c. Principal may admit non-KV children to class XI only within the class strength prescribed i.e **40** for fresh admissions as per the Priority categories. Admission may be granted to fill up the vacant seats within the class strength prescribed in the Table given at PART-A, Para-5 and according to the order of priority category of the parents.
- d. A student who was earlier not found eligible for admission to a particular stream may be allowed fresh admission to a particular stream in class XI in the next academic session, if he/she improves his/her performance within one year from the same Board, provided vacancies exist after admitting the eligible students passing out in the current academic session.
- e. Students passed through Supplementary Examination will be accommodated in the same procedure.

Note: Informatics Practices as an elective subject is offered to all streams. Admission to this would be granted as per the combined merit list. Computer Science / Bio- Technology, wherever available as an elective subject, is to be offered to students of Science Stream and admission would be granted as per combined merit list. Multi- media & Web- Designing Technology (wherever available) as elective subject may be offered to students of all the streams (Commerce, Humanities & Science) as per combined merit list.

11. THE FOLLOWING CONCESSIONS WILL BE ALLOWED FOR ADMISSION FOR CLASS XI.

(A) The following concession will be granted to students for admission who participated in Games & Sports meet/Scouting & Guiding/NCC/Adventure activities at various levels. The certificate needed for this purpose can be of any of the preceding years.

(B) Students belonging to SC/ST/OBC-NCL/CwSN would be given up-gradation in aggregate by 4% Marks for the purpose of admission to class XI.

(C) Maximum concession under Sports/Games/NCC/Scout and Guides/Adventure will not exceed 6% Marks in aggregate. In case of eligibility for more than one concession under different categories as mentioned at (A) and (B) above, only one concession having maximum advantage to the candidate will be allowed. The same benefit may be extended to non-KV Students for fresh admission in KVs.

Note:

1. This Admission Guidelines to be extended to Balvatika Classes wherever applicable on the same line as of Class I, subject to the age criteria for Balvatika 1, 2 & 3, as the case be.
2. In case of any issue related to the interpretation of Admission Guidelines, the decision of Commissioner KVS will be final.
3. Any changes required to the Admission Guidelines in any emergent circumstances at any time of the year, the changes can be made with the prior approval of Chairman, KVS.
